Rockwood robbers sought

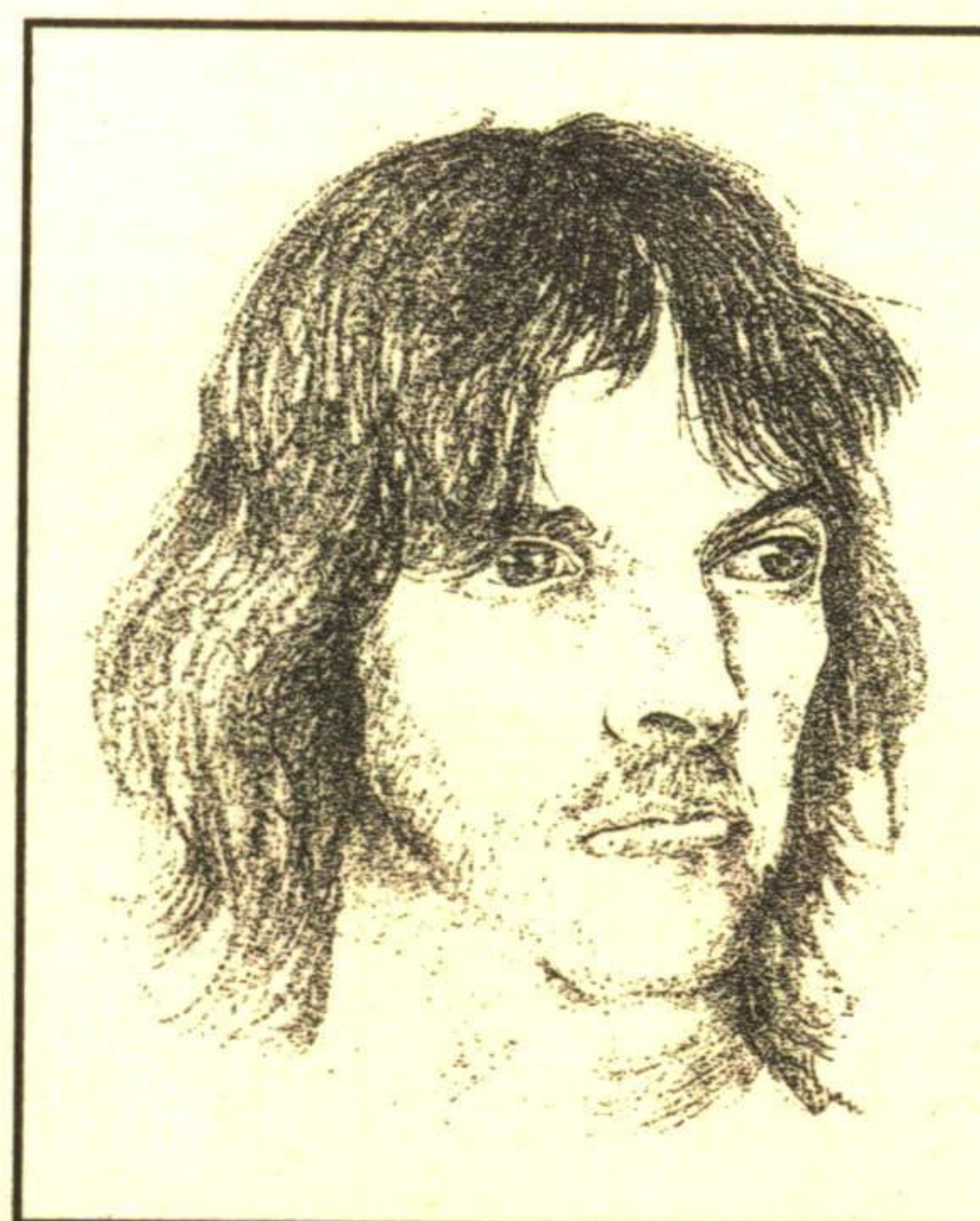
Crime Stoppers

On December 19 at 1:10 a.m. two men robbed the Rockwood Village Store in Rockwood. The robbers, brandishing a crow bar forced two store patrons to the floor and then began to remove cigarettes and cash.

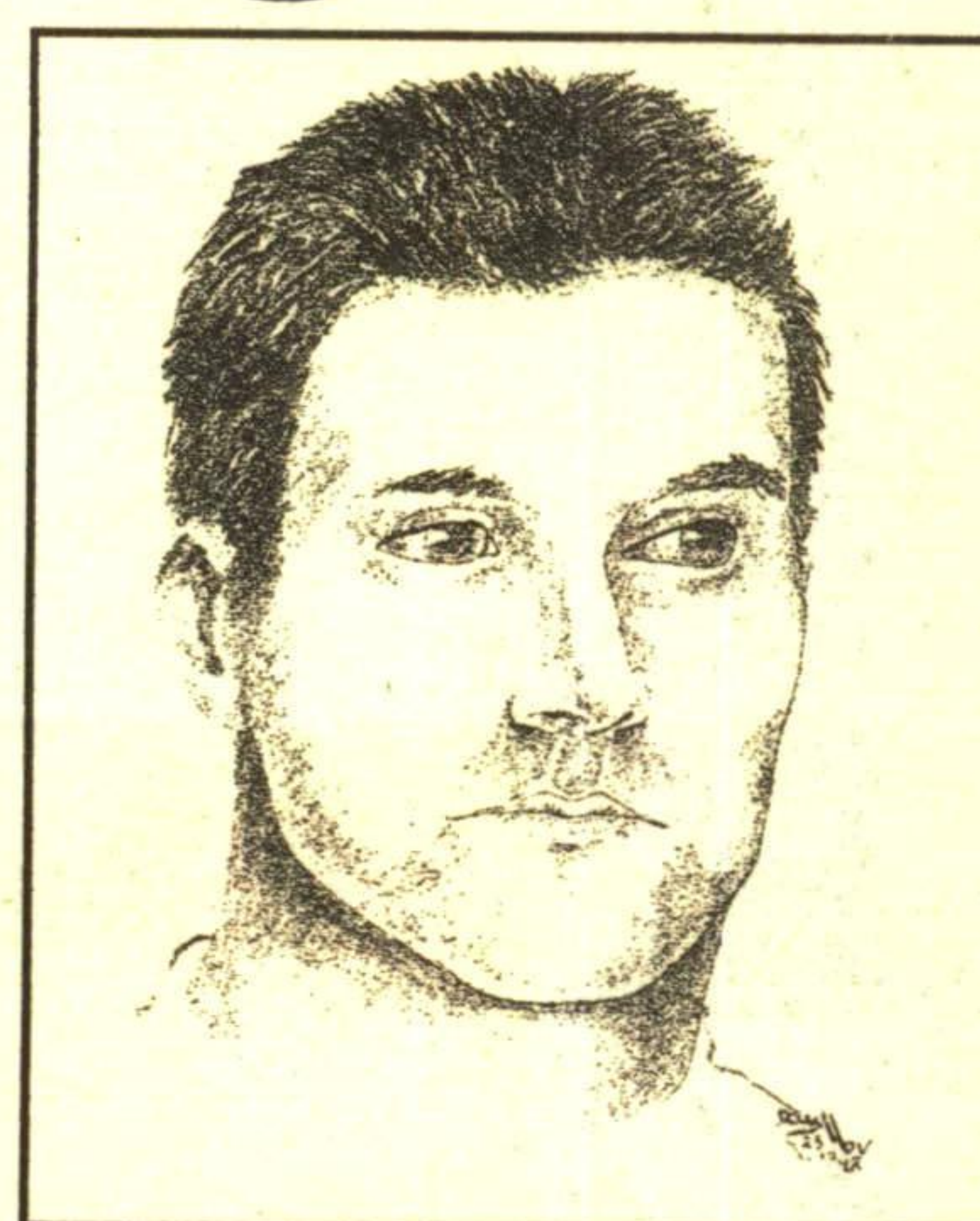
During the robbery two more patrons entered the store and one was struck with the crow bar. All the patrons were then herded into a storage room.

The bandits then fled the store. One fled in a dark colored General Motors Jimmy or Blazer. The second robber forced a local female from a V.W. Rabbit and drove out of town. The V.W. was later recovered on Highway 7, west of Rockwood.

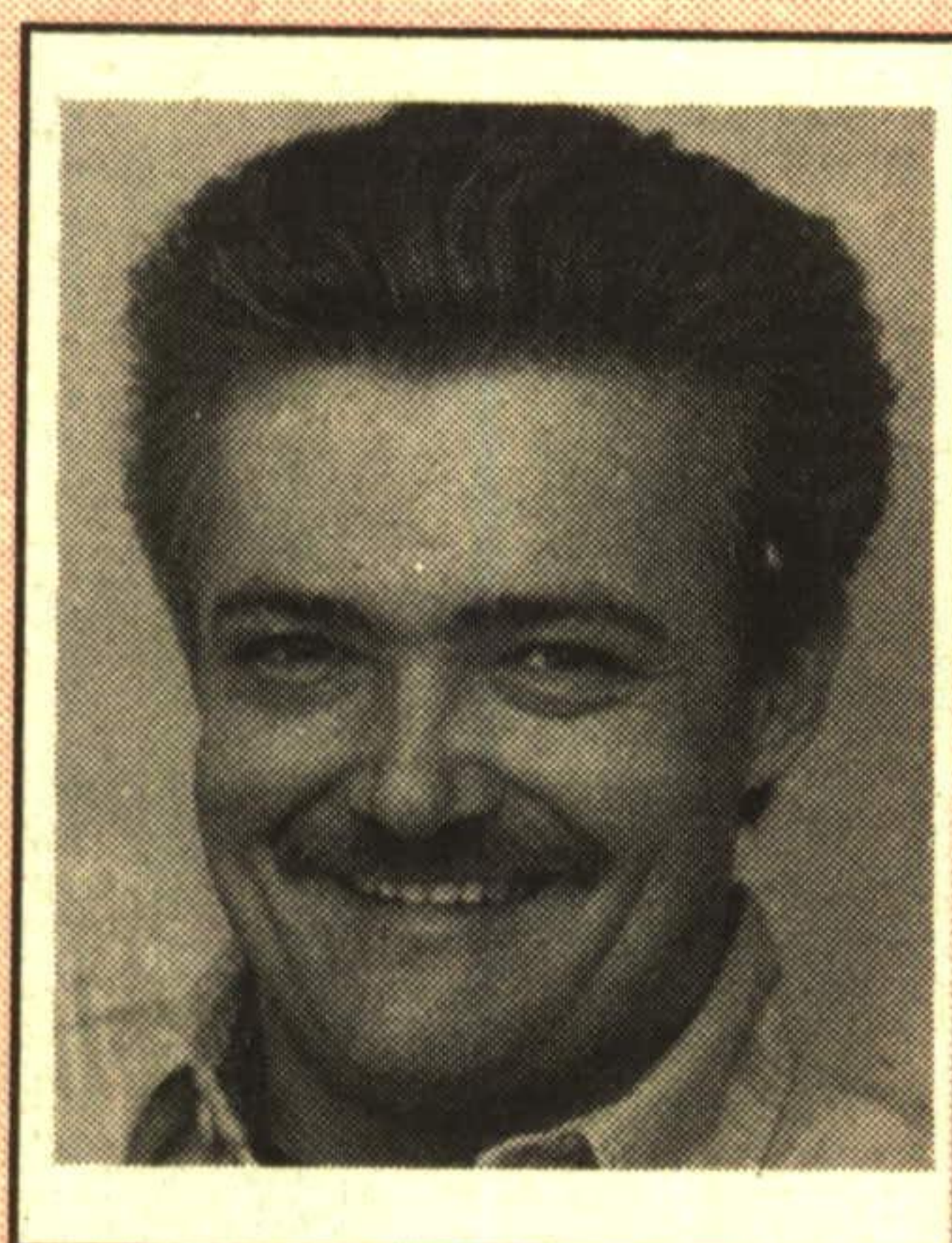

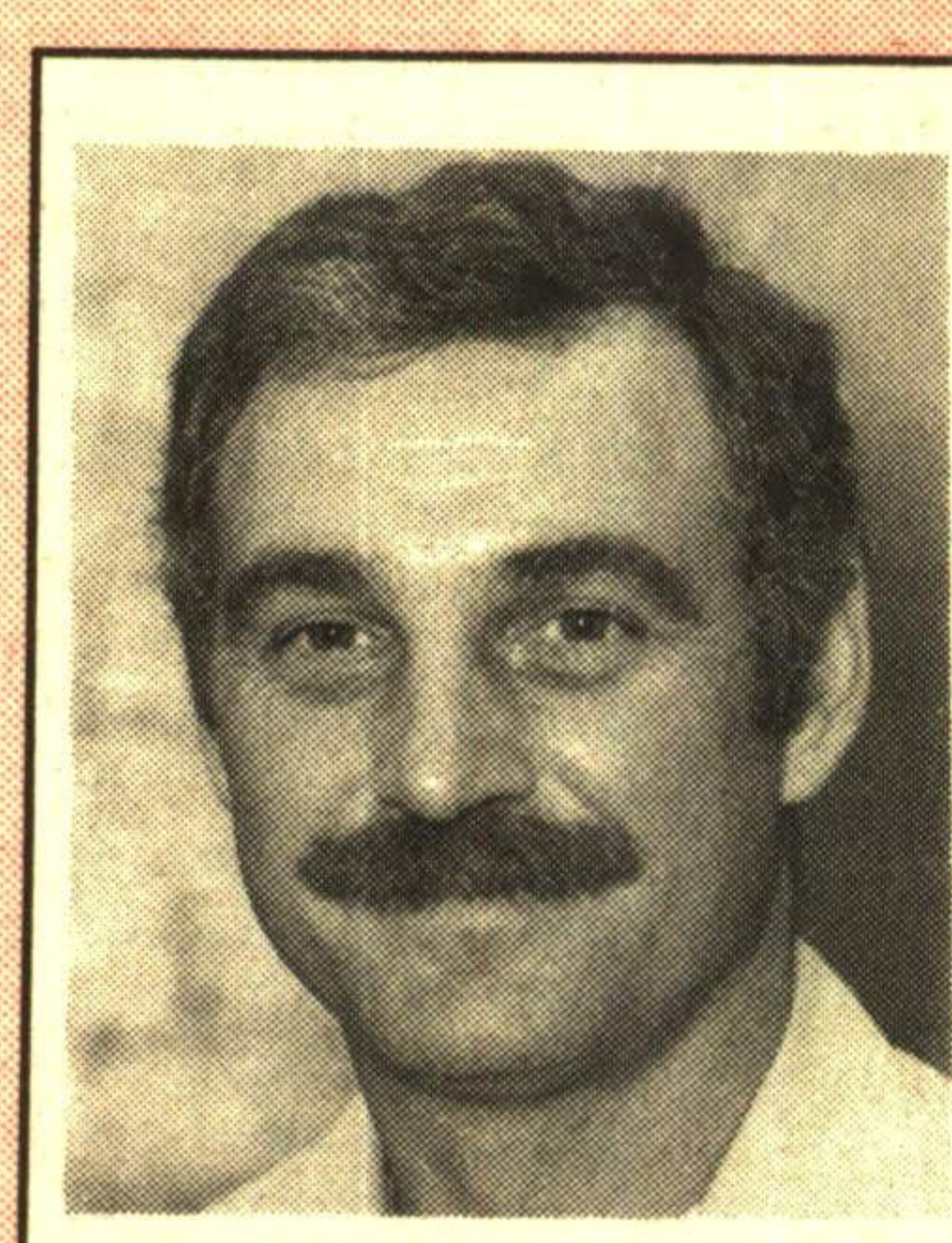
