

# Nassagaweya forms Community Consultation Committee

If you live in former Nassagaweya Township and have any specific concerns relating to the quality of life in this area, you now have another source of potential help.

The Nassagaweya Community Consultation Committee, consisting of private citizens and the police, was established in 1992 as a vital part of Halton Community Policing Program for the Nassagaweya/Campbellville areas.

The committee is tangible evidence of the community policing philosophy that police officers and private citizens can work together in creative ways to help solve problems related to crime, fear of crime, social and physical disorder, and neighborhood decay.

Steve Wood, 1993 chairman, says "We're in a good position to provide help relatively quickly, by alerting the proper authority that a problem exists."

Citizens of rural Milton with concerns about any of these problems are encouraged to contact a member of the committee, with the assurance that these concerns will

be looked at and further action instituted to alleviate the problem if at all possible. The committee has regularly scheduled meetings every two months, excluding July and August.

Typical items on the agenda range from illegal parking to garbage dumping on roadsides and private property.

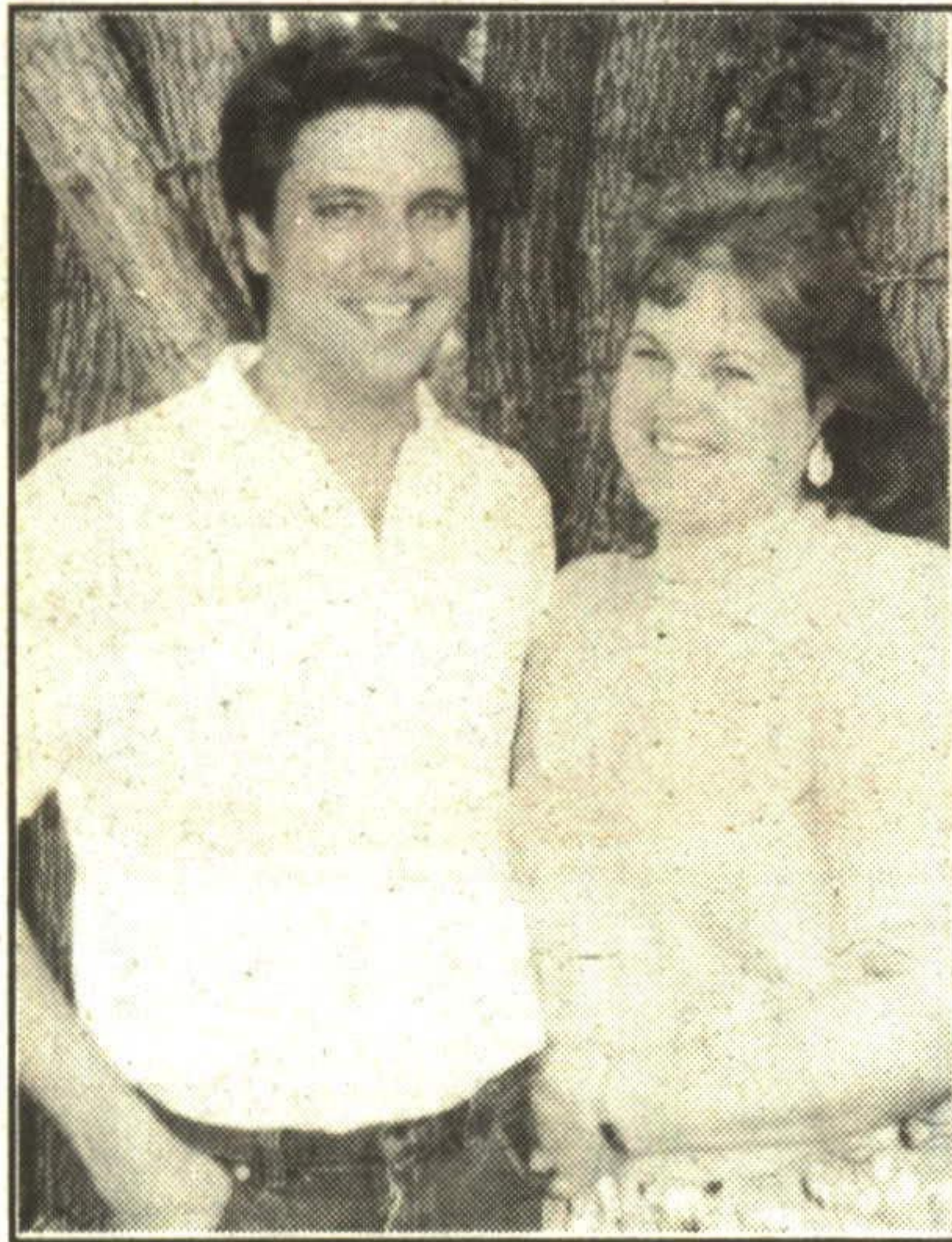
