United Way is optimistic will meet \$200,000 goal

Although it's too soon for a final tally, organizers of the 1992 Halton Hills United Way campaign are optimistic they will meet their

\$200,000 goal. Kathleen Hayward, executive director of the United Way for Halton Hills, says both the Acton and Georgetown residential campaigns should be finished by the end of this week, and the industrial campaign will wind down over the next few weeks.

Hayward says overall support for the residential campaign has been good but adds that the amount of donations received depends on the area. She says it's difficult to determine at this point if the recession will have an effect on the amount of money collected.

"The majority of our dollars are coming from outside the community," said Hayward. "We have a higher percentage of people contributing through payroll deductions than in the past."

Total figures on contributions made outside the community won't be in for a while.

On the industrial front Hayward says participation has been good from several area countries.

Hayward expects to have the campaign total by early December.


