

# Klipper Wilco wins Series

There was only one surprise in the \$53,000 final of the Princess Pacing Series at Mohawk Raceway on Sunday night.

The least surprising was the outcome as favorite Klipper Wilco paced to a lifetime best 1:55.4 mile for the father-son team of trainer Chris Christoforou and driver Chris Jr. to sweep the entire series.

The fact that she didn't control the mile was the biggest surprise but the Falcon Seelster filly Falcons Wish left so hard and fast from the outside eight hole, Chris and his filly really didn't stand a chance.

"I would have rather had her on the front, but Roger's horse (Falcons Wish) left so quickly I don't think we could have beat her," explained Christoforou Jr.

The trip worked out well as Klipper Wilco enjoyed a pocket trip despite not picking up the lines until past the half. That translated into a three-length gap between her and the leader at the :27.4 quarter and the :56.4 half.

"She's sometimes a hard horse to keep interested in the race unless she has the lead," continued Christoforou, "she hesitated a little bit when I first tried to get her rolling. But once she gets to the front, she's very game."

Klipper Wilco took over past the three-quarters which was reached in 1:27 and cruised to a two-length win over Classic Wish and On Fire

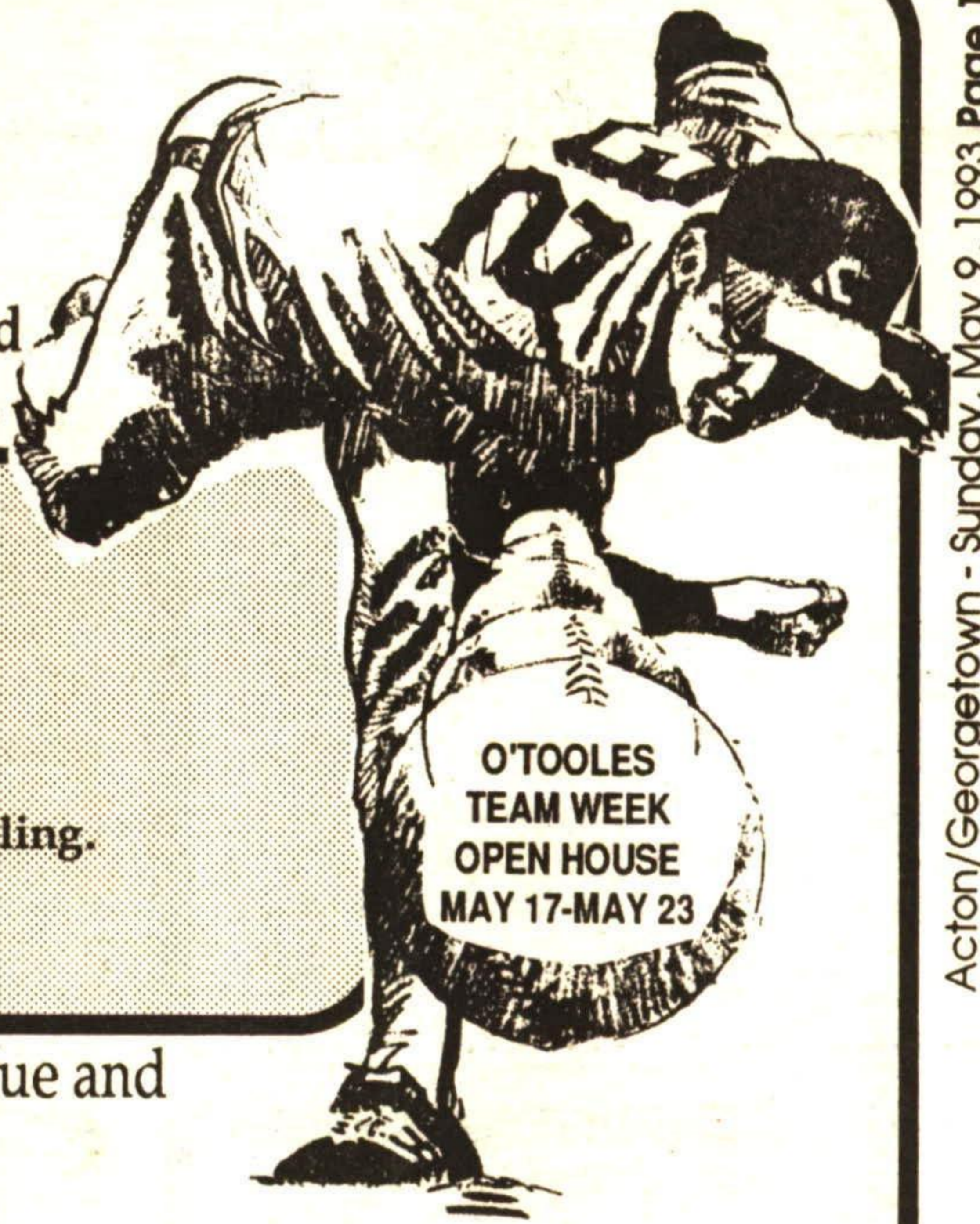

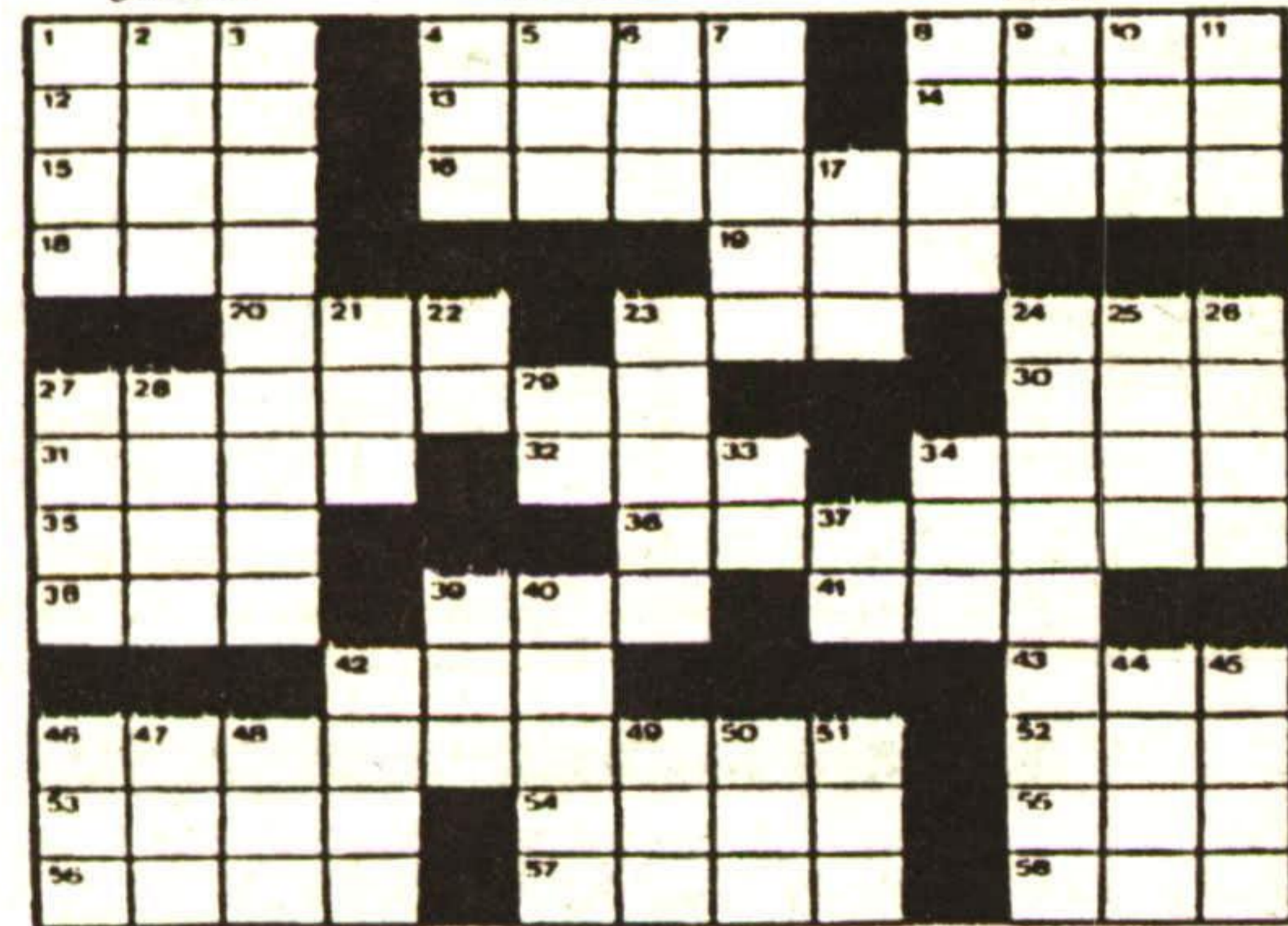
