Sherwood Awards

Conservation authority honors contributions

The Halton Region Conservation Authority presented the annual Ralph Sherwood Conservation Award to three worthy recipients.

The award is named after Ralph Sherwood, a longstanding and distinguished member of the Halton Authority whose service and dedication to conservation extended over 20 years. Each year, the award is presented to people who have made outstanding contributions to conservation in the Halton watershed. The program includes three categories: Individual, Institutional and Educational.

In the Individual category, Sandy Gage was selected for his involvement in establishing a bluebird nest box program in Bronte Creek Provincial Park. As chairman and founder of the Halton Bluebird Club, he was responsible for erecting over 30 nest boxes in suitable locations throughout the park. The efforts of Gage and several other volunteers have resulted in the introduction of bluebirds back into this part of the Halton watershed. Habitat improvement programs like this have helped the bluebird population to increase throughout Southern Ontario in recent years.

In the Institutional category, the Keep the Escarpment Environment Protected Committee (KEEP) was selected for its efforts to protect and preserve the LAC Mineral property in Milton during the last few years.

The 390 acre property is located just south of the Kelso Conservation Area on prime Niagara Escarpment land. In 1992, the Authority purchased the property from LAC Minerals, a multinational mining company who had hoped to use the land to expand its limestone quarry operation located nearby.

The 2.5 million dollar property almost doubles the size of the Kelso Conservation Area. Much of the funding for the acquisition came from the Niagara Escarpment Fund that was established in 1985 to protect valuable escarpment lands. The Conservation Authority now owns almost 6,000 acres of land on the Niagara Escarpment, Ontario's most significant land form.

The property, which includes hardwood forests, wetlands and a very scenic section of the Bruce Trail, will be available for Ontario residents for generations to come.



The dedicated efforts of the KEEP Committee to protect this piece of the escarpment, including thousands of hours of valuable time and fundraising, eventually led to the acquisition by the Conservation Authority.

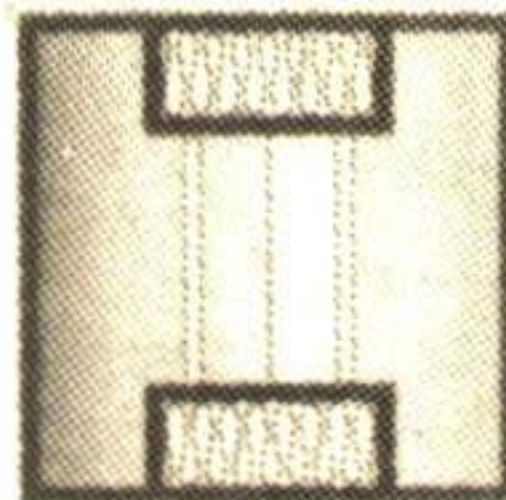
In the Education category, Dr. Bruce Hunter, a veterinarian and teacher at the Ontario Veterinary College at the University of Guelph, was selected for establishing education programs to promote greater awareness about the importance of wild bird rehabilitation and research. Dr. Hunter has also been providing technical services and advice to the hawk and owl rehabilitation program at the Mountsberg Conservation Area for more than 10 years.

Dr. Hunter's efforts and work with birds of prey at the Wild Bird Clinic at Guelph is an excellent example of how important conservation programs can help people become more aware of the environment.

The 1992 award recipients are excellent examples of how people and organizations can get involved with and make a difference for conservation concerns in Halton.

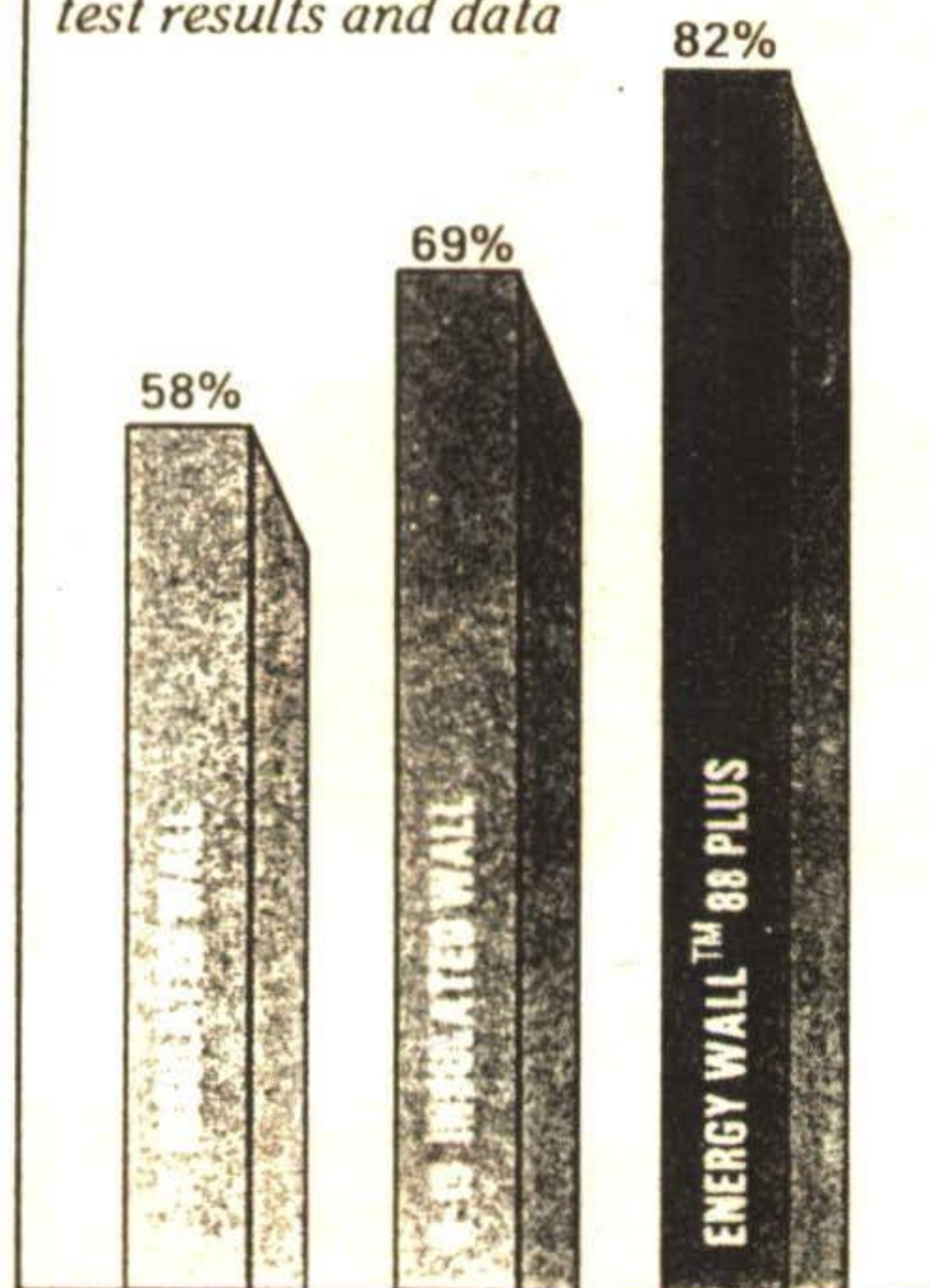

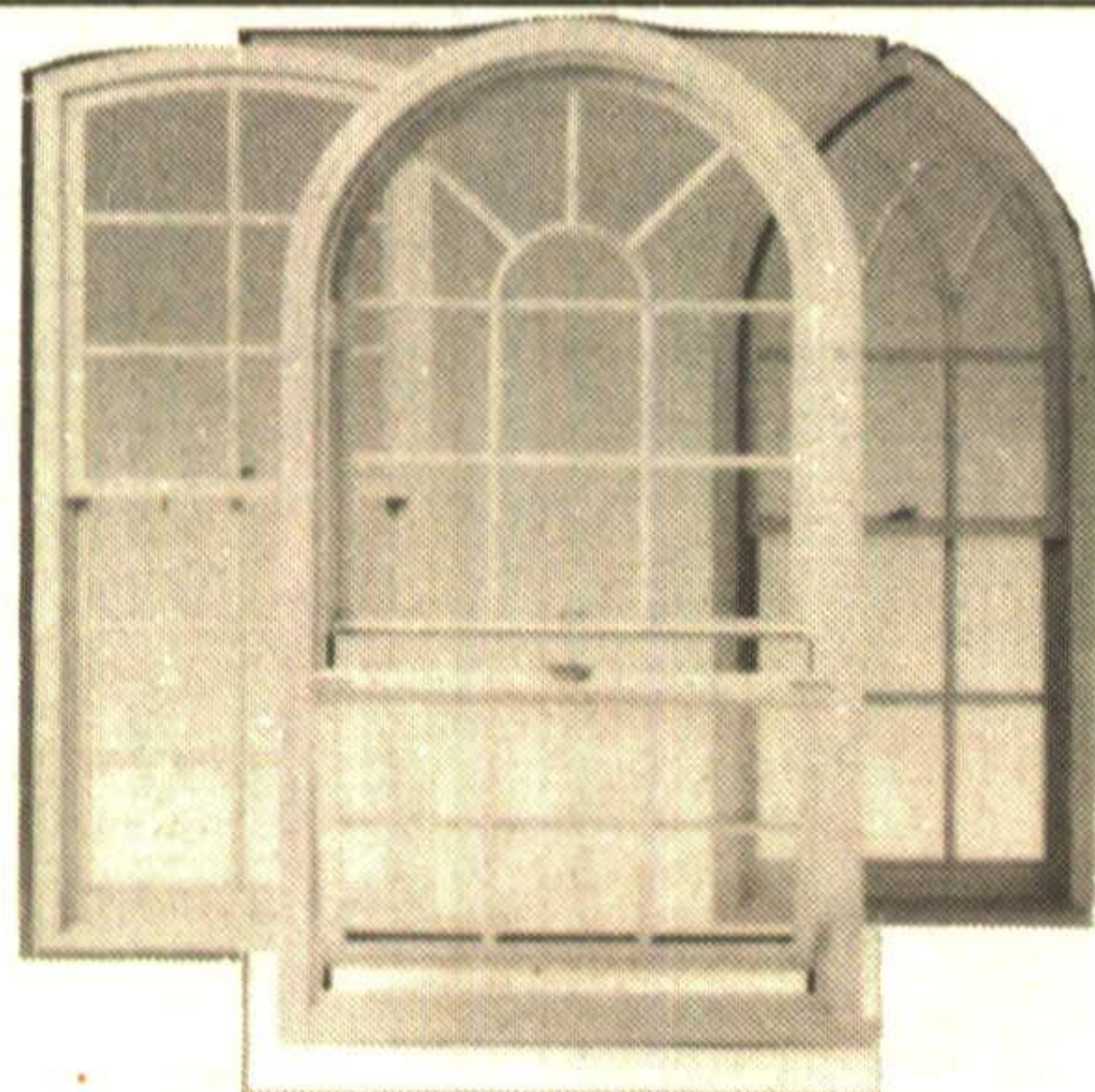

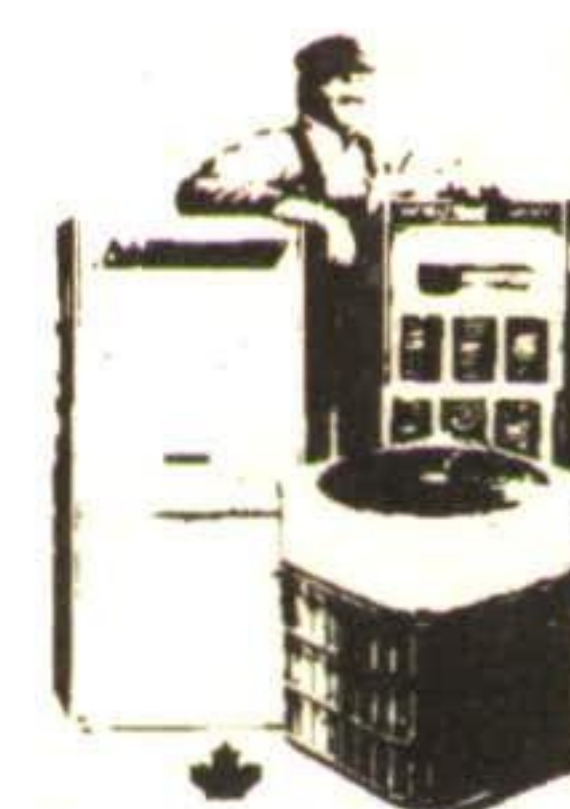
