Photographic show tickles your fancy

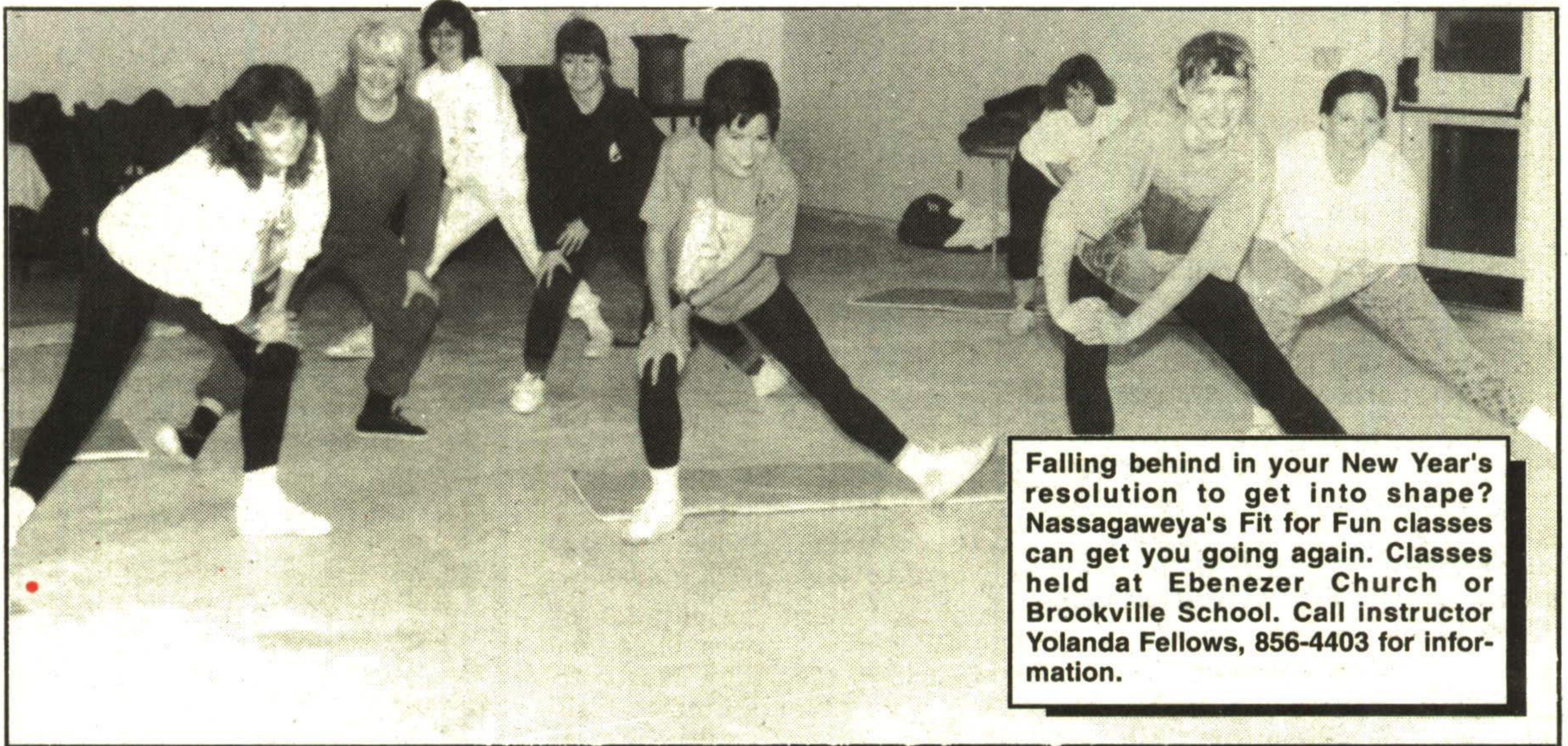
Do you believe everything you see? We all like to think that we are seeing things in the right perspective.

The Ontario Science Centre's travelling exhibition, *Optickles*, currently being shown at the Halton Region Museum, challenges your ability to see things from a different perspective.

Optickles features the work of Gera Dillon, a Toronto-based photographer. The collection of 23 photos, portraying simple everyday items, will intrigue, tantalize, or

tickle your powers of perception. A sinuous mass of fleshy brain-like folds is revealed as the cross section close-up of an ordinary red cabbage. A brown desert landscape of hills and craters turns out to be insulation sprayed on the side of a house. For those completely baffled by these visual puzzles, a peek panel comes with each of the pictures.

The Halton Region Museum presents *Optickles* until April 2. The museum is open daily, Monday to Friday, noon to 4 p.m.
