

Truck and tractor pull at Acton fair

The Acton Fall Fair in '93 will once again be sponsoring its popular Truck and Tractor Pull, on Sunday afternoon, Sept. 19.

The Sunday afternoon Truck and Tractor Pull runs from 1 p.m. till almost closing time. People can come and go, and may rejoin the excitement at any point while at the fair.

In 1992 the Truck and Tractor Pull proved so popular that a Saturday night was added to give more people a chance to join in. At 6:30 a Lawn and Garden Tractor Show will compete in 2 classes 12

h.p. and under and 12 h.p. and up to 20 h.p. Prizes of \$25, \$20, \$15 plus a trophy will be awarded in each class.

At 8:30 Giant Highway Trucks will compete in 2 classes. Prizes of \$50, \$40, \$30 plus a trophy will also be awarded.

On Sunday the ever popular Truck and Tractor Show starts at 1 p.m. with weigh in from 10-11:30 p.m.

The Show has 3 sections: Antique Tractors over 25 years, Our at Field - Today's Workhorse and 4X4 Pickup Trucks.

Confusing to the novice, it is very simple to follow. One vehicle is hooked to a weight boat. As the boat is pulled down the track a graduating weigh increases till it can no longer be moved forward, which causes the pulling vehicle to grind to a halt. "He who can pull the furthest wins" Simple!

Starting with the lightest weight pulled first, more weights are gradually added as the pullers increase in size and horsepower.

The popular 4X4 Trucks join in when the weight being pulled reaches their range of capability.

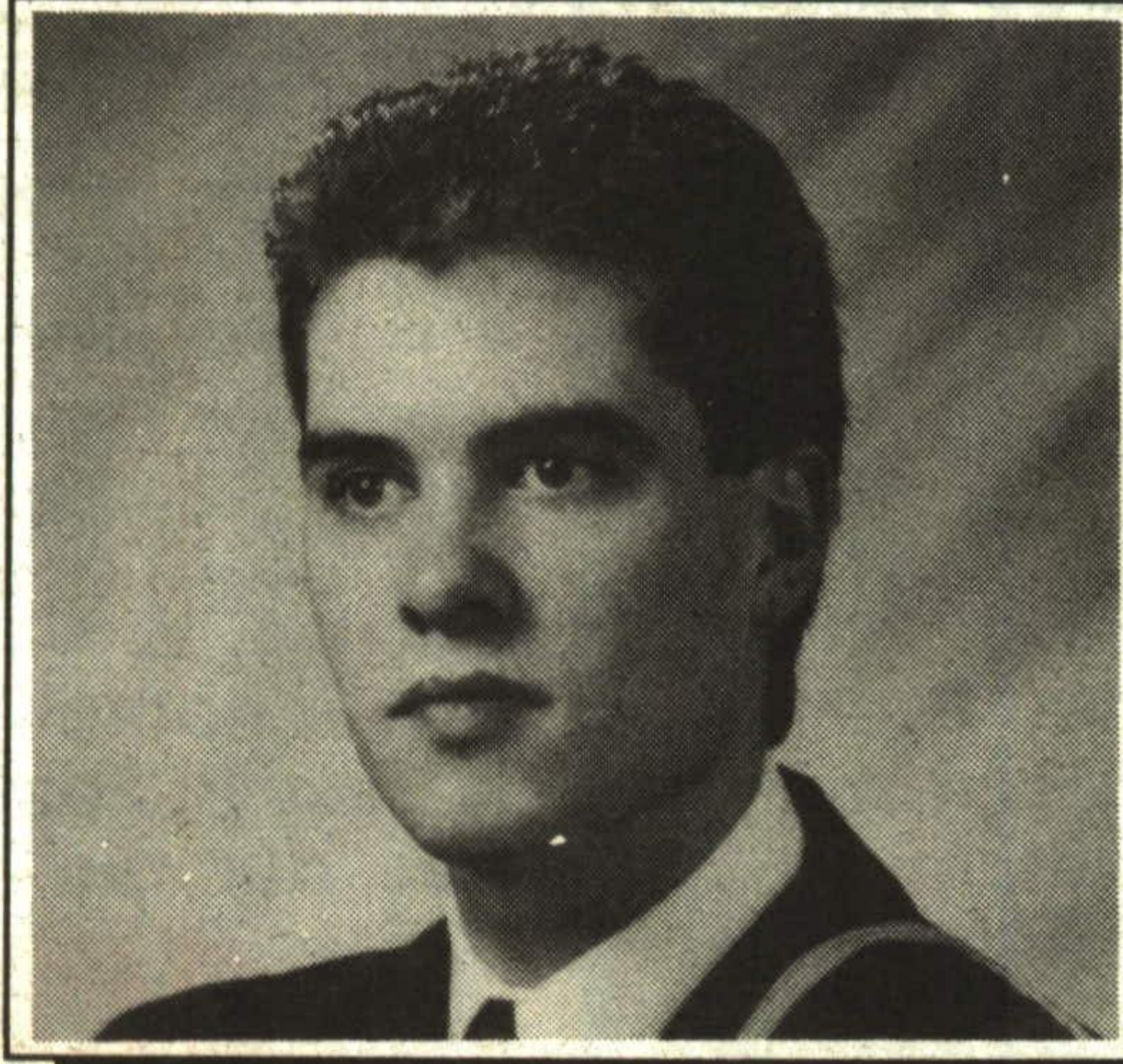

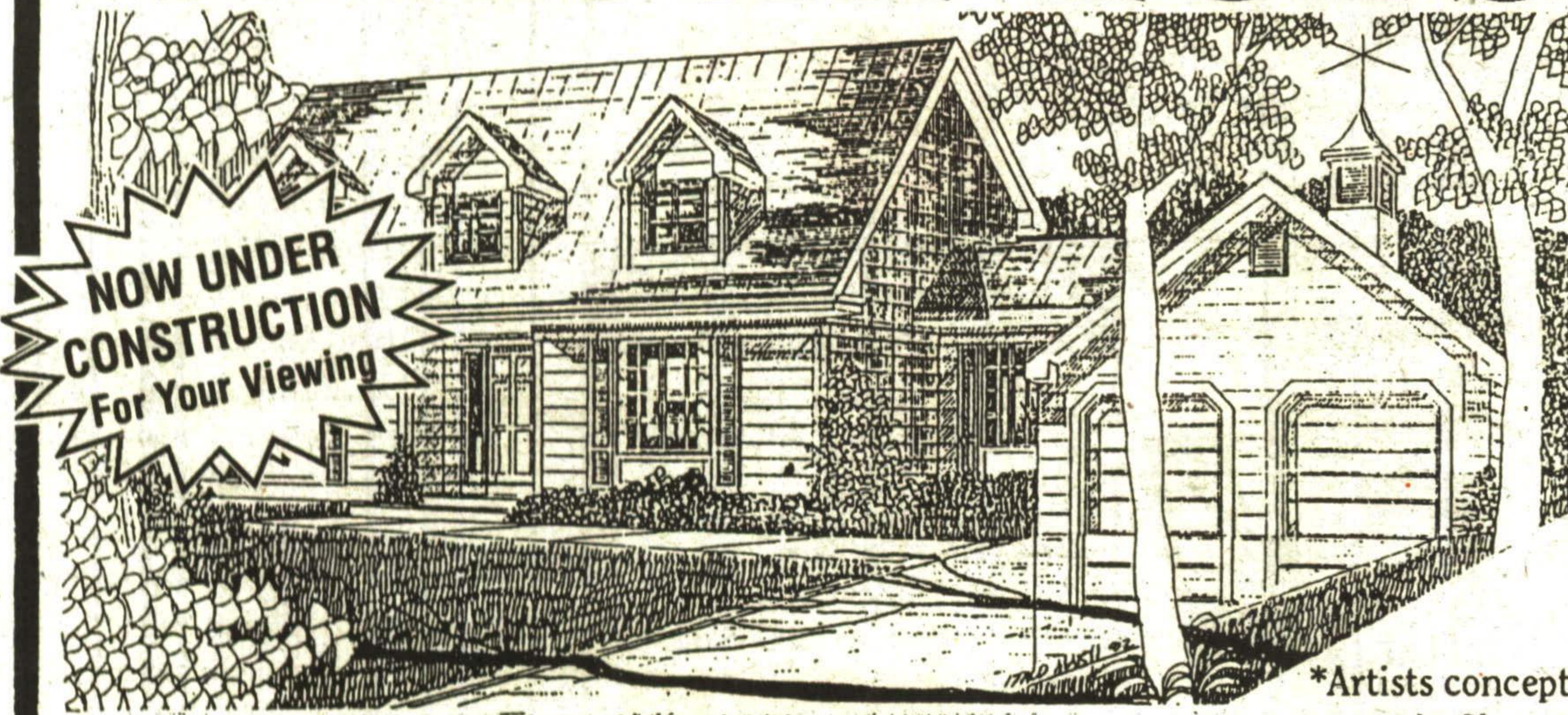
Paul is planning to continue his B.A. programme at Lakehead University (2nd year) while hopefully working part-time in his chosen career.
