"As well, there will be staff on hand to demonstrate some of the newest clinical services now available to the community."

Georgetown Hospital has been the recipient of many generous financial donations from the community. As a result, the health care institution has enhanced its services with additional new equipment such as a cardiac stress-testing machine, centralized cardiac monitoring system for the Intensive Care Unit, laparoscopic equipment used in surgical procedures, pain control pumps for monitoring pain, the latest in mammography equipment, and new additions to the Obstetrics Ward.

These examples of the many recent improvements made at the hospital will be on display for the public.

Also included in the behind-the-scenes visit will be a tour of the Emergency Department, Laboratory, X-Ray, Obstetrics and Rehabilitation.

The one-hour-long tours will then wrap up with the unveiling of the hospital's three-year Accreditation Certificate, an award that places Georgetown Hospital among the top hospitals in Canada.

Refreshments will be available in the boardroom, and visitors are encouraged to stop by and view the new boardroom.

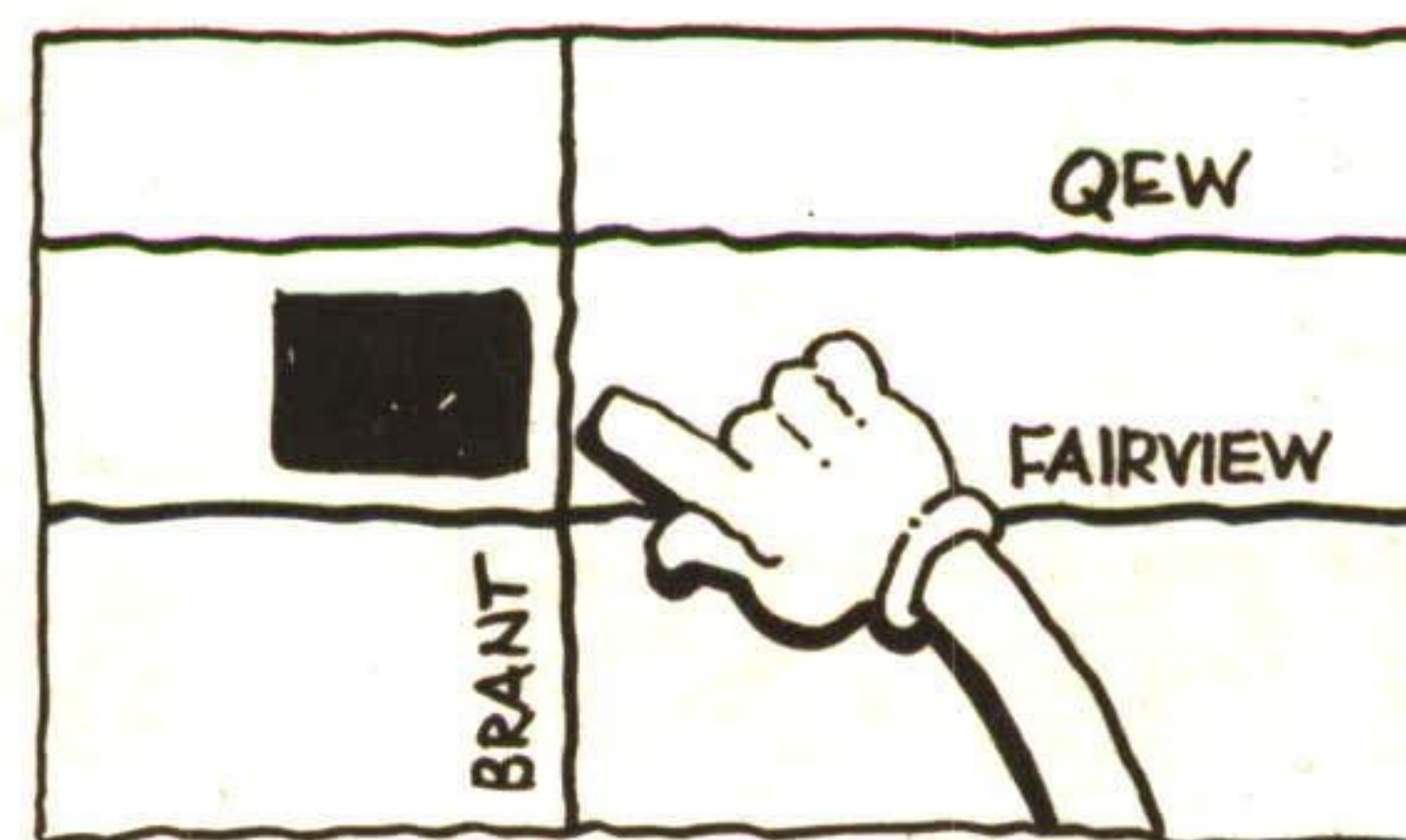
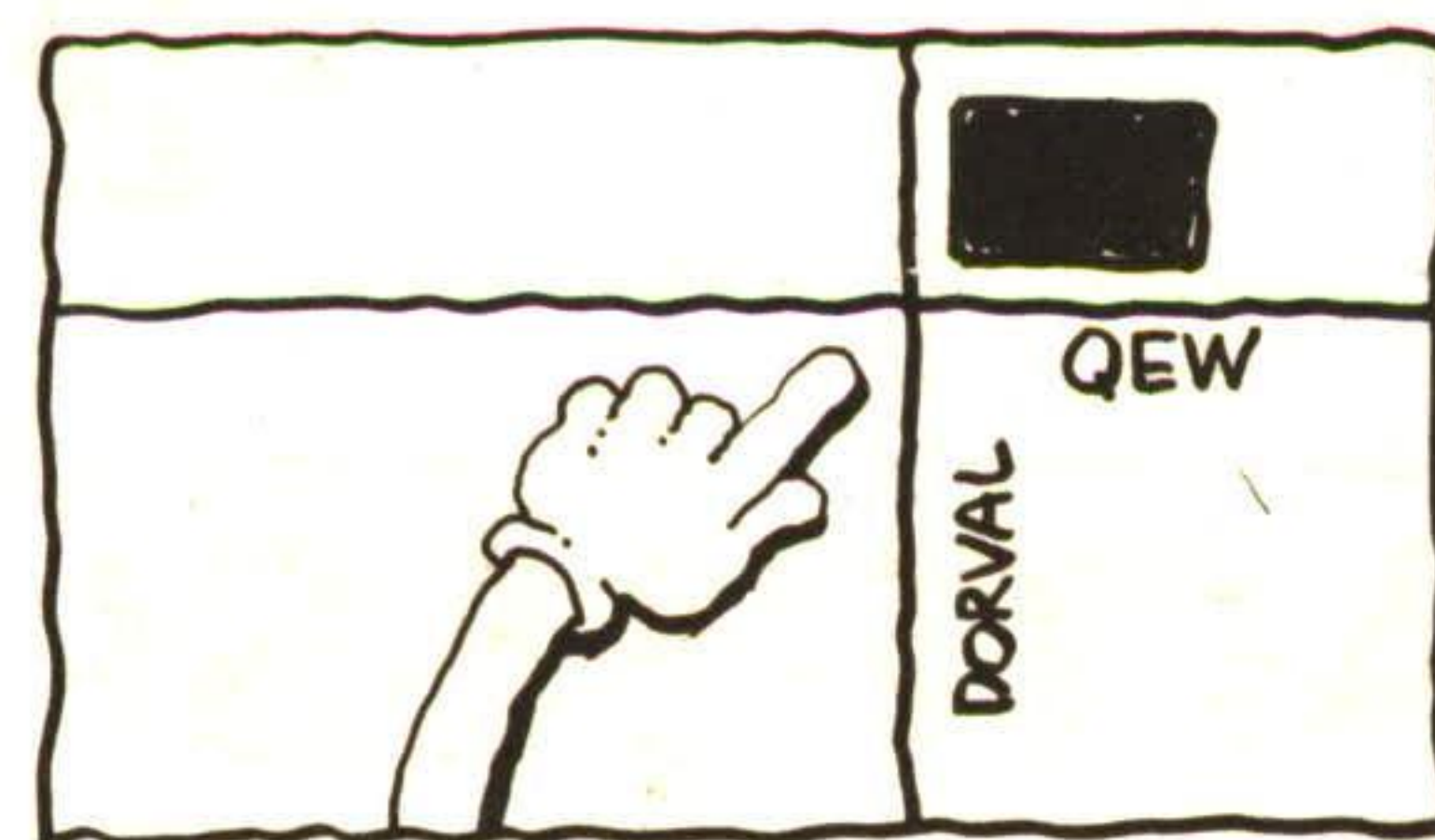
