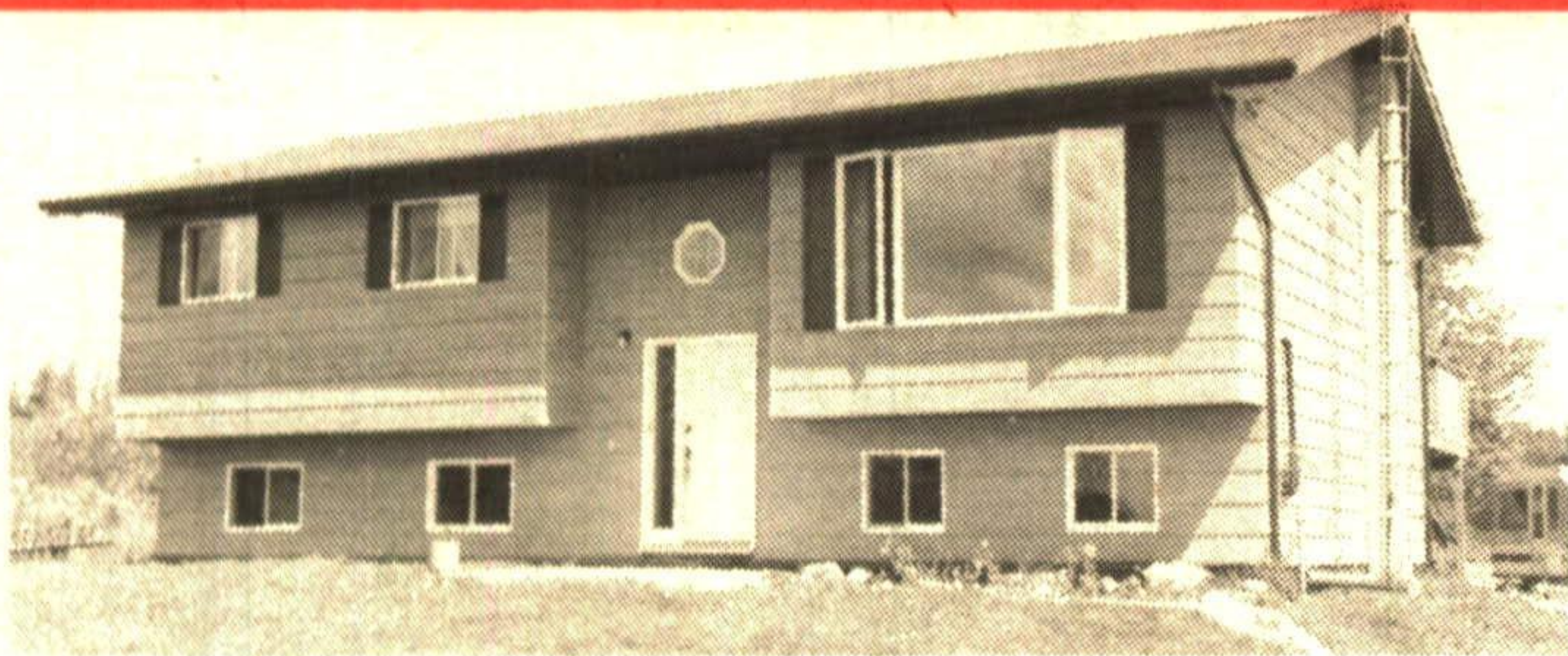
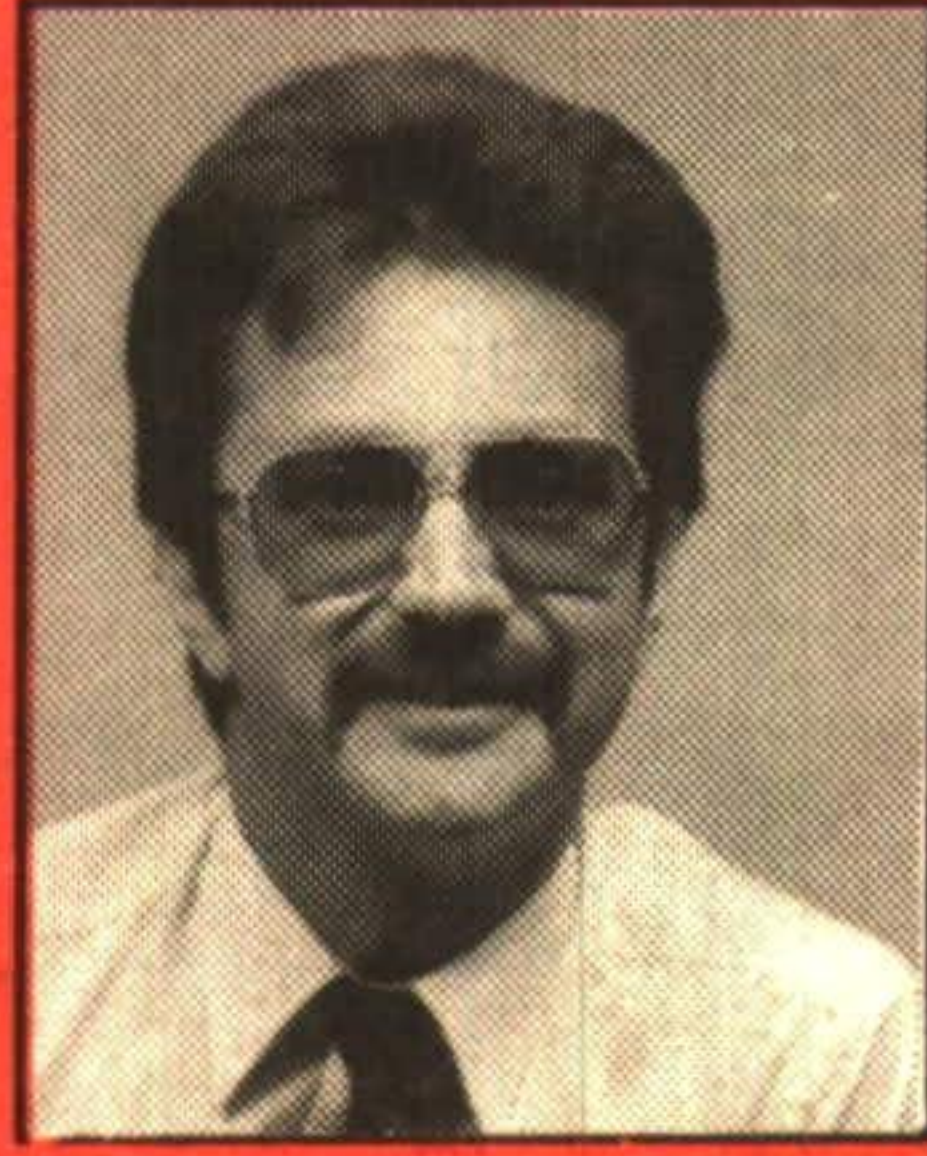

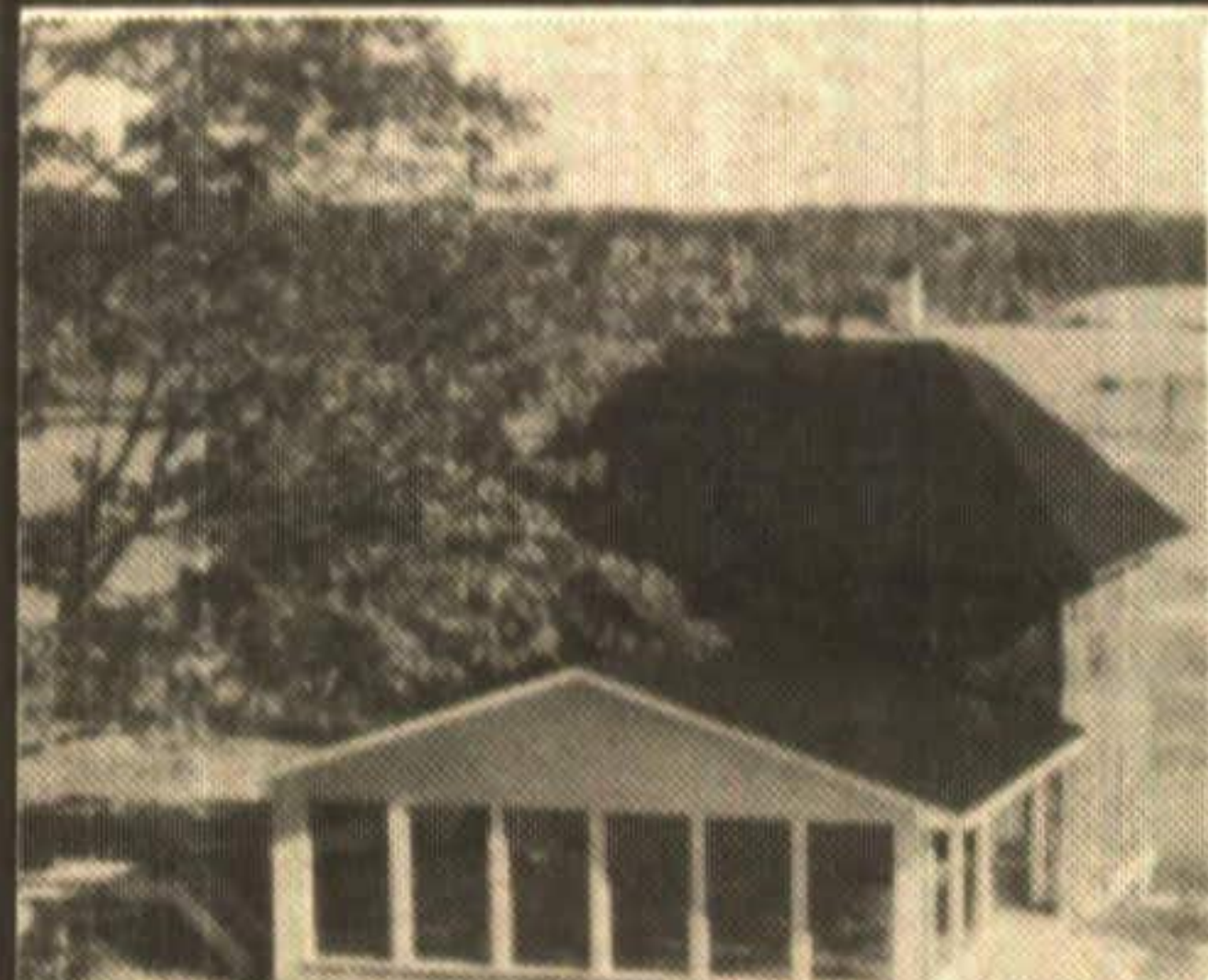

# Landscape

*with Mowing Safety in Mind*

Many homeowners landscape with only one objective—to have a unique and beautiful lawn. While this is important, it is even more important to be aware of future mowing safety, and to plant trees and shrubs with this in mind. Careful planning while you are landscaping can not only save you mowing time, it can also prevent accidents in the future.

Keep the following tips in mind to make landscaping safe and successful:

- Avoid planting trees and bushes in a way that would make forward mowing difficult. Backward mowing should be avoided to prevent accidents.
- Remove a two- to three-foot area of grass from around trees and large bushes and fill the area with mulch. This area will be much easier to mow around and it will allow water and nutrients to reach the roots much more easily.
- Use an edging strip around areas filled with shredded bark or stones.

Mow far enough away from the edging strip to prevent the lawnmower blade from throwing the stones into the yard. The unmowed area can be trimmed with a nylon-line trimmer.

- Alternate your mowing pattern by changing your mowing direction each week. This prevents the grass from leaning which causes an uneven appearance.

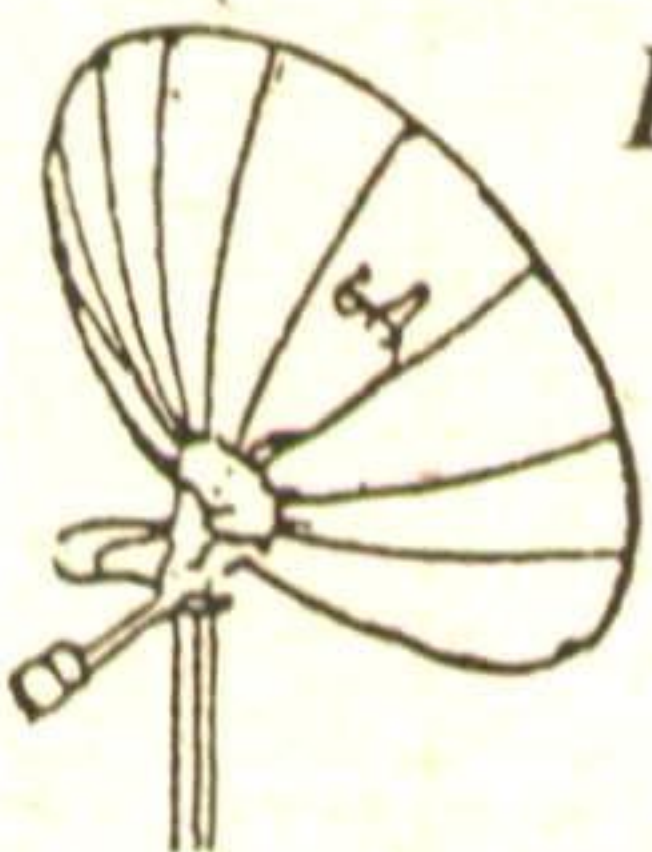
