

\$1,200 theft

Police are investigating the theft of about \$1,200 worth of property from two CN rail cars parked on the tracks at Armstrong Ave. east of Mountainview Rd. in Georgetown sometime between Saturday and Tuesday. The cars were among 70 parked there to house CN employees who have been working on the railway in this area. Residents of the cars were away from the camp during the period, except for one company employee. Police say entry was gained through a window in a door into one car, and aren't sure how the culprit(s) got into the other car. Stolen is a VCR, television and some meat.

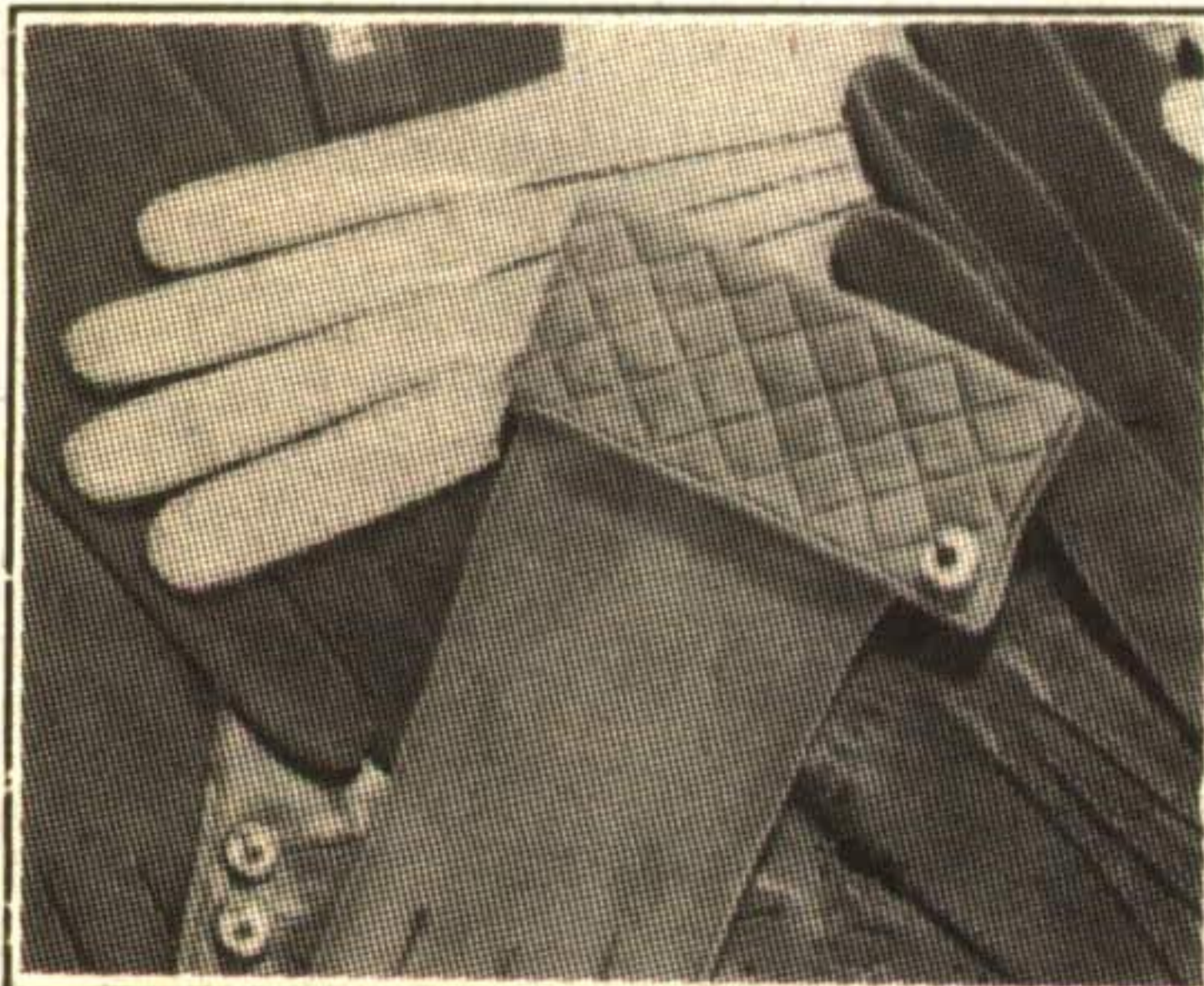
Golf ball thieves

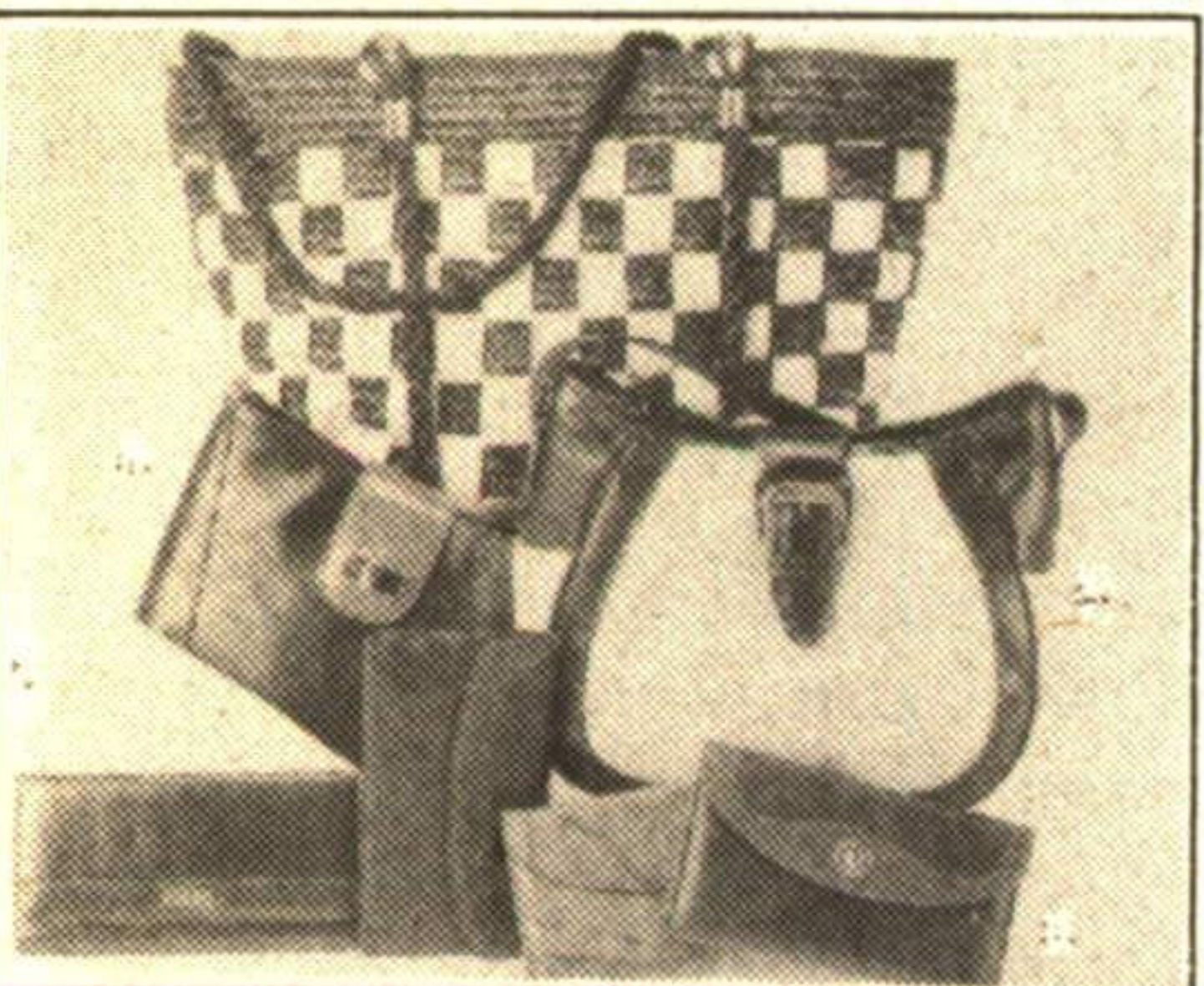
