I had no other choice (at least I thought at the time) than to unpack my handy hatchet and split the wood into kindling.

In the haste to get a warm fire going my first swing of the hatchet ended up glancing off the wood and embedding itself into the top of my right hand.

The cut didn't bleed right away, so I figured it wasn't that bad. But by the time I unpacked my first-aid kit my hand was covered in blood. It took three changes of gauze and

So how do I gather enough wood for a fire without the aid of an axe or hatchet?
