Cornwell, McGowan named to special health committee

Betsy Cornwell and Eunice McGowan will represent Halton Hills on the Halton District Health Council's Long Term Care Committee.

Betsy Cornwell is chief executive officer for the Halton Hills Library and an Acton resident. Betsy is currently a member of the Healthy Lifestyles Coalition, chairing the Nutrition Data base Group, two literacy boards and recently competed the term of membership on the Elderly Services Advisory Committee.

Eunice McGowan is the social worker/discharge planner for Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital. Eunice has worked provincially to establish the Community Home Support Association and previously was executive director of Halton Helping Hands. Eunice was a member of the District Health Council from 1982-1989.

Vacancy still exists on the council for a Halton Hills senior receiving services.

District Health Councils were directed by the Ministers of Health, Community and Social Services and the Ministry of Citizenship to establish these committees. Over 100 people from

across the region applied to join the committee.

Members were chosen on the basis of a number of factors including geographic representation, knowledge and skills. The members also bring a variety of experiences in the home setting, in the community and from institutions. A balance of health and social service perspectives exists among the members.

The committee will plan for services for seniors, persons with physical disabilities and people of all ages who require health services at home, the workplace or in schools.

The plan will also have an emphasis on maintaining health and well-being. Key to supporting seniors and persons with physical disabilities to remain in the community will be the development of plans for supportive housing, respice care and other community based services.

One of the key components of this planning process will be the design and development of a multi-service agency that will provide a 'single point of entry' for consumers who require long term care services for Halton.
