Leaving from post five, American Winner assumed command of the field within a quarter mile and trotted to a 59-second half and 1:29.3 three-quarter mark enroute to a one and three quarter length victory.

Controlled hunt planned for Orangeville

Details of the controlled waterfowl hunt at the Orangeville Reservoir were releasedthis week.

Fourteen blinds will be available on a first come first served basis again this year starting on Saturday, September 25. As in the past, hunting times are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4 p.m. to 1/2 hour after sunset and on Saturdays from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 11 a.m. and again from 3 p.m. to 1/2 hour after sunset. This year, to help meet the demand for quality hunting opportunities, hunting has been extended into November on Saturdays only, again with morning and afternoon hunts.

Hunters can register for the 14 blinds available at the gatehouse in the Conservation Area. Some of the blinds are accessible by boat only and all hunters must have either a dog or a boat to ensure retrieval of downed birds. No gasoline powered motors are allowed on the Reservoir.

To help promote the Saturday afternoon hunts, hunters will be charged \$15 to register for both the morning and afternoon hunting periods.

The Orangeville Reservoir is located on Hurontario Street off Buena Vista at the Highway 10 lights in Orangeville.
