## O'Tooles takes a SIP of prevention

The serving staff of O'Tooles restaurant, Georgetown, recently graduated from the Server Intervention Program (SIP) run by the Liquor Licence Board of Ontario. SIP is a refresher course on dealing with serving alcohol. The course will be mandatory in 1993 for anyone that serves alcohol, including bar-

tenders, waiters, waitresses and management.

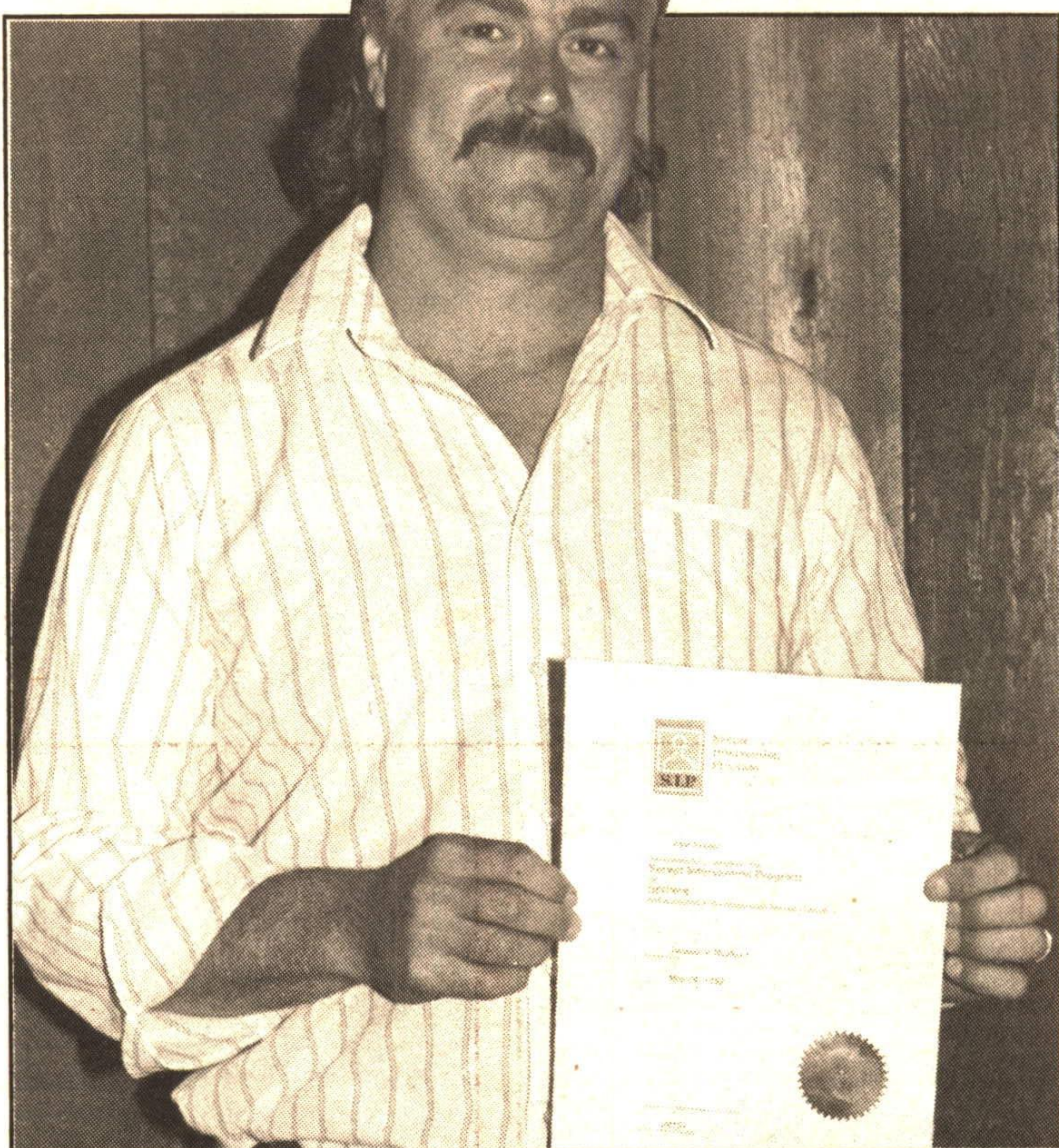
O'Tooles' staff of 15 participated in the four hour course at Jack Tanner's, a fee of \$32 per person applied. They learned about the laws and liabilities involved with alcohol sales and consumption.

Manager Paul Kimbell said the course taught common sense responsibility, such as offering a customer a taxi or food if they drink too much. The course also stressed that there are both physical and emotional responses to alcohol.

"We strongly support anti-drinking and driving in this community," said Kimbell. "We always have. What we're trying to do is keep people off the road (that have had too much to drink)."

Kimbell said everyone had to achieve 90 per cent on the test to obtain the certificate. All of his staff passed without a problem.

"We want people to be responsible," said Kimbell, as well as having fun. "If they can't be responsible enough we have to be responsible for them. ... We don't want anyone to get hurt."
