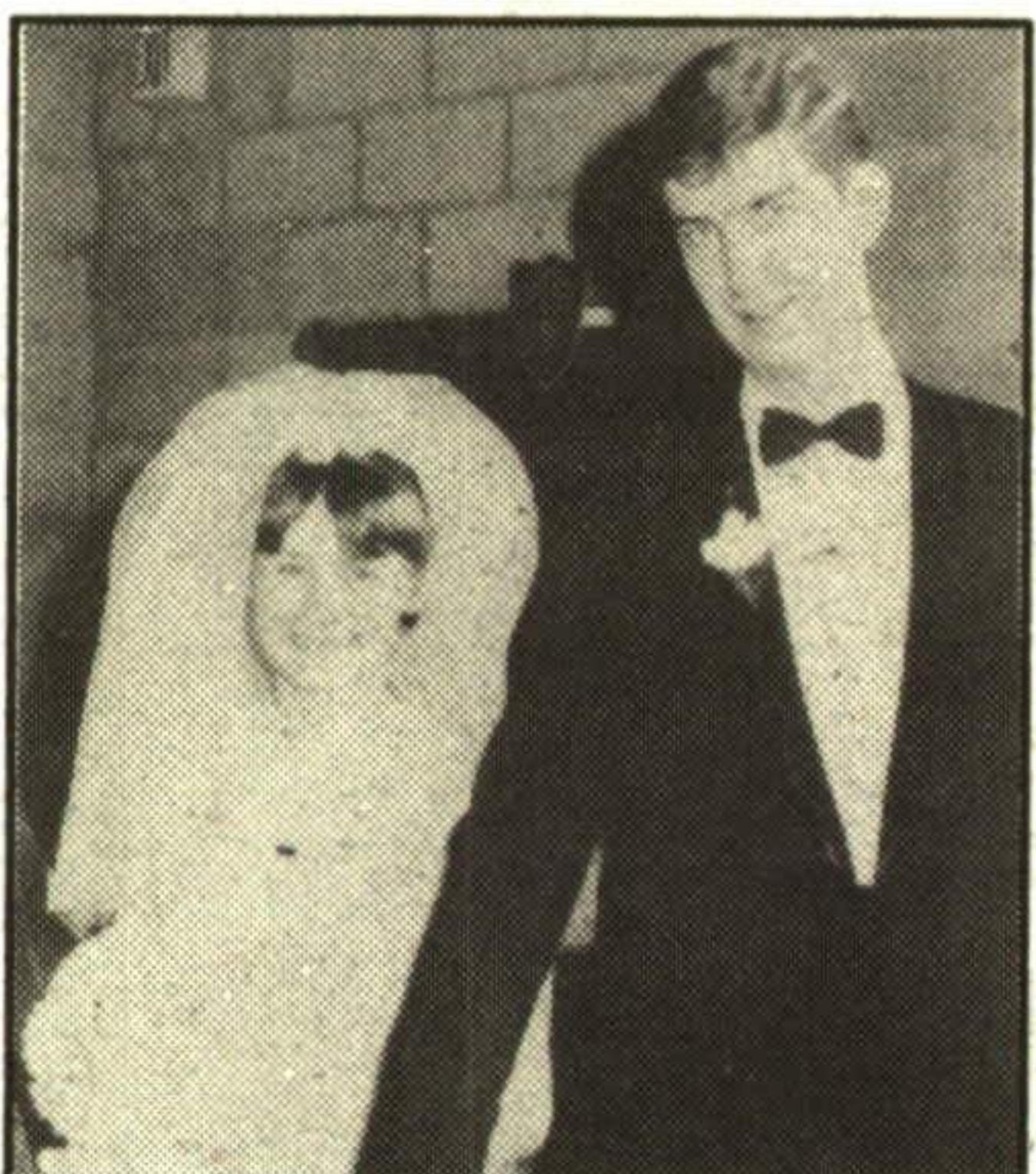

This magazine, "The Denturist," is the organized voice of full-time practitioners in dealing with the licensing board, the government, as well as other professional organizations.

This association is a member of the Denturist Association of Canada and the International Federation of Dental Prosthetists.

All activities of a licensed Denture Therapist are monitored by the provincially appointed nine-person Governing Board of Denture Therapists.

All denture therapy licenses must be renewed annually.
