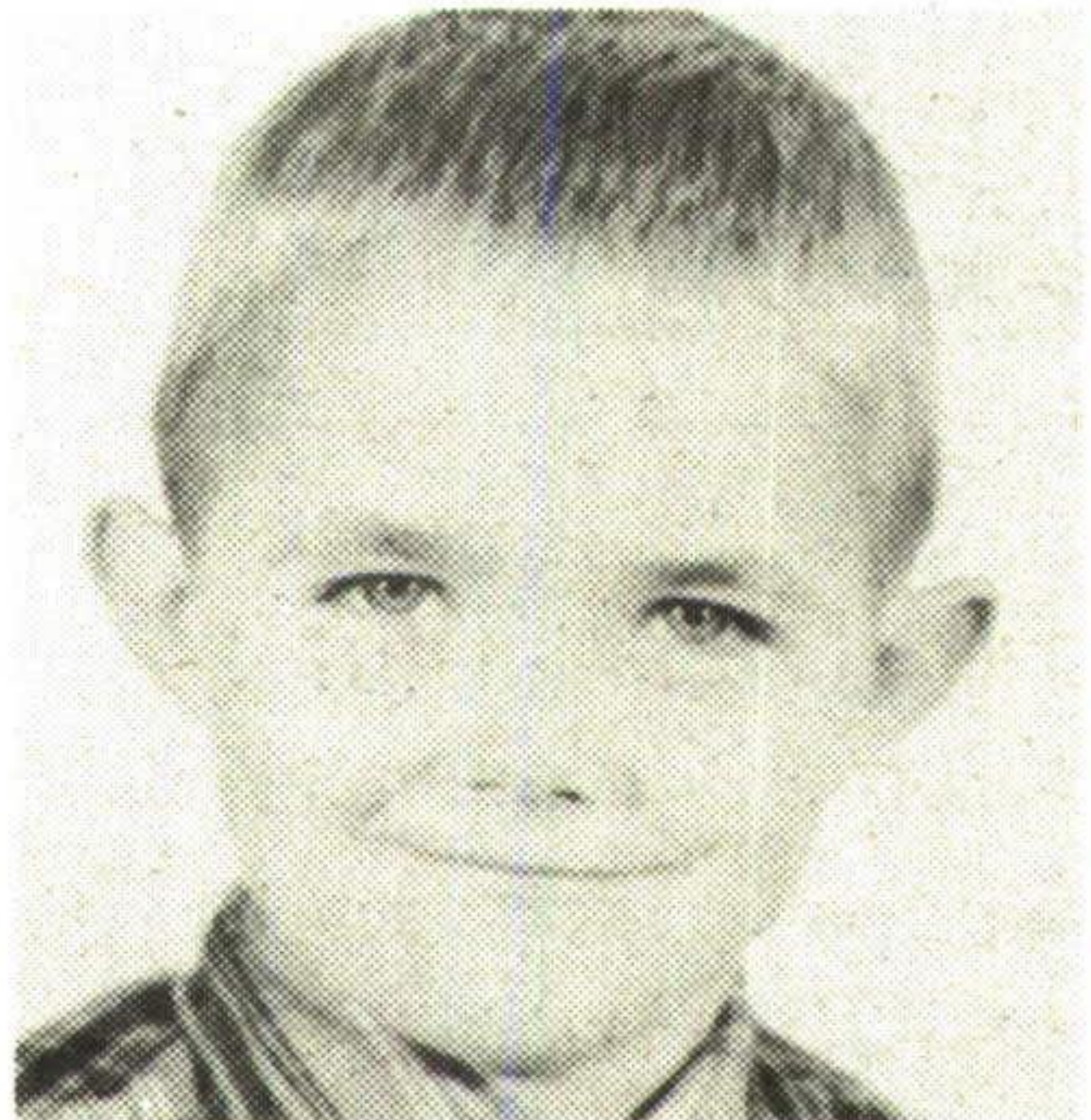

Prince attends youth musical

The National Youth Music Theatre (NYMT) of Great Britain, one of the world's most influential youth music theatre companies, comes to North America for the first time in its 16-year history when it presents *The Ragged Child* at the Oakville Centre for the Performing Arts, April 8 through 12.

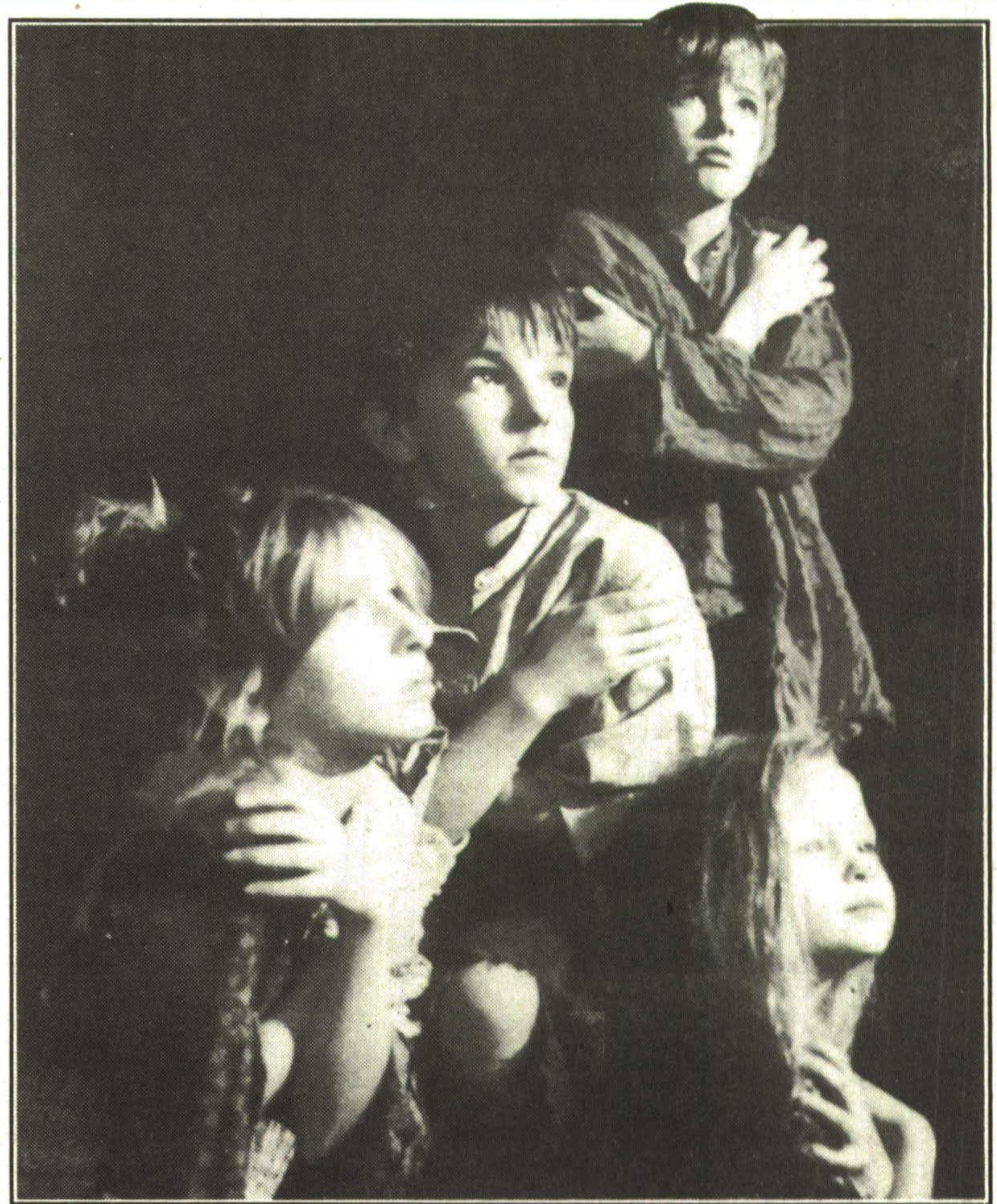
Following the Toronto engagement, the production travels to New York's Triplex Theatre for a limited engagement (April 15-17) before returning to England.

The Ragged Child is a musical romp through the gutters, the ships, the pubs, and the drawing rooms of Dickensian London. It chronicles the heartwarming story of Joe and Annie Cooper, two destitute children living in the underbelly of England. Into this existence entered John Pounds - a crippled cobbler whose small shop and weird stature

served to unite the young urchins. Using popular music of the time and pulling no punches, the production is spectacular and simple, hard-hitting and sympathetic, tragic, comic and full of pathos and sadness.

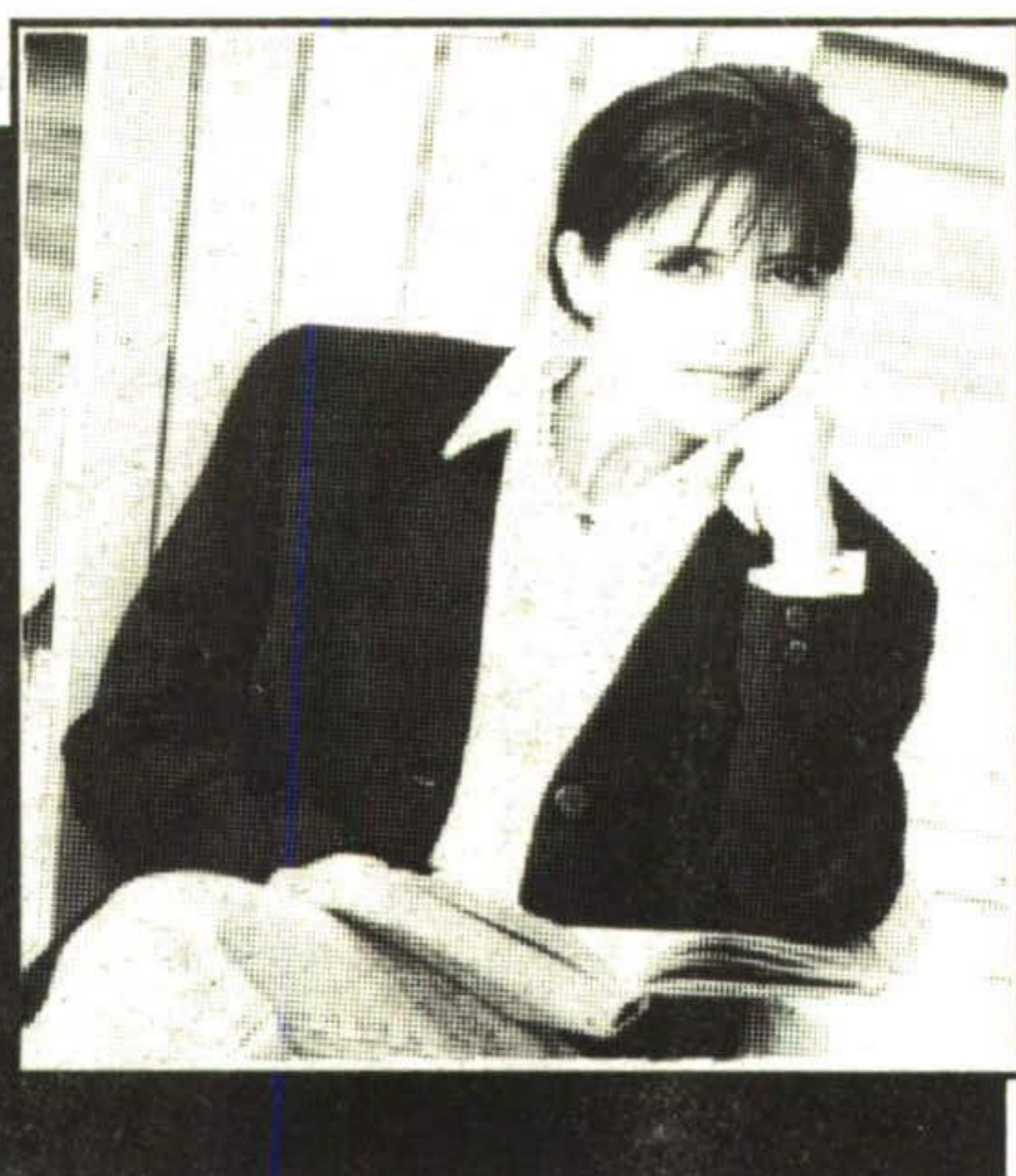

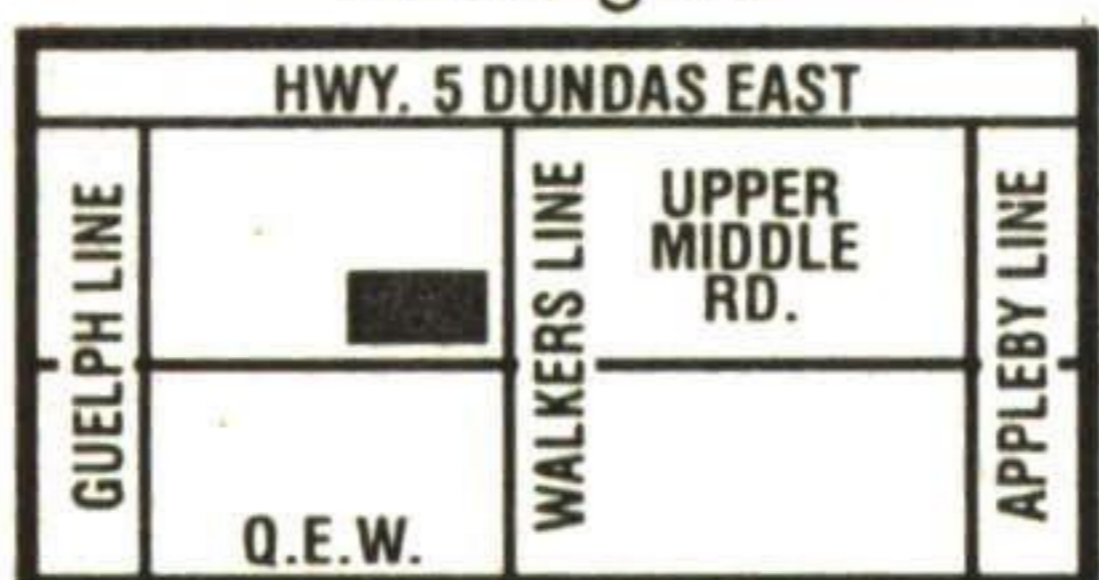
