## Public board hosts Kansas educators

Eighteen elementary educators  
from the Lawrence Unified School  
District, Kansas, visited Halton  
Board of Education schools on  
Tuesday, June 16. The visitors will  
learn from, and build on, the suc-  
cesses of the Halton Board of  
Education's model for school  
growth planning.

Funded completely by a grant  
from the United States government,  
the group met with senior staff and  
made intensive visits to three  
Halton schools. The 18 educators  
split into four groups, each of which  
spent a full day at one school. The  
schools, selected based on the spe-  
cific areas of interest of the visi-  
tors, were C.H. Norton Public  
School and Frontenac Public School  
in Burlington, and Pilgrim Wood  
Public School and River Oaks  
Public School in Oakville.

Superintendent of Instructional  
Services Joanne Zywine said,  
"These educators want to take back  
information and strategies on how  
to successfully change schools in  
order to help students meet the  
challenges of the future. We also  
hope to learn from their experi-  
ences in coping with change, and to  
use those experiences to benefit the  
students we serve in Halton. This is  
a tremendous 'win/win' situation  
for kids in both countries!"
