

GREEN THUMB GARDENING

OVERCOMING GARDEN **PROBLEMS**

Did you have a few problems in your vegetable garden last season? The following contains an explanation and solution to a few problems you may have encountered last season -- they are easily corrected for this season.

 Cauliflower heads turn yellow before they matured cauliflower turns yellow when it is exposed to light. To produce clean, white curds on the head you have to eliminate its exposure to sunlight. But, don't do it too early, this can prevent the head from growing to its proper size. You should do it when the outer leaves no longer curl around and protect the head. At this time, take some of the large outer leaves and wrap them over the top of the plant and secure in place with twine and string.

Pepper plants lack peppers.

You may be amazed to learn that pepper plants grow beautifully in nutrient rich soil but do not bear a reasonable crop of peppers. Pepper are best grown in "poor" soil, especially those low in nitrogen. However, pepper production can also be reduced by cool weather during the flowering period.

Green potatoes?

Potatoes are normally white (depending on the variety) but occasionally part of the potato can be green. Do not eat any part of the potato that is green! Green coloration develops on potatoes when they are exposed to sunlight. To prevent this, once or twice throughout the growing season the plants should be "hilled up". This simply means that you should mound up a bit of soil around the base of the plant.

Black blotches on tomatoes

This condition is called Blossom-end rot. These block blotches on the bottom of the fruit is caused by fluctuations in soil moisture - from very dry to very moist. Keeping the soil evenly moist with a mulch or careful watering will prevent this from developing.
