Halton Hills Recreation and Parks and Leisure Services from Milton. Fundraising efforts provided by the group help support program supplies and refreshments.

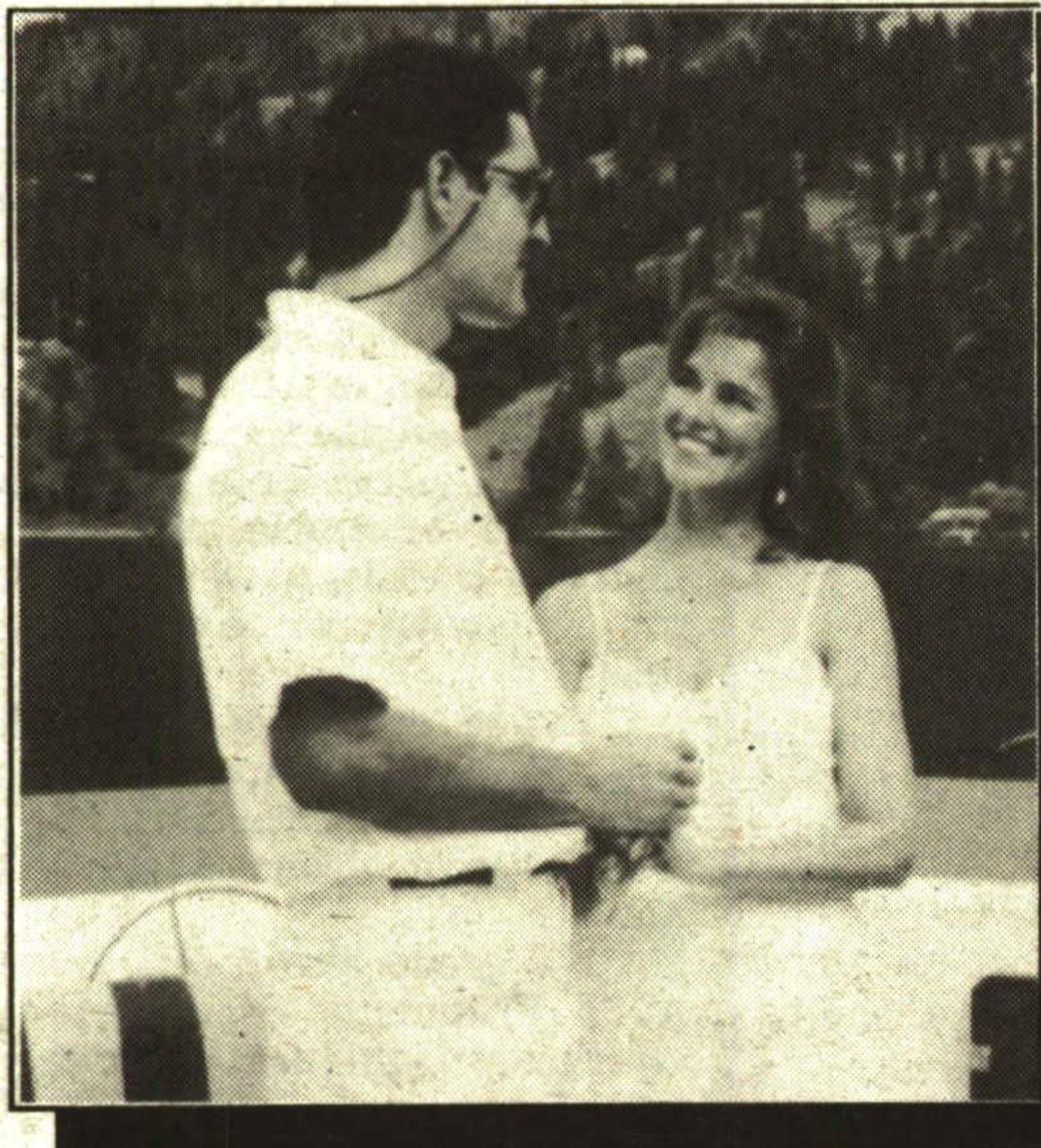

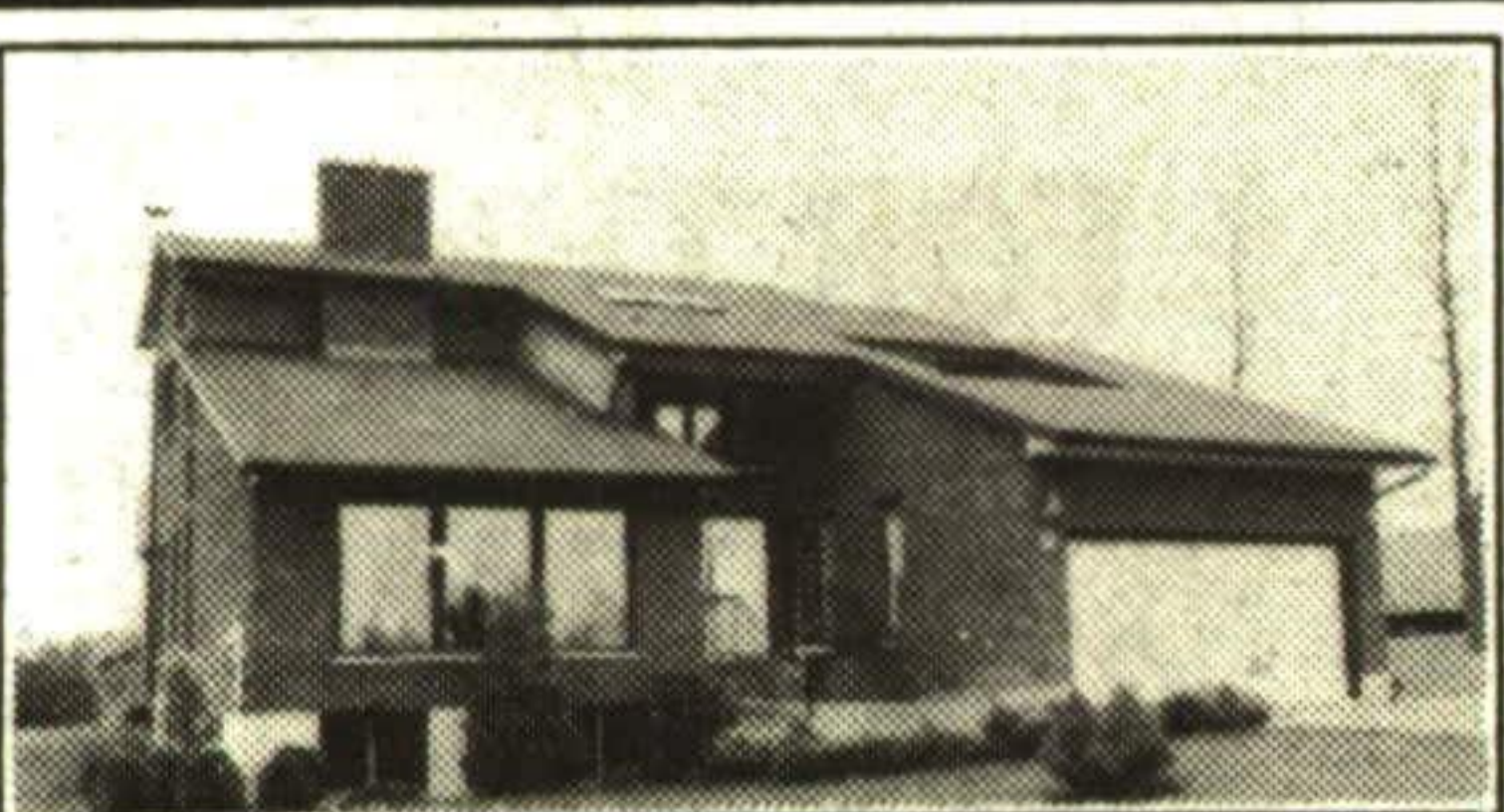
