Star in 'Beauty and the Beast' Dancers prepare for the future

Allisson Bobor and Adele Campbell are dance students at the Halton Hills School of Dance and both plan to have careers in danc-

"I would love to go to Concordia University in Montreal in the dance program," said 16-year-old Campbell. "I'd love to be a choreographer, and teach in Europe."

Bobor also wants to study dance at university, become a certified teacher and then own her own dance studio. She'is the choreografor the Georgetown Gymnastics Club. The Grade 10 student at Georgetown and District High School began dancing when she was just four years old and now at 15 has already been teaching for two years. She and Campbell have

been dancing together since they were 8 or 9 years old. Campbell is in Grade 12 at Mayfield High School, a performing arts school.

"A few years ago we were at the stage where we competed a lot. Now we're almost like sisters, we live practically together, we help each other out a lot," Bobor said.

Since this is the end of the dance year, they practise four or five hours each day, including weekends. The two girls are performing the lead roles in the Halton Hills School of Dancing production of Beauty and the Beast, which will be at John Elliott Theatre June 11, 12 and 13. Campbell is playing the part of Beauty while Bobor will be the Beast.

Last month the two competed in the Dance Masters of America competition in Toronto. Bobor earned a gold medal for her performance of Recipe of Love by Harry Connick Jr., a dance which she choreographed herself. As dance partners they came away with two silver medals, one for their performance of Jazz Hot and another for performing Georgia.

"When I'm performing, I let everything go. It's a great way to express feelings and get frustrations out," Campbell said. Bobor also said her favorite part of dancing is performing.

The previous year was the first time they competed in the Dance Masters of America competition.

"Last year I was so nervous, I thought I was going to throw up," Bobor said. "Our goal (this year) was to beat last year's standing. We did better than we thought."

They performed for an audience of 600 to 700, and there were about 75 competitors in each category.

The girls will be performing along with the rest of their studio on June 11 at 7:30 p.m., Saturday at 2:30 p.m., and 7:30 p.m. and Sunday at 2:30 p.m. Tickets are available from the Halton Hills School of Dancing at 142 Mill St. in Georgetown at 877-1581. They are \$6.50 for adults and \$4 for children.
