

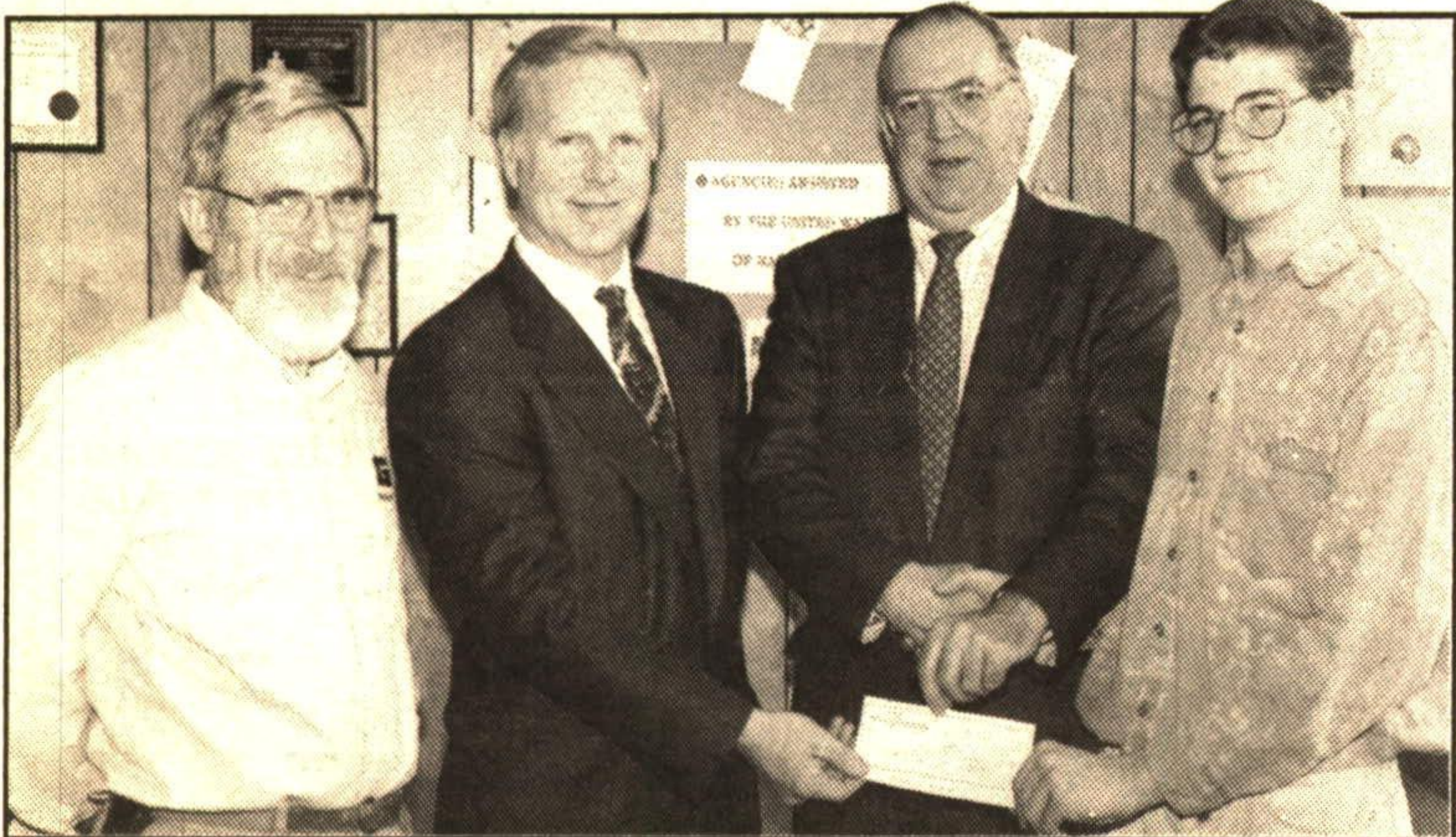
Halton Hills in focus
