

Students to learn about agriculture

The children of Limehouse Public School will have the opportunity to learn more about agriculture now that they have the resource material presented to them by Dublin and Limehouse Women's Institutes.

The F.A.R.M. Kit stands for "Fascinating Agricultural Resources and Materials." This hands-on educational tool was first developed by four women from Southern Ontario who had great concern for the lack of knowledge of agriculture and farm safety. The kit includes scale models of 13 farm implements, 138 activity cards and a teacher's manual. The presentation was made recently at one of

Limehouse School's assemblies and will be incorporated into the school's program in the fall.

Another project of Dublin Women's Institute was a donation to the Guelph General Hospital Building Fund. Jean McLean and Kathleen Alder represented Dublin at a recent presentation.

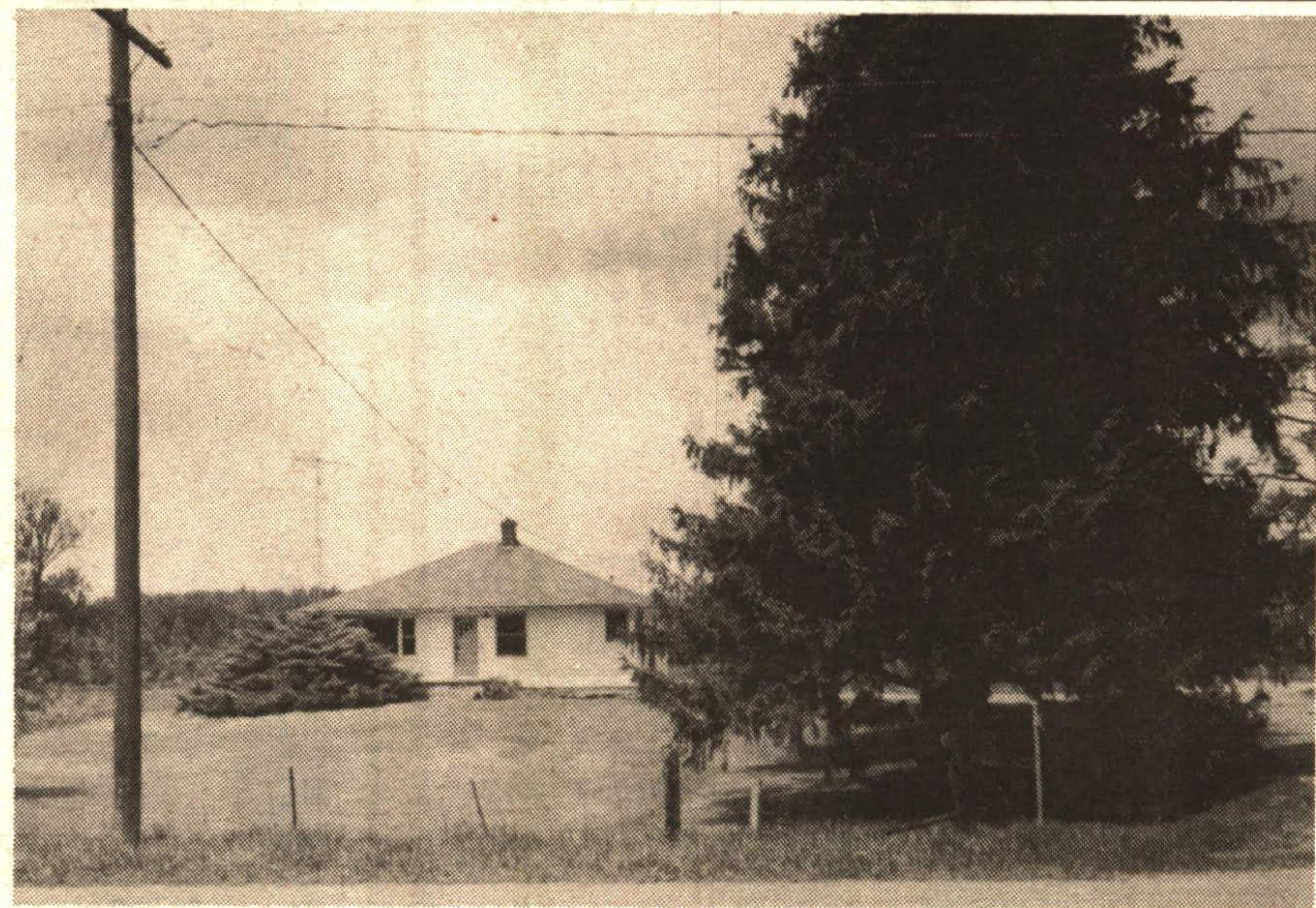

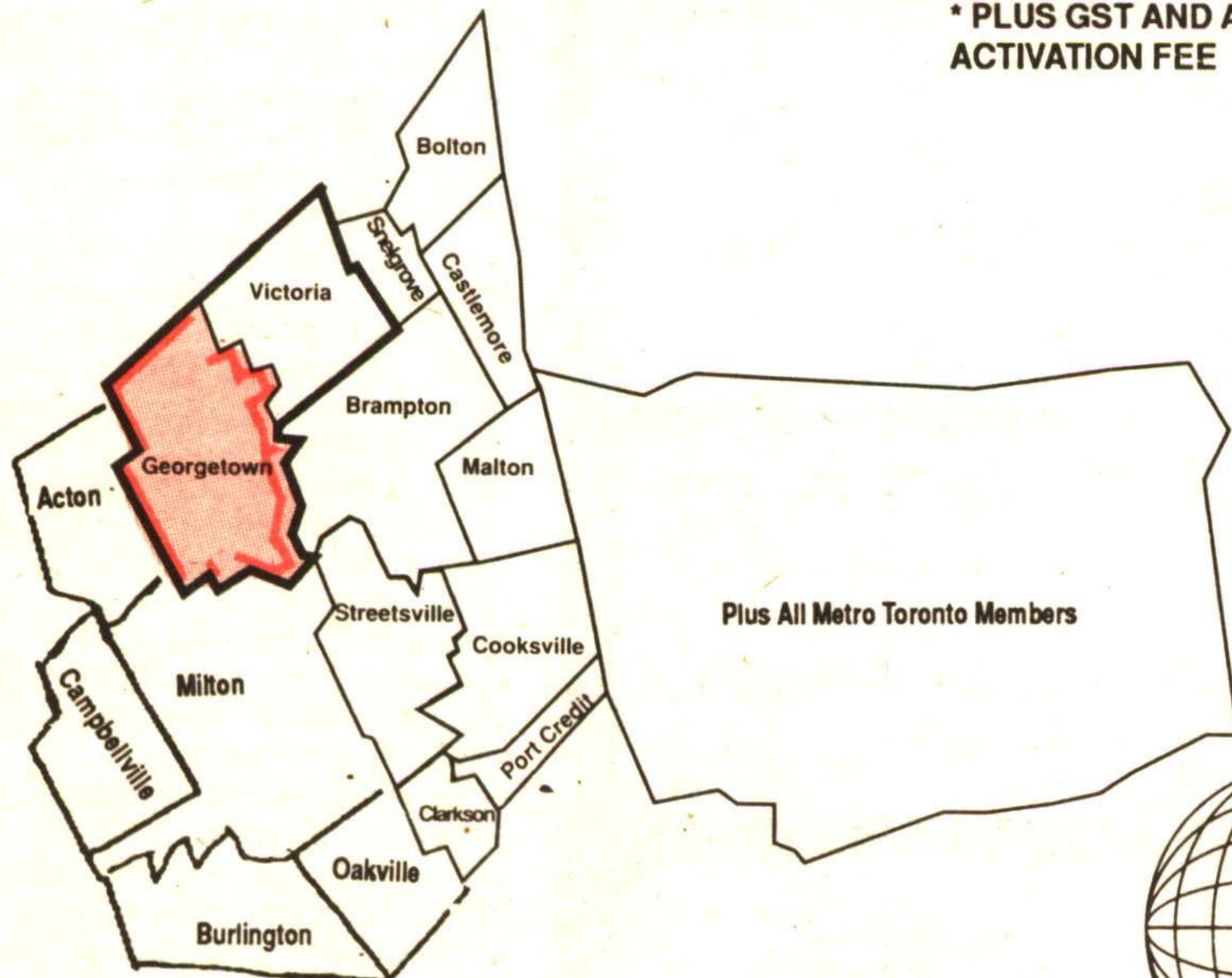

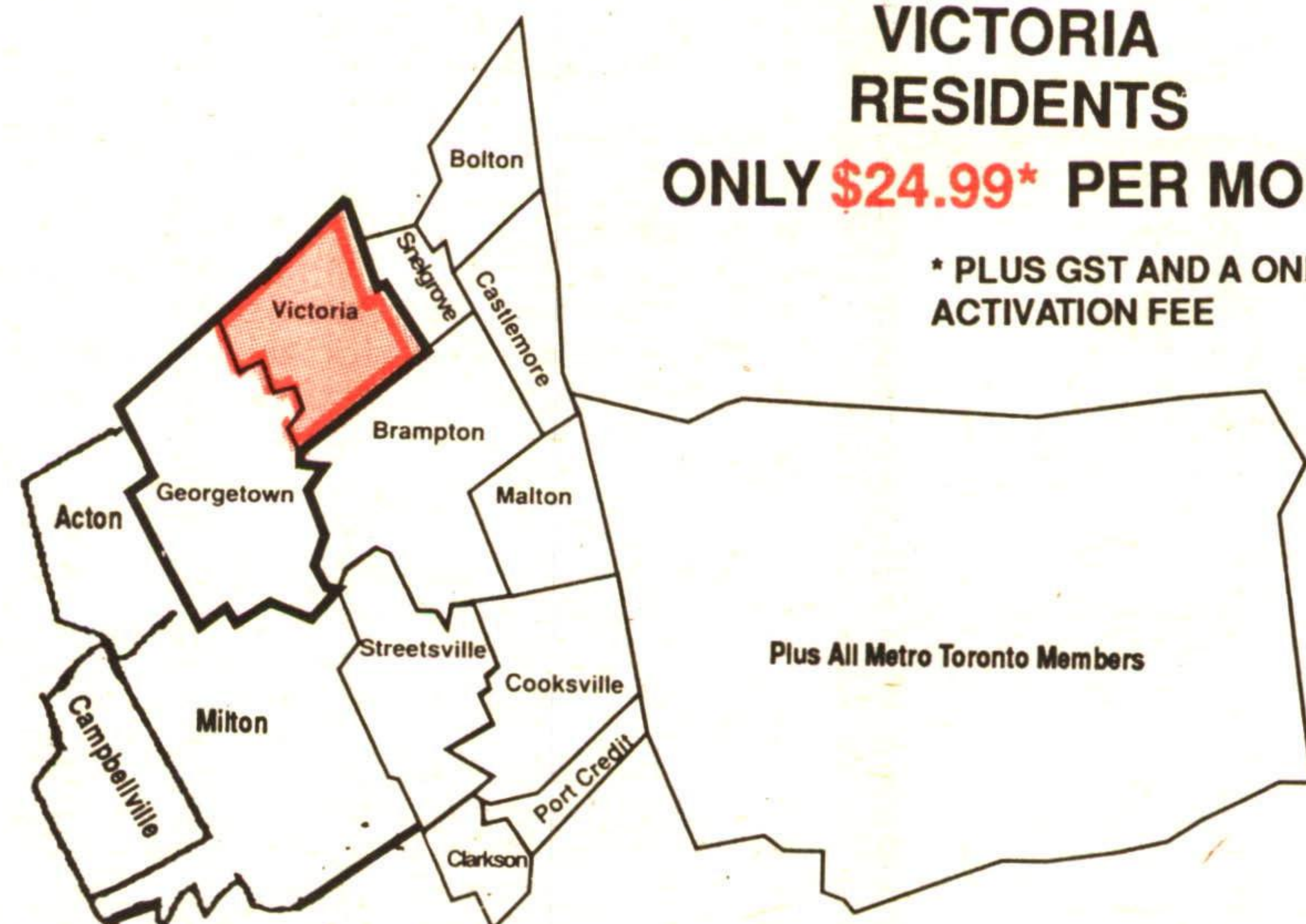
