Dr. Wilson will be sadly missed by the community she served for so many years.

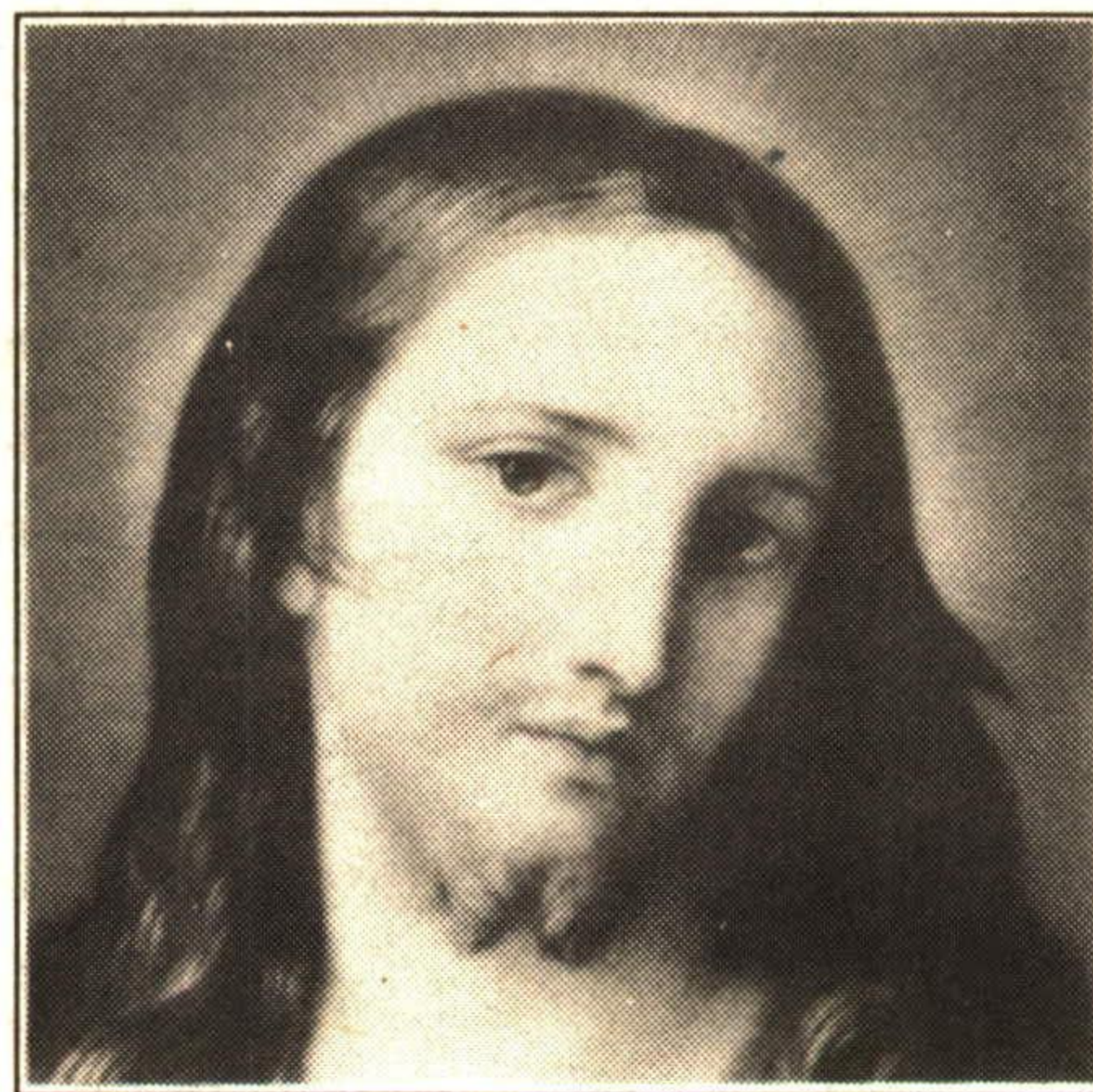

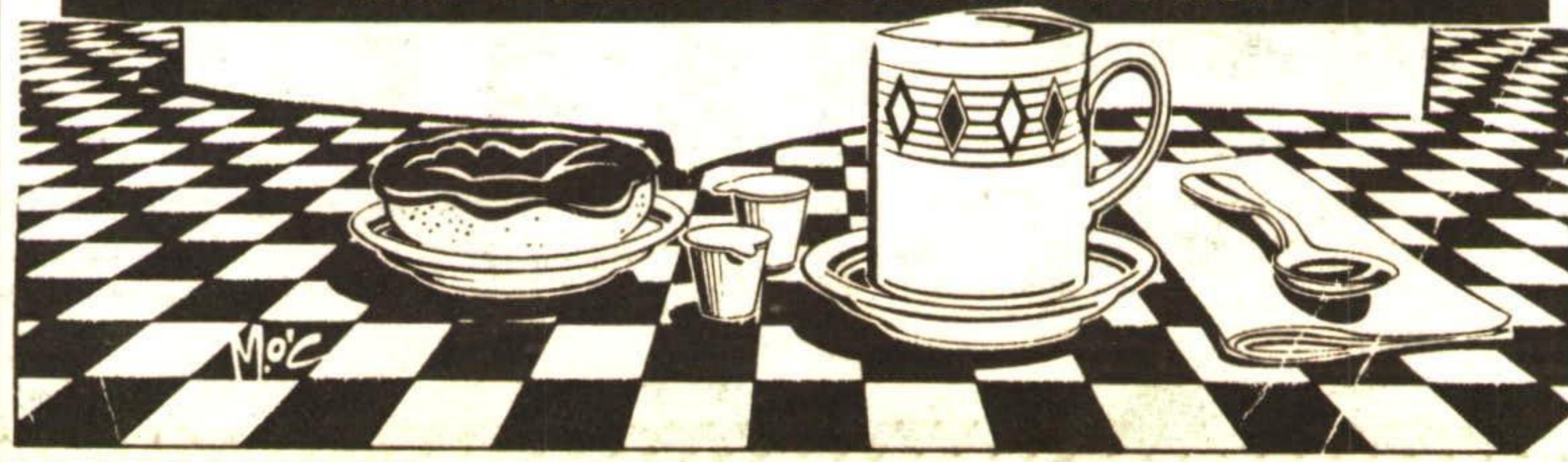
