## American Winner doesn't disappoint

Hambletonian champion American Winner didn't disappoint fans at Mohawk Raceway Saturday as he trotted with ease to a 1:58.3 victory in the first \$112,108 Simcoe division for sophomore colts.

Leaving from post five, American Winner assumed command of the field within a quarter mile and trotted to a 59-second half and 1:29.3 three-quarter mark enroute to a one and three quarter length victory.

Ontario Sires Stakes star Oaklea Bluejay was second and Frank's Folly took show money. "I didn't have to press him at all," said win-

ning driver Ron Pierce. "He did it easily. He just floated."

It was win number 14 in 17 starts for the colt that has never finished worse than third this year. The horse has banked \$1.2 million for owners Robert Kay and John Glesmann.

With victories in the Yonkers Trot as well as Hambletonian,

American Winner has two-thirds of the Trotting Triple Crown to his credit, with the Kentucky Futurity looming on the horizon in early October.

Should he win that event, he will become the first Triple Crown champ since his sire, Super Bowl, in 1972.

"Early in the season we figured winning the Triple Crown was just a dream," said Pierce. Now, however, "I feel very confident about my horse's chances."

American Winner's stablemate, Hi Noon Star, trotted to a 1:58.2 win in the first \$112,107 Simcoe division.

## Controlled hunt planned for Orangeville

Details of the controlled waterfowl hunt at the Orangeville Reservoir were released this week.

Fourteen blinds will be available on a first come first served basis again this year starting on Saturday, September 25. As in the past, hunting times are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4 p.m. to 1/2 hour after sunset and on Saturdays from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 11 a.m. and again from 3 p.m. to 1/2 hour after sunset. This year, to help meet the demand for quality hunting opportunities, hunting has been extended into November on Saturdays only, again with morning and afternoon hunts.

Hunters can register for the 14 blinds available at the gatehouse in the Conservation Area. Some of the blinds are accessible by boat only and all hunters must have either a dog or a boat to ensure retrieval of downed birds. No gasoline powered motors are allowed on the Reservoir.

To help promote the Saturday afternoon hunts, hunters will be charged \$15 to register for both the morning and afternoon hunting periods.

The Orangeville Reservoir is located on Hurontario Street off Buena Vista at the Highway 10 lights in Orangeville.
