Four Georgetown District High School grapplers qualified for the Ontario Federation of School Athletic Association (OFSAA) wrestling championships, this weekend at the University of Windsor after turning in great performances at the Golden Horseshoe Athletic Conference (GHAC) championships last week.

During GHAC at Burlington Central, Mike Large, Doug Dutchburn, Jason Myers and Colin Kay all came away winners and earned the right to compete with Ontario's top wrestlers tomorrow.
