Water balloons

A dog was sent in, but no one was found. On Monday (June 8) the screens on a window were damaged at the same school, police said.

A John Deere garden tractor was stolen sometime overnight Thursday, June 11 from Winston Churchill Blvd. It was parked in a farm equipment shelter behind a home. It had a yellow grass cutter attached and is in good condition, estimated to be worth \$4,000.


Ownership missing


