## Seeing the unseen in new photography exhibit

Seeing the unseen through photography is the subject of Apercu: Unseen Visions, a new exhibit opening at the Halton Region Museum September 13.

Consisting of 24 photographs, the exhibit, which is on loan from the National Archives of Canada, explores ways in which photography expands human ability to see.

Like the human eye, photography shows depth, movement, and color, unlike that of humans, however, the photographic eye can stay open for longer periods to record what we can not see. Pluto and its moon Charon were both discovered in this century as traces of light in photographs.

IN HOME

Photography also captures movement too quick for humans to appreciate. While the eye sees a high jumper going over the bar, and the human mind is able to recall the action as a whole, only the camera captures a lasting image of the high jumper in mid-air.

Apercu: Unseen Visions also explores the capabilities of photography to use non-visible light in beneficial ways. The discovery of X rays in 1895 has made it possible to look inside the human body without the use of invasive surgery. Computer-produced images using infared light can be used in remote sensing. In ordinary photography, infared light helps surveyors work

on hazy days.

Apercu: Unseen Visions will be on display at the Halton Region Museum from September 13 to December 17.

The museum is open daily Monday to Friday from noon to 4 p.m.

It is located west of Milton in Kelso Conservation Area, on Regional Road 28. Admission is by voluntary donation.
