Raves, at the former Club 2000 address, will now be run by a new strong management team which is here to stay and plan to work with the Georgetown community.

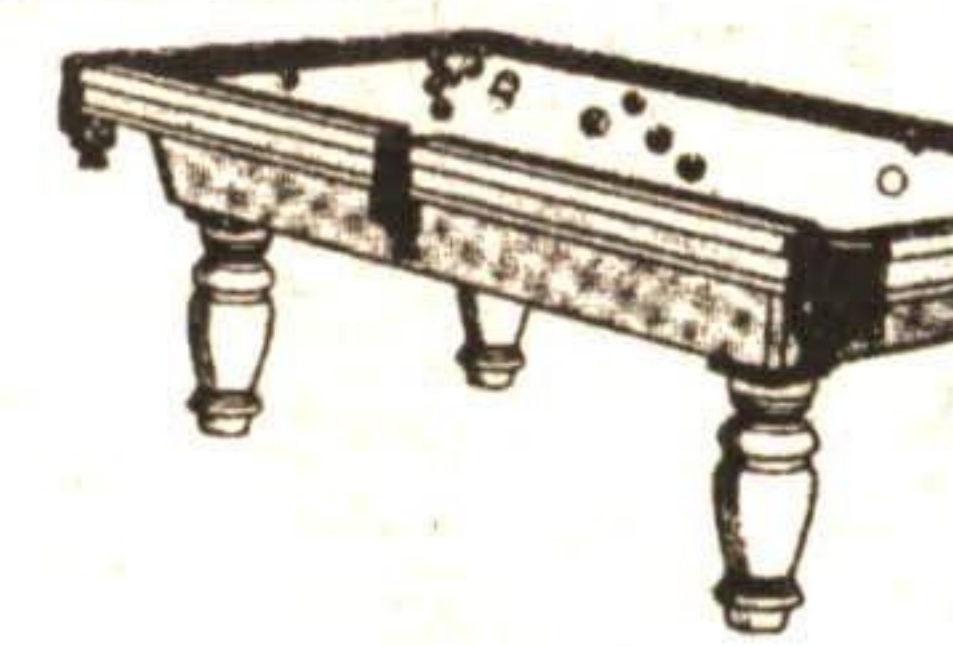
Albert Euteneier, a prominent entrepreneur, who once made the
