

**Long distance feeling**

Police are investigating the theft of a telephone and two keys from a secretary's desk at Glen Williams school which occurred sometime between Wednesday and Sunday. Police say the missing phone was discovered by the school's principal, and that there was no sign of forced entry at the school. The missing phone is valued at \$260.

**Toronto man charged**

A 25-year-old Toronto man has been charged with theft under \$1,000 and possession of stolen property under \$1,000 in connection with about \$380 worth of car parts stolen from a Sixth Line used auto parts business on Monday. 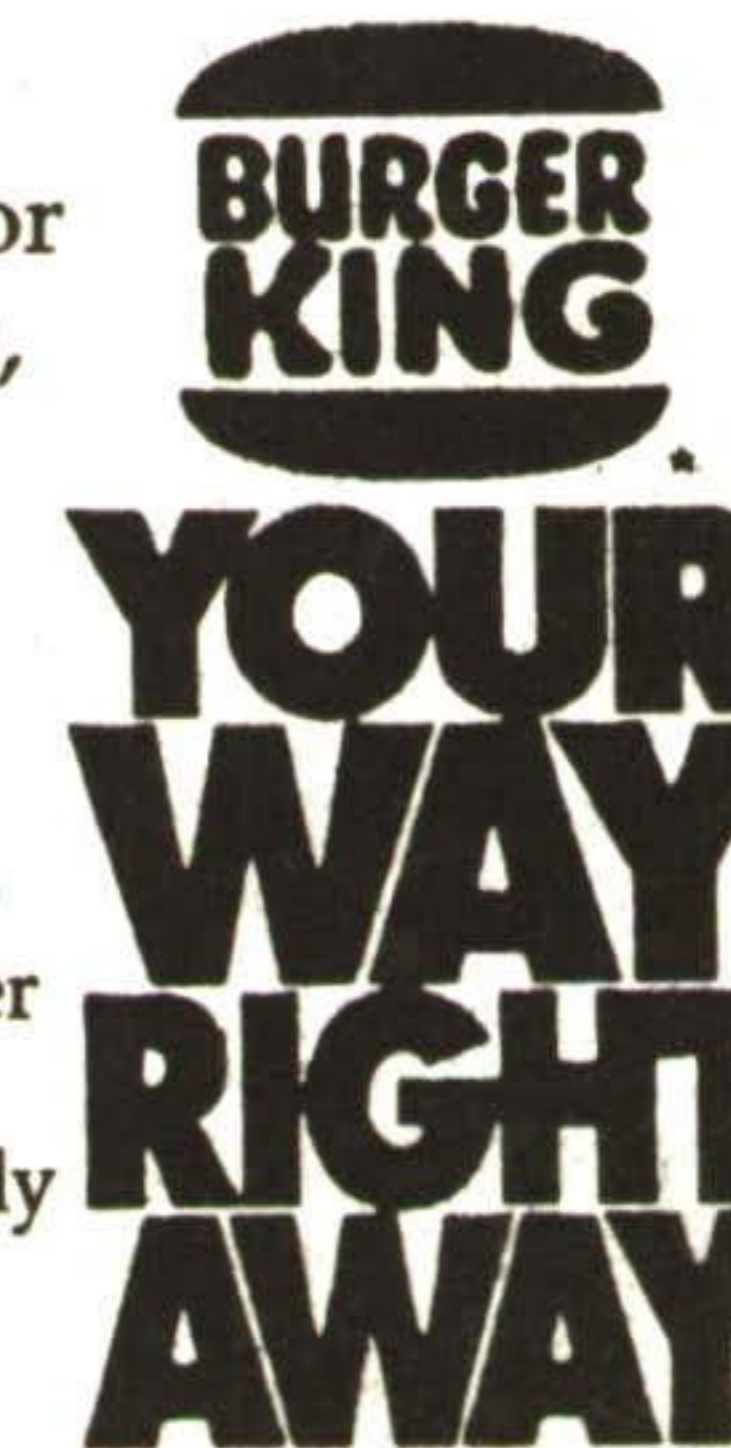
