Both coordinators say they are short on just about everything.

Some of the items they need include; peanut butter, canned stews, fruits and vegetables, spaghetti sauce, pasta, jam, sugar, pork and beans, macaroni and cheese, soup, rice, cereal, baby food, baby formula and diapers, meat (they both have freezers) milk (dried and whole), cheese, bread, fresh fruits and vegetables and paper bags and baggies for school lunches.

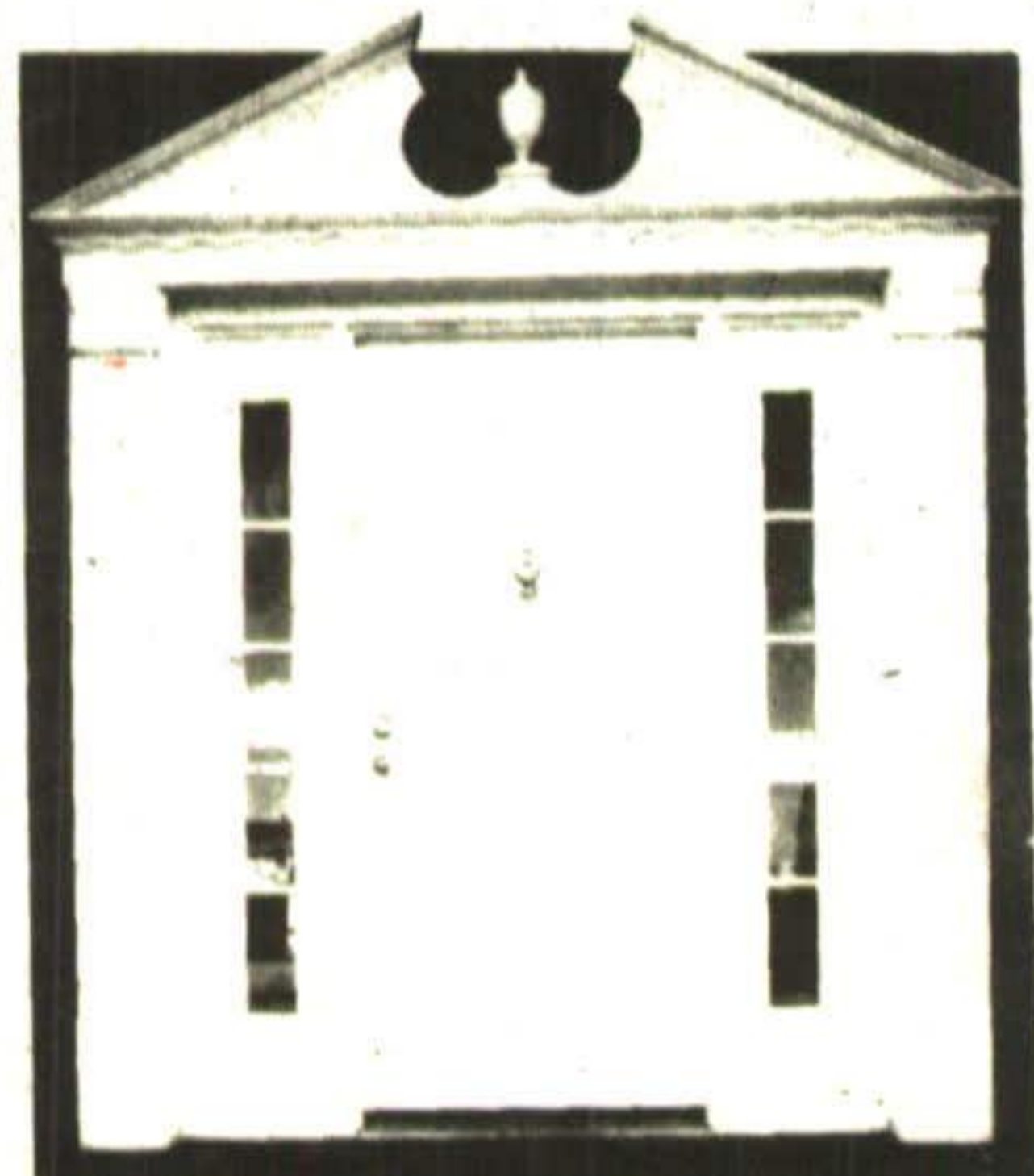
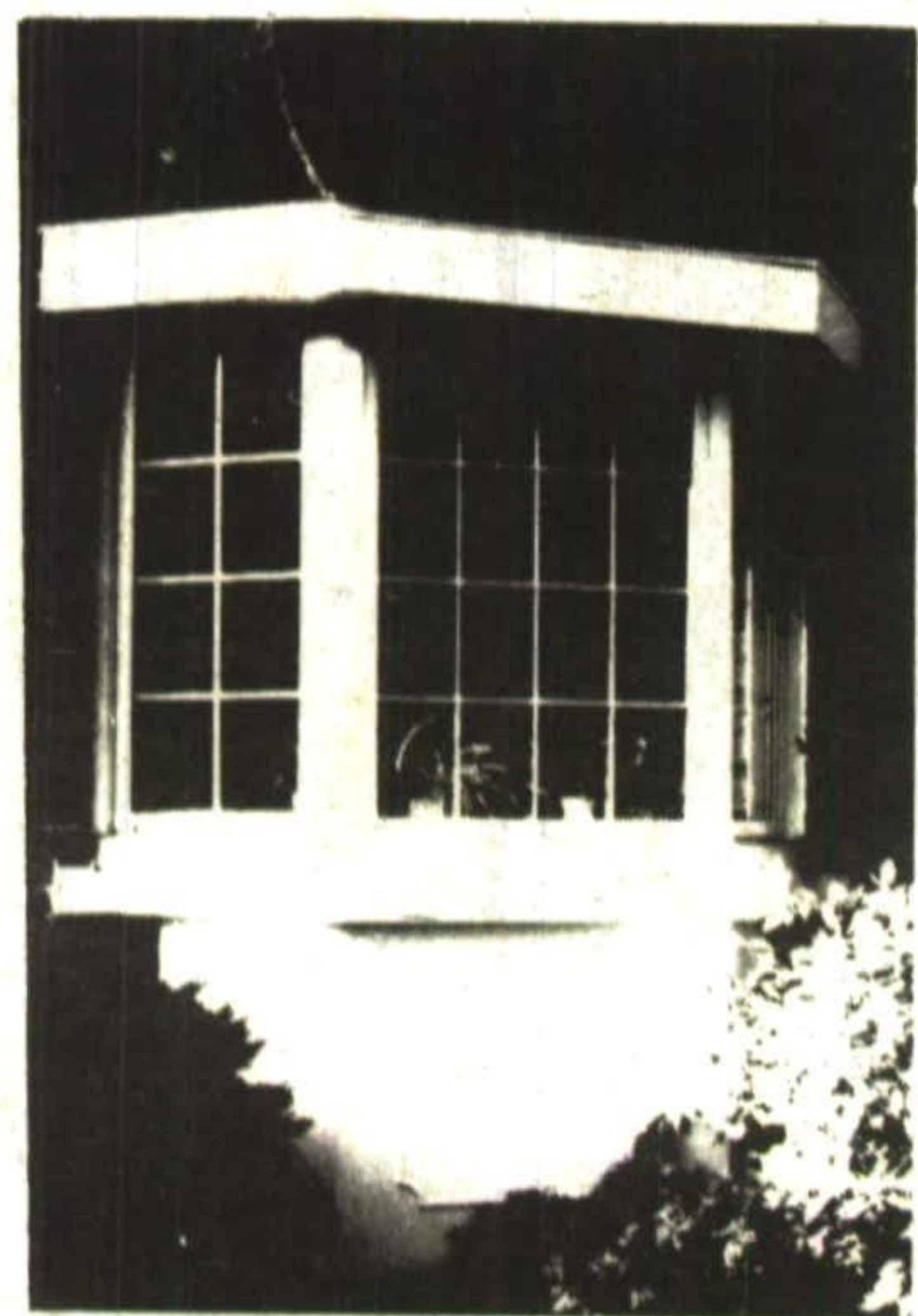
Both food banks will also take cash donations and the Georgetown food bank will take clothing donations, (the Acton bank doesn't need any now). New or barely used toys for the Love In Christ toy room are also needed. The toy room provides food bank users with the opportunity to select a toy for their child, to be given as a Christmas present.

Both food banks are also in need of volunteers. People are needed to clean, fill orders and read stories to children. Volunteers can commit to as much time as they like.

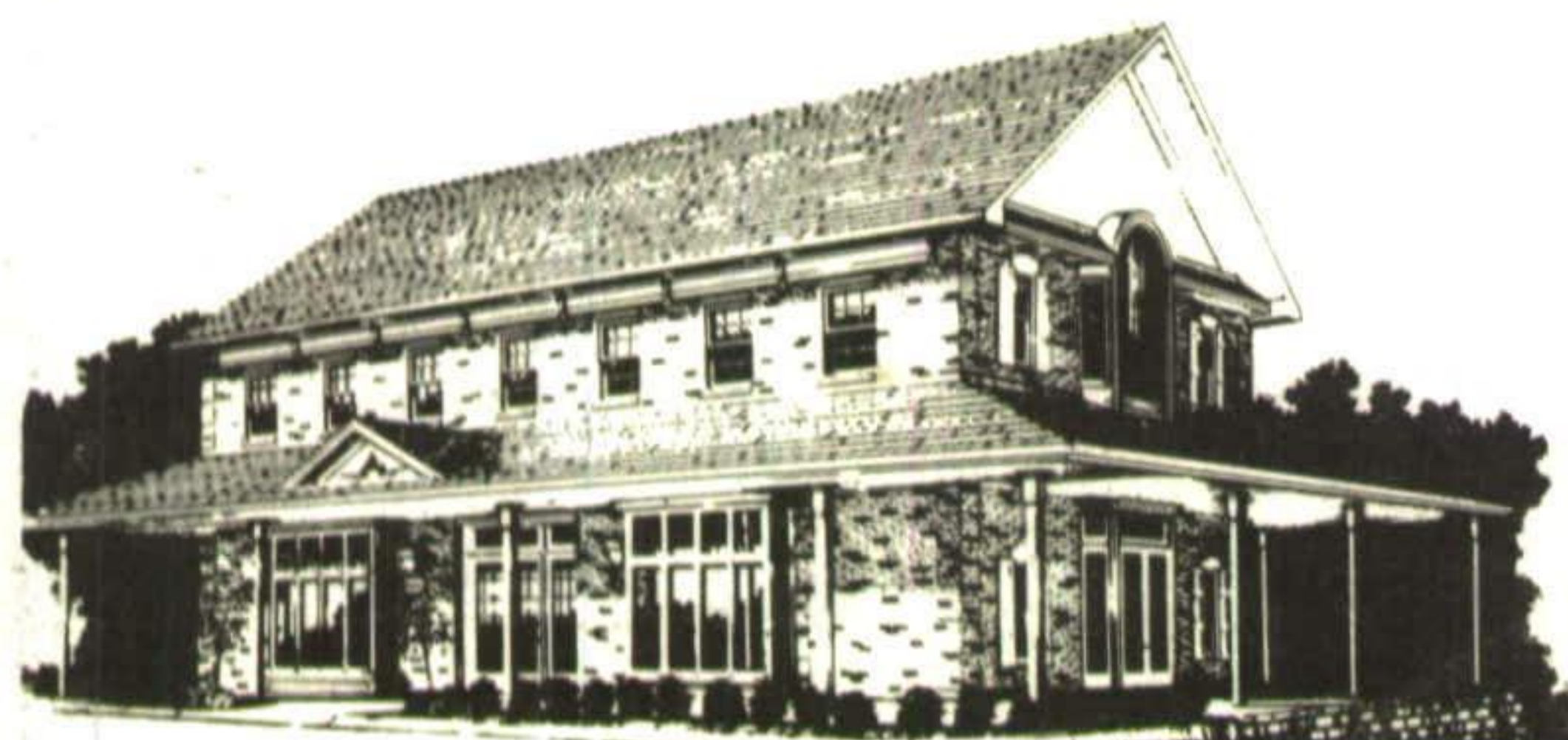

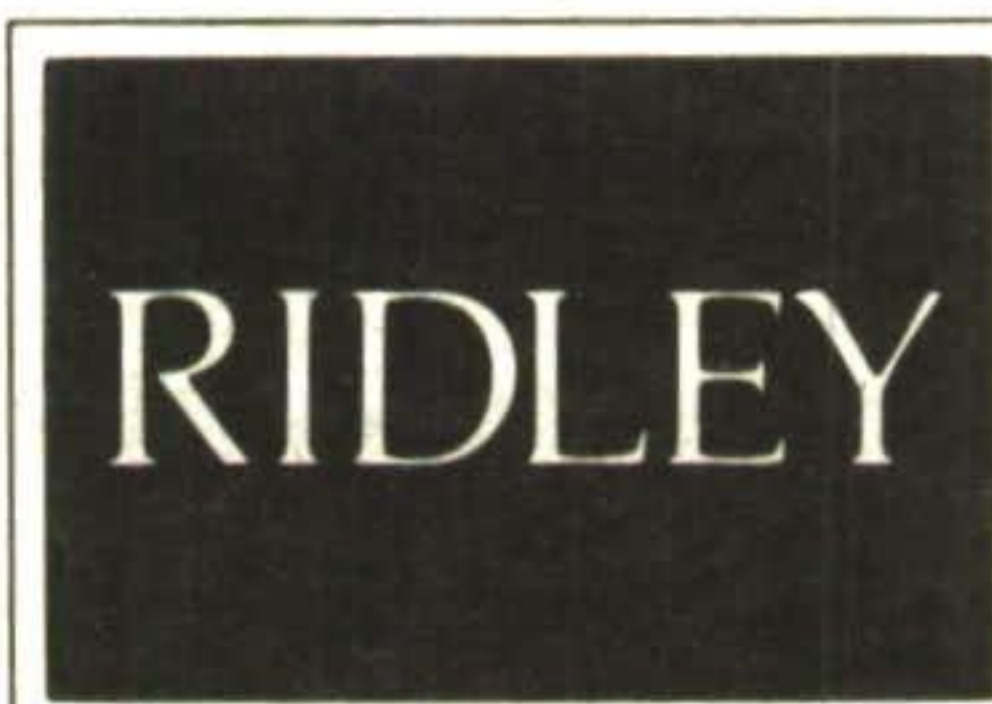
