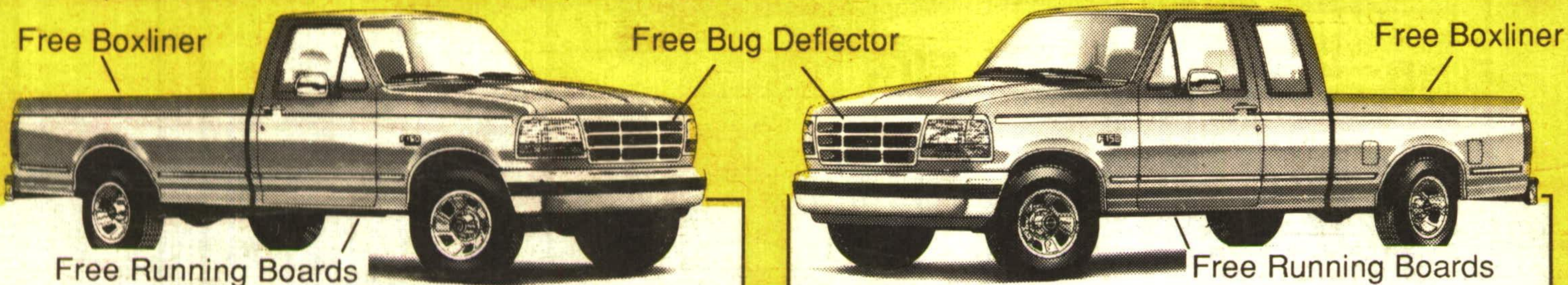

## GREEN THUMB GARDENING

### SPRING IN THE GARDEN

• Apply Crabgrass Killer when Forsythias are in bloom.

• Apply Dormant Oil Spray before buds break on shrubs, trees & roses. This the most important application of the season since it eliminates any overwintering insects and diseases. Note: on day of application the temperature must remain above 0°C.

• Remove winter protection from evergreens and mulch from roses slowly over a period of a week or two. (preferably on clam, cloudy days). If done too quickly they could show signs of exposure.

• Do not prune Maple or Birch trees in late winter. Since they "bleed" profusely at this time. These trees are better left until they are fully leafed out (late spring).

• Pansies are a very hardy annual that can be planted out now for quick spring color that will last throughout the spring and summer.

• Apply pruning paste or paint to shrubs and trees that have been damaged by mice and rabbits. And that have had their bark removed completely around the stem will not survive.

• Transplant and/or divide any perennials that are growing in the wrong location or are getting too large.

• Do not prune spring flowering shrubs such as forsythia, lilac, rhododendron, etc. until they have finished blooming.
