### Terra Cotta banker seeks Reform Party nomination

Campbell McLeish of Terra Cotta has announced his intention to seek the Halton-Peel Reform Party nomination.

McLeish, a resident of Terra Cotta since 1987, is 42 years old, married with one child. He is the vice president of Credit Lyonnais, a French bank which is the seventh largest in world.

According McLeish, "the economy is in a mess. I have specific financial skills ... to help deal with

this major problem." McLeish believes that government spending cuts must be made by eliminating duplication of services. He says these cuts and further cuts in non essential government spending can bring about a

balanced budget and lower taxes. He supports research and development initiatives to reduce dam-

age to the environment. McLeish says the Young Offenders Act is being seriously abused and needs revamping. Restitution should be made where appropriate to victims, he says. McLeish supports capital punish-

ment for certain crimes. On women's issues, McLeish is pro-choice and supports equal opportunity for women in all industries, the government and the Armed Forces.

McLeish supports Reform Party leader Preston Manning's view that Canada is a confederation of provinces equal in all respects.

## Milton man seeks Reform Party job

Rick Malboeuf, 41, a resident of Milton for the past five and half years, is the fifth candidate to seek the Reform Party nomination, to be held Wednesday night at the Georgetown District High School.

Malboeuf, married and a father of four, is a 12th generation Canadian, born and raised in Quebec. He is fluently bilingual. Since 1970 he has worked in the transportation industry, the advertising industry and for the past 15 years in the automotive aftermarket. He's currently a selfemployed small businessman whose company specializes in the sales and marketing of automotive tools and equipment.

Malboeuf has just returned from Ottawa where he participated in a CBC television panel discussion on the referendum question. Malboeuf represented the Reform Party's no position on the accord. The show will
