Immunization clinics

Halton Regional Health Department offers monthly community immunization clinics the second Tuesday of every month in North Halton. Clinics alternate monthly between Georgetown and Milton.

Vaccines available through this clinic include mumps, measles, german measles, diphtheria, polio, whooping cough, tetanus, typhoid and hemophilus B (18 month schedule). Mantoux testing for tuberculosis screening is also available. This service is free to the residents of Halton except for a \$2 charge for the typhoid vaccine.

Milton clinics will be held at the Health Department office at 251 Main Street, Milton on June 9, August 11 and every two months thereafter, 3:30 to 7 p.m.

In Georgetown, clinics will be held July 14, September 15 and every two months thereafter, 3:30 to 7 p.m. at the Health Department office at 93 Main Street, Georgetown.

For appointments to attend the Milton clinic call 878-7261 and for the Georgetown clinic call 877-2238.

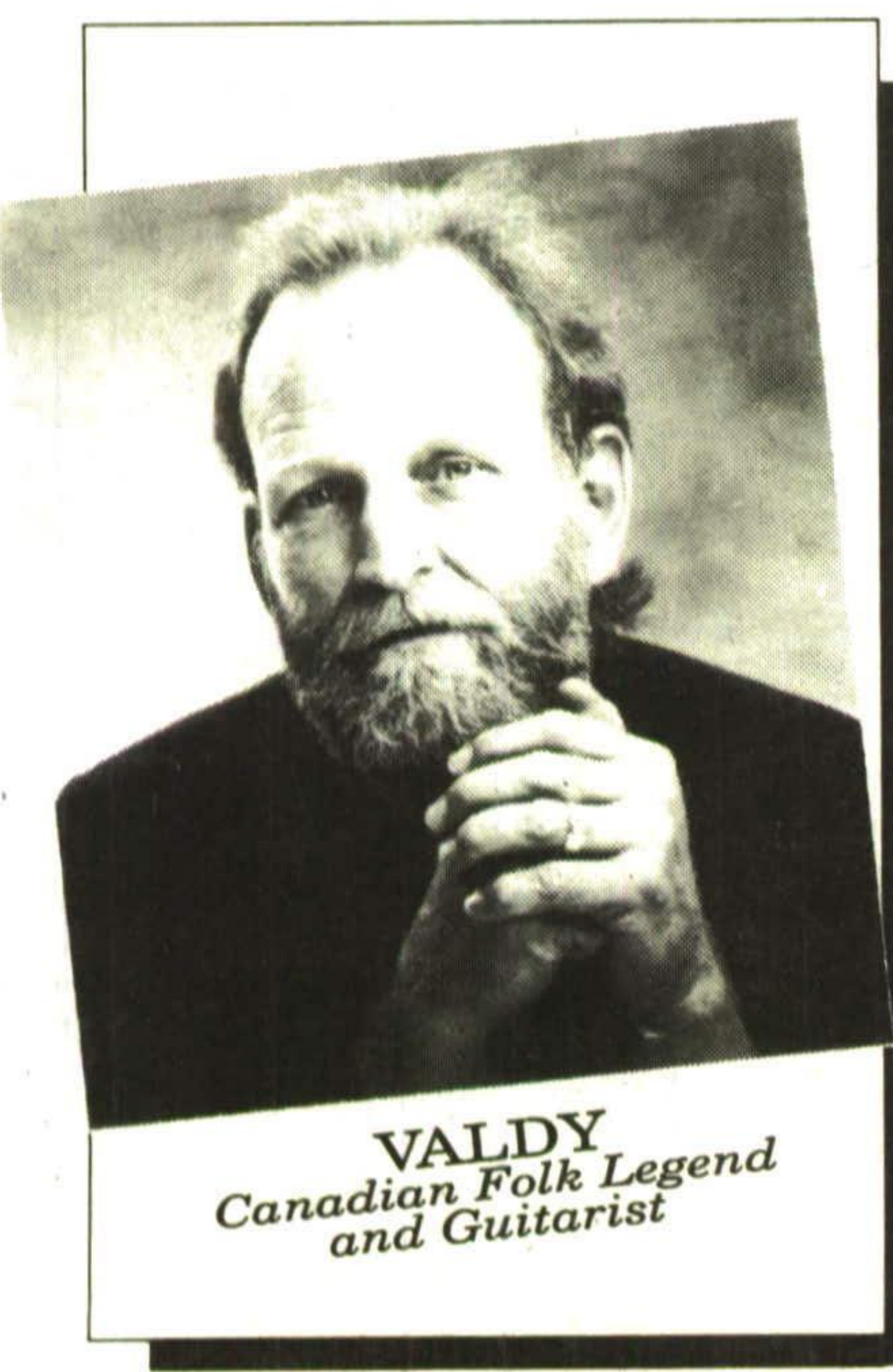
