CHICKEN CACCIATORE

- 2 skinless chicken breasts, boned
- 1/3 cup flour
- 1/4 cup oil
- 1 medium onion, thinly sliced into rings
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 28 oz. can tomatoes, drained & chopped
- 4 oz. fresh mushrooms, sliced
- 1 handfull green beans
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1/8 teaspoon basil
- 1/2 teaspoon basil
- 1 cup red wine

1. Place flour in plastic bag, toss chicken in bag
2. Brown chicken in oil and 2 cloves garlic, remove chicken
3. Add onion, mushrooms, remaining garlic, beans, cook for 3 mins. on high
4. Add herbs, salt & pepper, wine & tomatoes, mix together
5. Add chicken, simmer on low 20-25 mins.
6. Put chicken on plate and spoon over sauce

Serve with baked potato and salad or vermicelli and salad

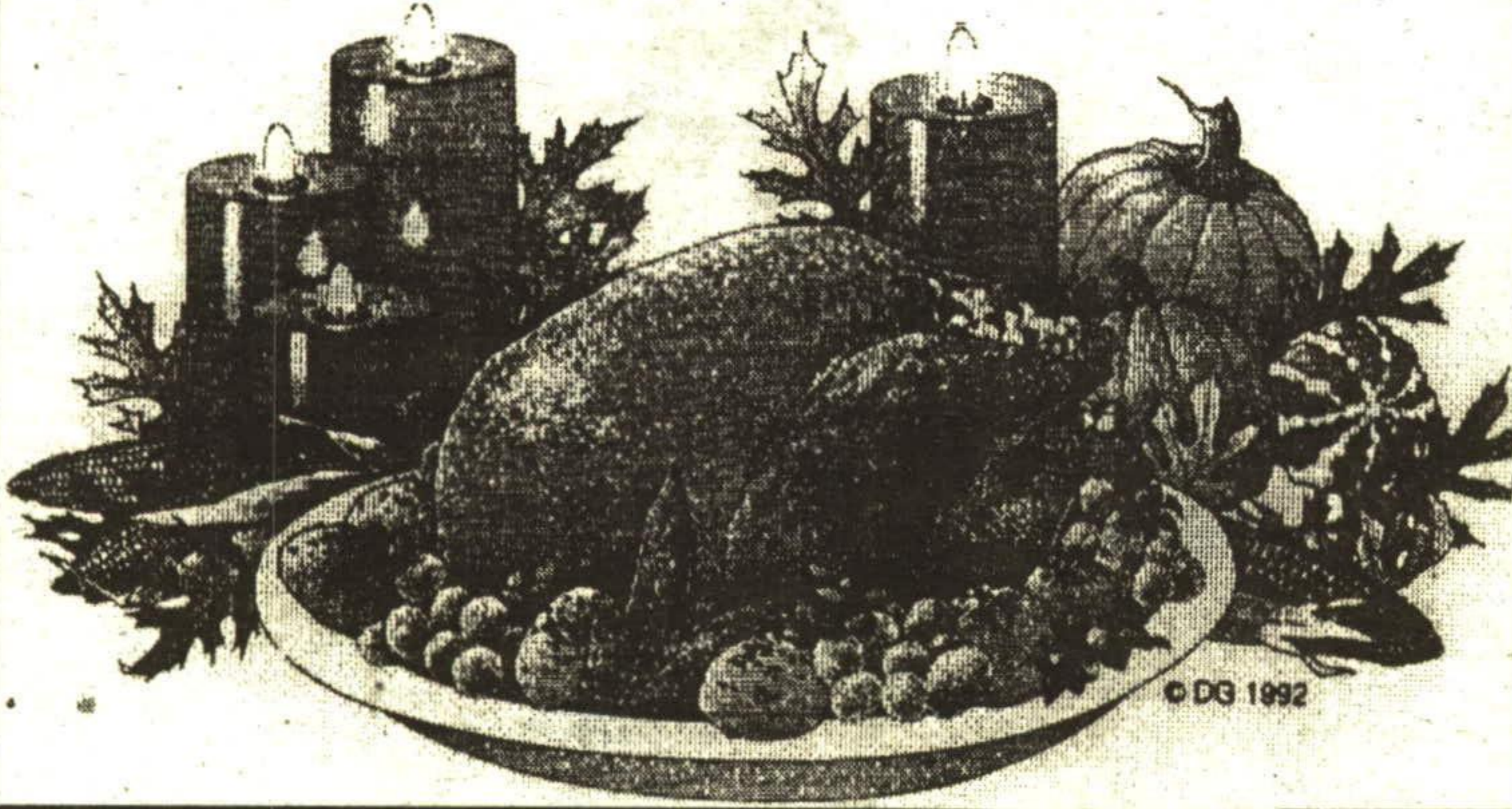

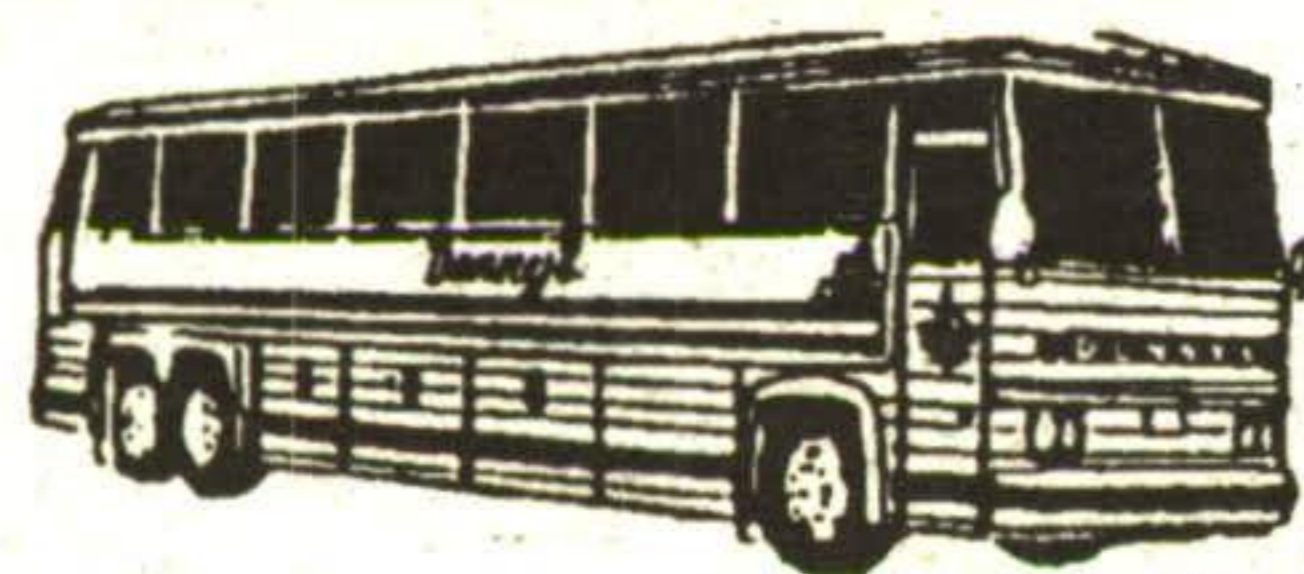
