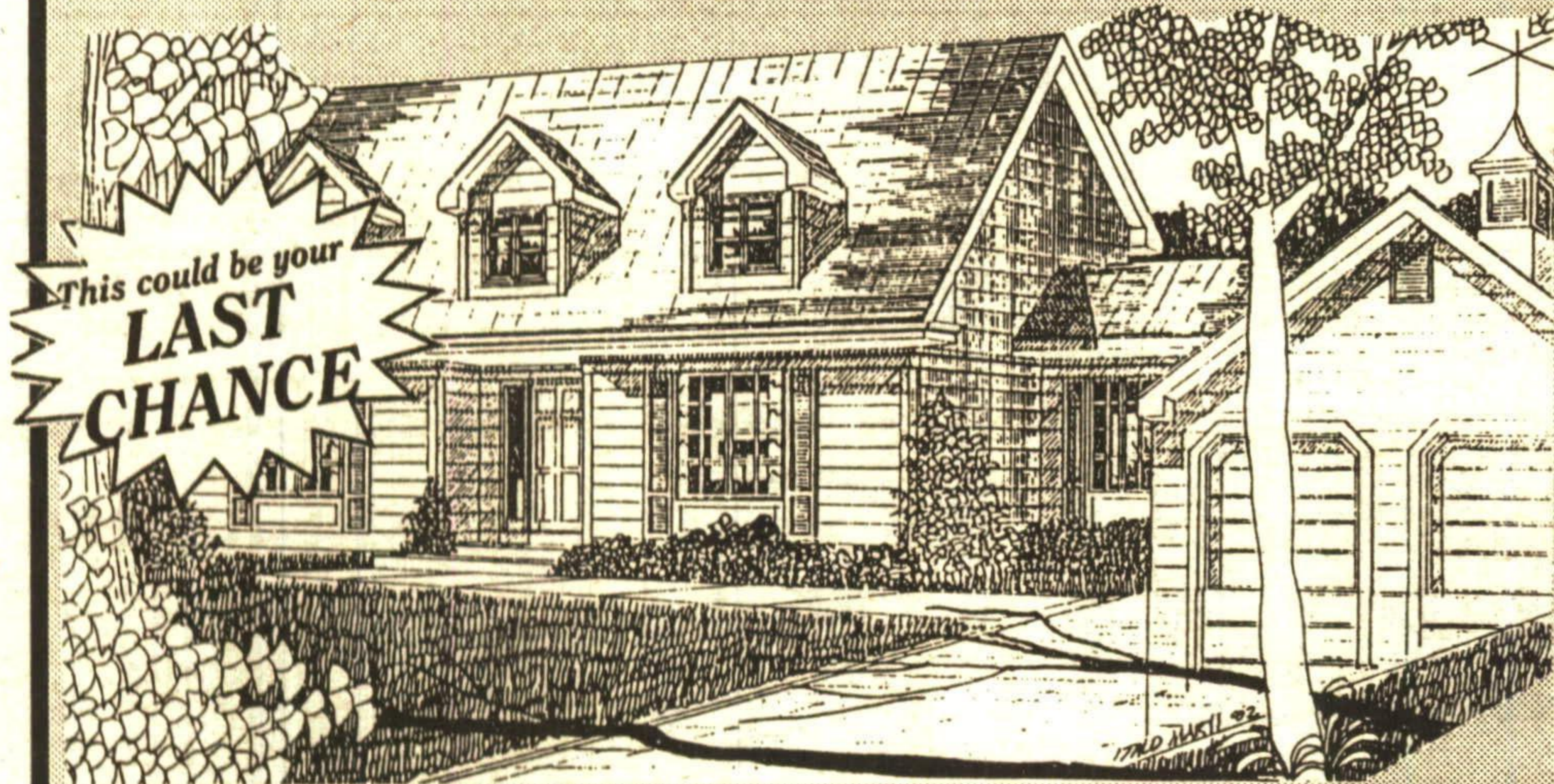

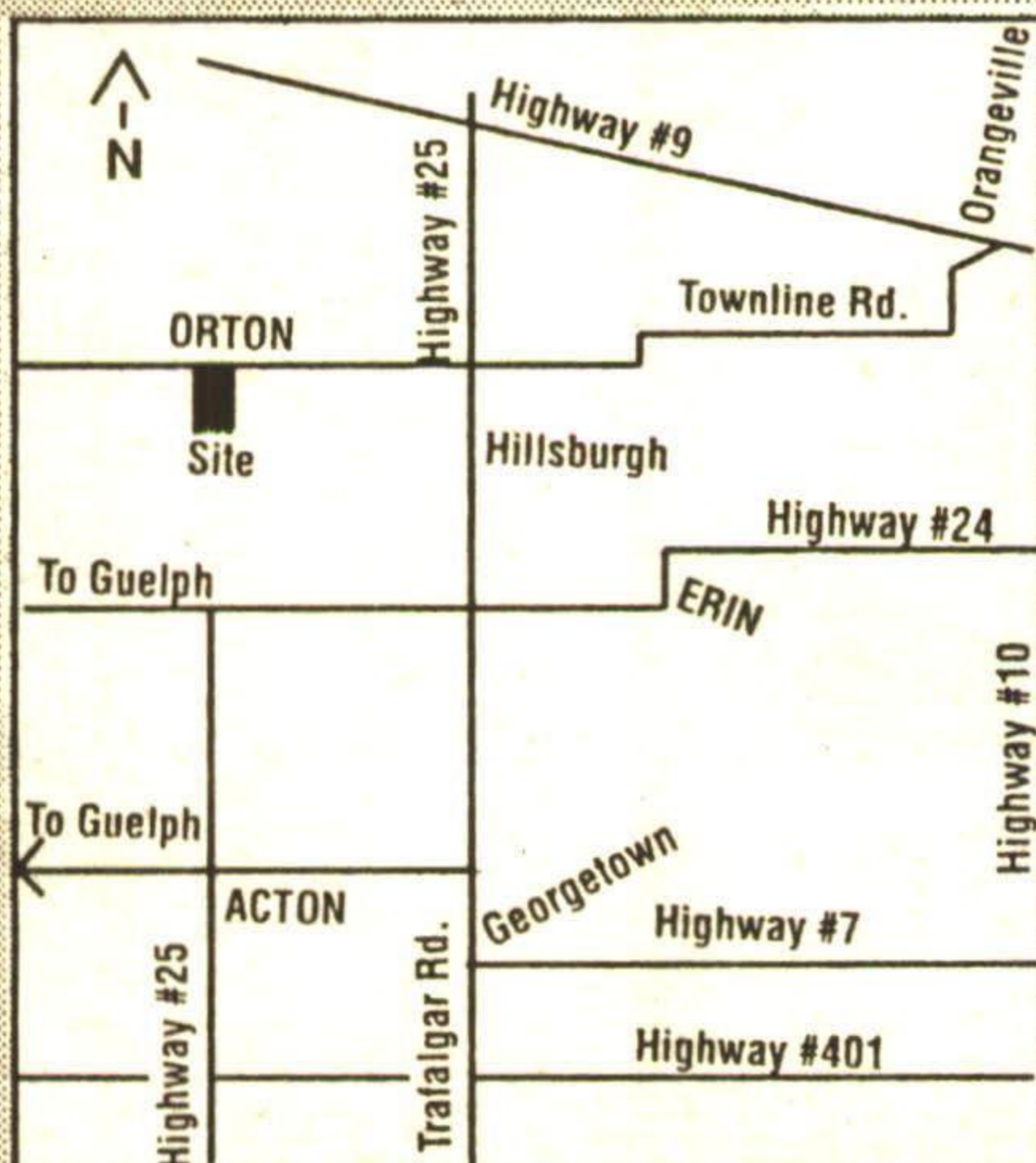

## ADAPT office opens

ADAPT, the Halton Alcoholism and Drug Addiction Program, has opened a new satellite office in Georgetown.

The ADAPT office is open at 232 Guelph St., suite 208, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday for alcohol and drug assessment and counselling services. The centre serves both adults and youth.

Evening counselling appointments can be negotiated, but clients must make an appointment during office hours for an initial assessment. ADAPT services are free of charge.

ADAPT has provided service in Burlington, Oakville, Milton and Halton Hills since it began as a pilot project in 1975.

"It's a service that's open to any residents experiencing drug and

alcohol problems," said adult program coordinator Lori Millie. Millie stressed that this includes people that may not have a drug or alcohol problem themselves but have a spouse or family member whose addiction affects them.

"We're very happy to say that half of referrals are self-referrals," said Millie.

ADAPT works out an individualized treatment plan for each client, emphasizing prevention and treatment to live a chemical-free lifestyle. Counsellors will also make recommendations for other professional help if it is needed.

"We will certainly see people at an early stage," said Millie, if someone is wondering whether or not they have a drinking or drug problem.
