MPP Duignan hoping new bill could kill quarry landfill bid


MPP Noel Duignan introduced a private member's bill Wednesday which would eliminate any future waste disposal sites on the Niagara Escarpment.

"This particular rock formation is very porous and is no place for a dump site. It's also been declared a United Nations Biosphere Reserve," and shouldn't have any waste sites

on it, Duignan said. The bill was unanimously passed in the House of Commons for the first reading, and Duignan is pushing for it to be debated and passed the second and third time before the summer session ends. The current session generally ends on June 25, but it may continue into July this year, he said.

One of the strongest benefits of this act, he said, would be to kill any attempt to put a landfill site in the Acton quarry or any other quarry site on the escarpment. It suggests that only those with a certificate of approval, which the Acton Quarry does not yet have, would be permitted.

The proposed bill would override Amendment 52 to the Niagara Escarpment Act, because under that a company can still apply to amend the NEC Planning Act and possibly still have a landfill site put on the escarpment. If it is passed in time, it would also override a decision from the Environmental
