

240 golfers expected at Bill Smith Tournament

Toll free telephone line offers campsite reports

A toll-free phone line that provides campsite availability reports from 53 of Ontario's provincial parks is now in operation.

"Ontario's provincial parks are extremely popular," said Peter North, Ontario Minister of Tourism and Recreation. "The toll-free phone line is widely used by campers. This allows them to get a better handle on planning their outdoor getaways."

Running from May 15 until Labor Day weekend, campers outside Toronto can call 1-800-ONTARIO, 24 hours a day to get the latest vacancy information.

People in Toronto can dial 314-0998. The report is also available in French by calling 1-800-268-3736 from 9 am to 9 pm daily and 10 am

to 6 pm Sundays, or by dialing 314-0956 in Toronto. Campsite information is also available from Ontario Travel Information Centres, listed in the blue pages of the telephone directory.

Reservations must be made by calling a provincial park directly.

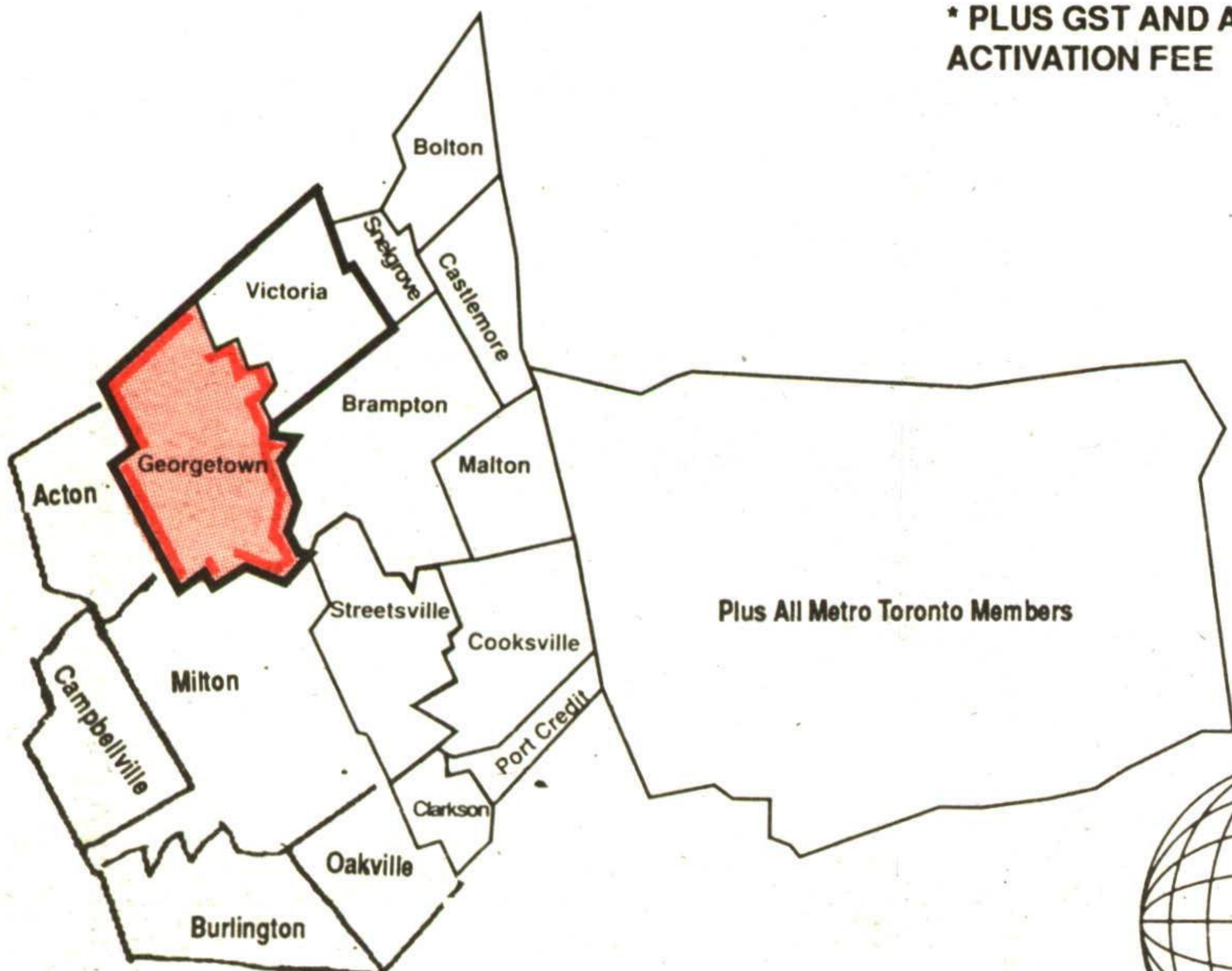

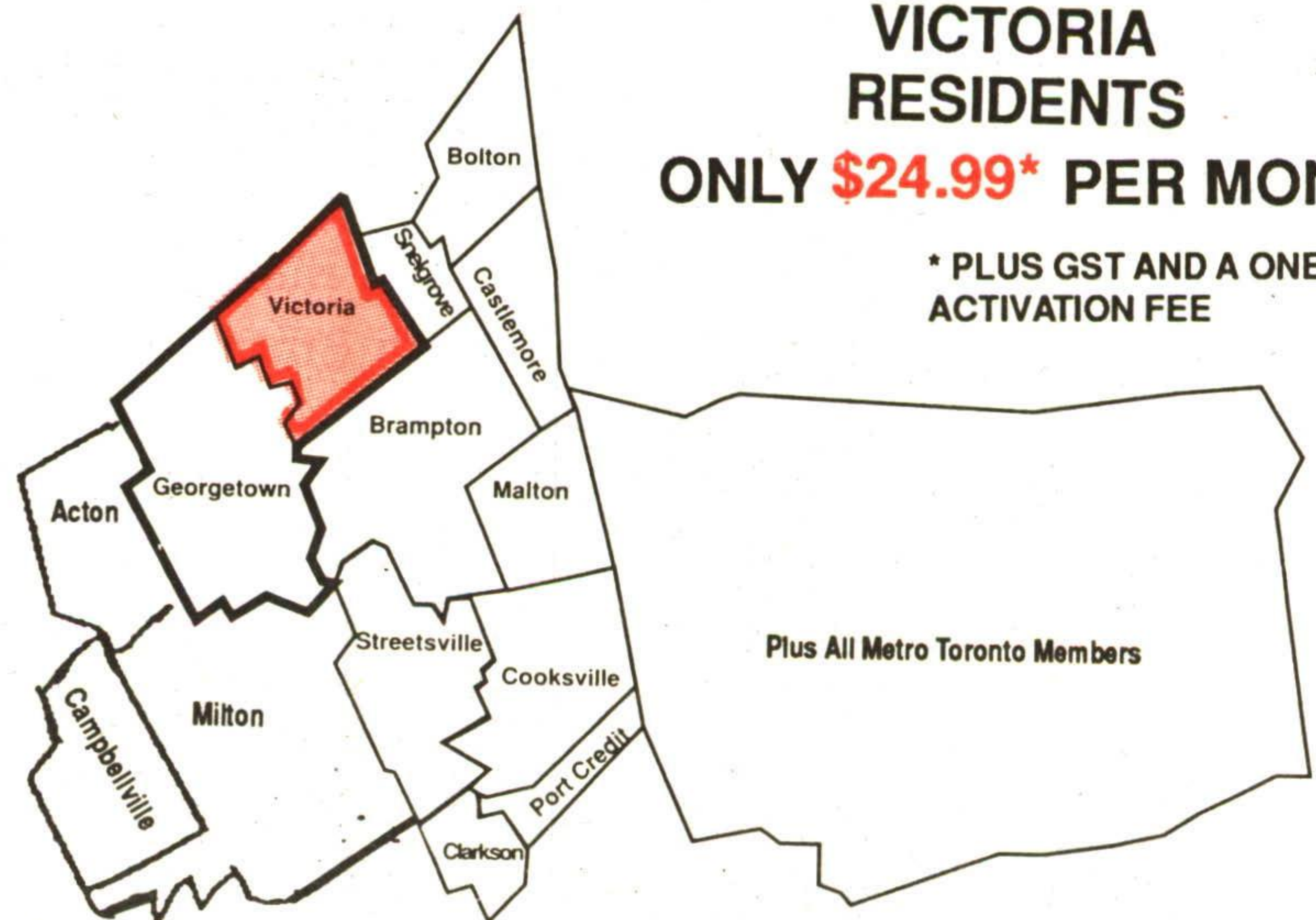
