# Meet your neighbors

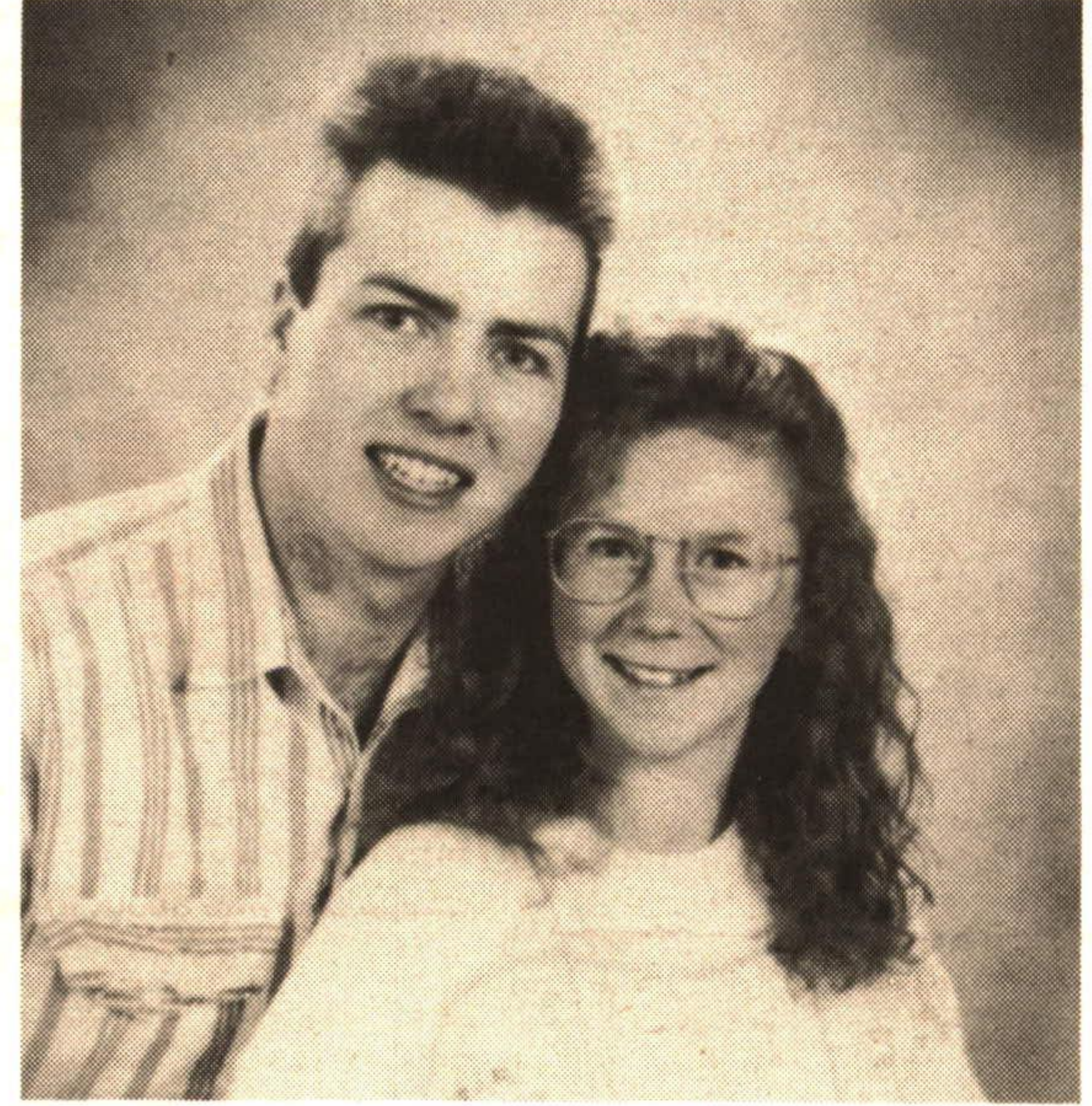
There will be a Meet Your Neighbor Party Sunday, August 16, noon to 6 p.m. at Mountainview North Plaza.

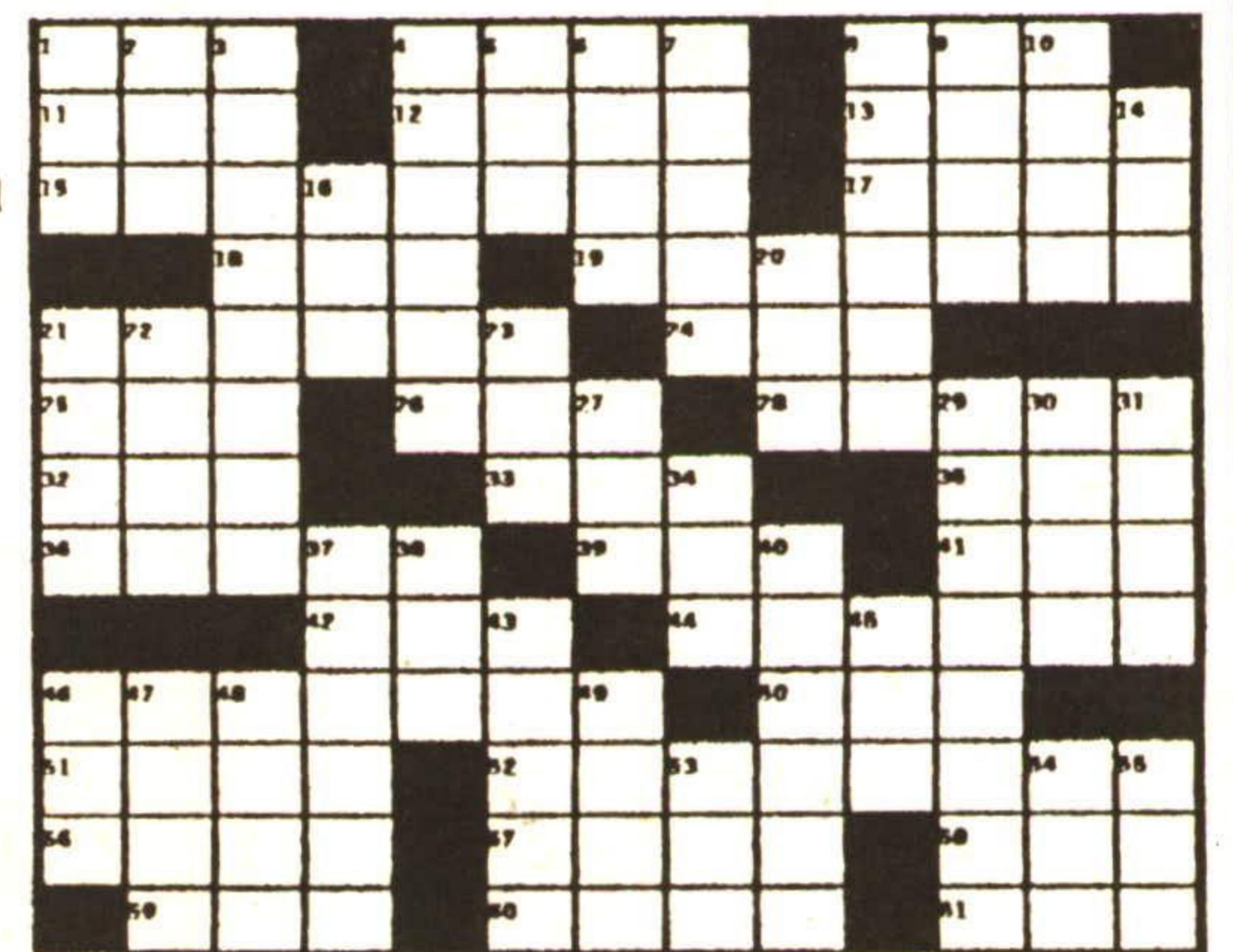
