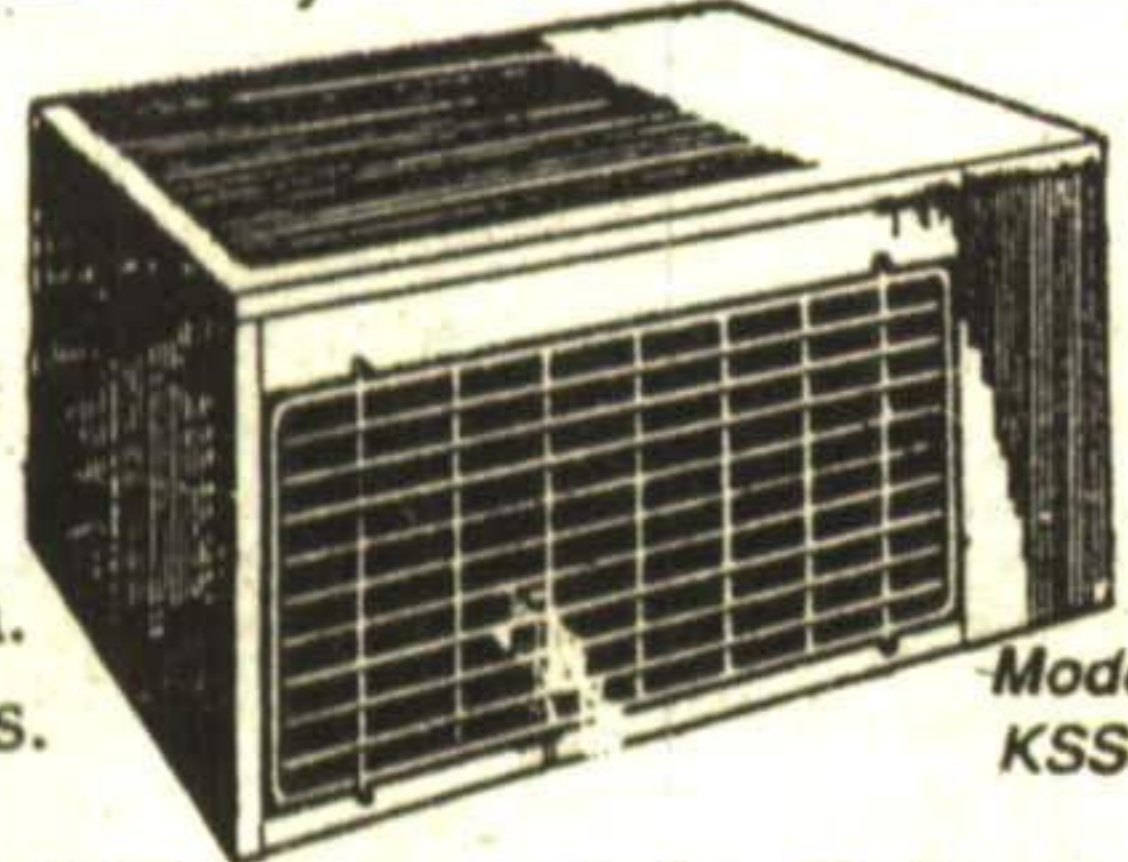

Residents and business operators are invited to express their comments and concerns regarding this matter at one of two public meetings to be held on the matter. The first is slated for Wednesday

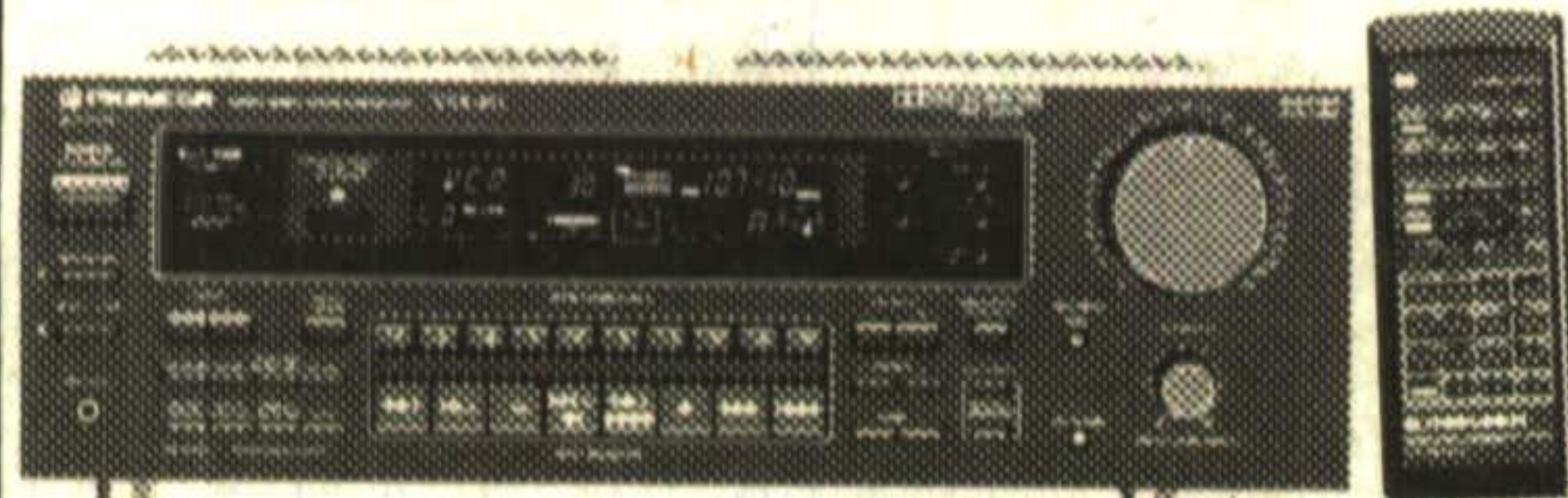
evening at the Halton Hills Civic Centre, 1 Halton Hills Dr., Georgetown, beginning at 7 p.m.

Stewarttown subdivision

All of the deficiencies and problems of the Halton Hills Development Corp. subdivision in Stewarttown have finally been complete and legally put to bed, councillors were told Monday. The developer went bankrupt in 1990, leaving much of the work on the roads, grading, drainage and houses either not complete or deficient. But now, through previous court action and the help of the province's new home warranty program, the deficiencies have been brought up to standard, according to town administrator Dan Costea.

Beaumont Mill

Council supported a bid to lobby the ministry of citizenship and culture for funds to help pay for restoration of the historic building, the Beaumont Mill in Glen Williams. Seven of the 20 windows are needed to be rebuilt at a cost of \$6,125. Each year, a maximum \$3,000 is available through a special provincial grant. Councillor Norm Elliot, who sits on the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee, pointed out the restoration will not cost the town any money.

No parking
