

Cinnamon Reel in the Princess final

Although there were nine three year old fillies contesting the \$58,000 final of the Princess Pacing Series on Saturday, May 2, it was fair to say the trio of Tarport Sensation, Hop Irish and Cinnamon Reel were carrying the biggest credentials and as post time arrived the "big three" didn't let their handlers or the crowd down.

As the wings unfolded, David Keyes shot Hop Irish out for command from the six hole and the tandem lit up fractions of :27.3, :57.4 and 1:25.4 with Tarport Sensation sitting a patient second and Cinnamon Reel taking to the outside flow third. With the field facing a

fierce head wind in the stretch, it was Cinnamon Reel and reinsman Paul MacDonell outdueling Hop Irish by half a length in a spirited mile time of 1:55.4. Tarport Sensation was another half length back in third.

"They were definitely the two to beat," said MacDonell of his nearest competitors, "but I was very impressed with her after last week and I thought we had a big shot. With the wind she was happy to see the wire, but so was everybody."

The talented Cam Fella miss pushed her season earnings over \$61,000 for trainer William Elliott and owners Pat Jr. and Dan Daly of Hamilton.

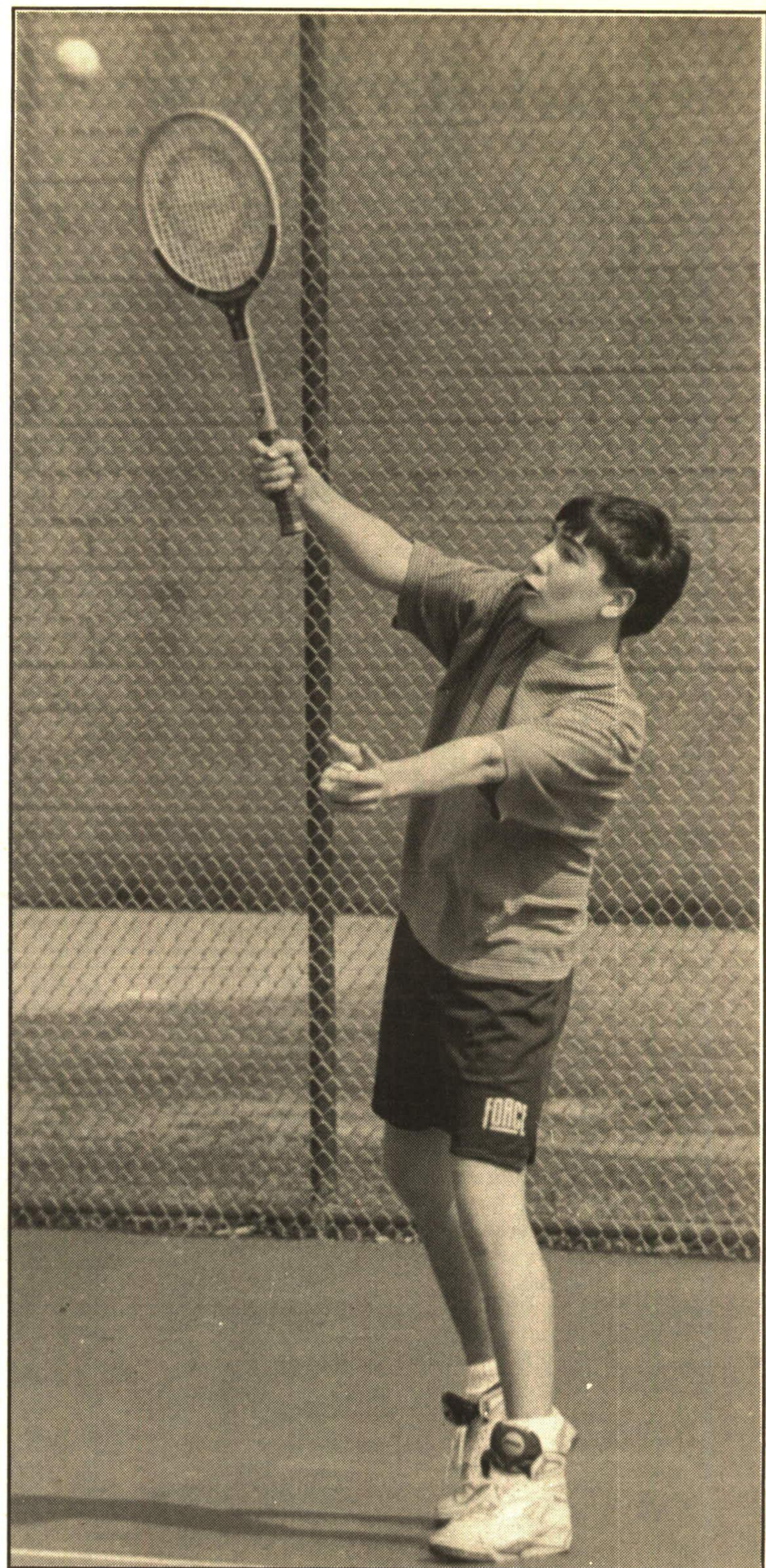
Four weeks after the tragic barn

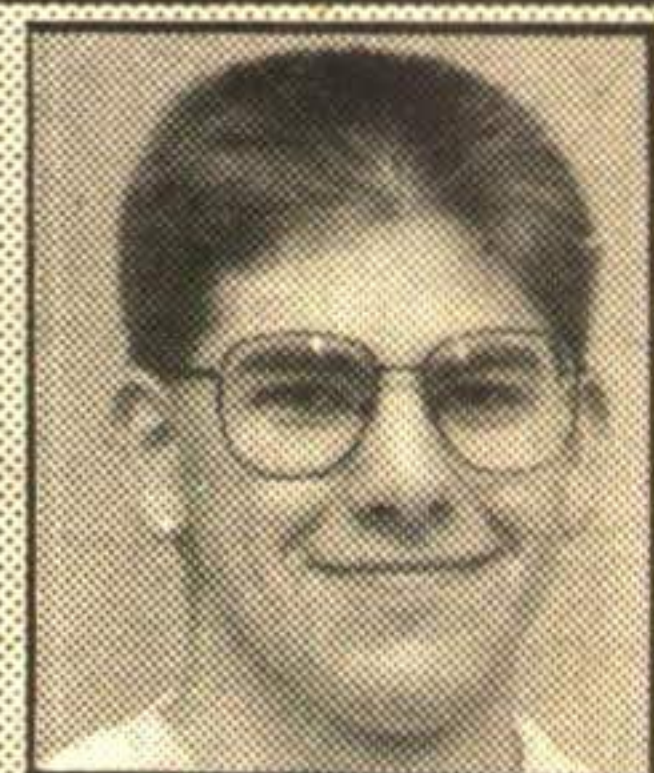
