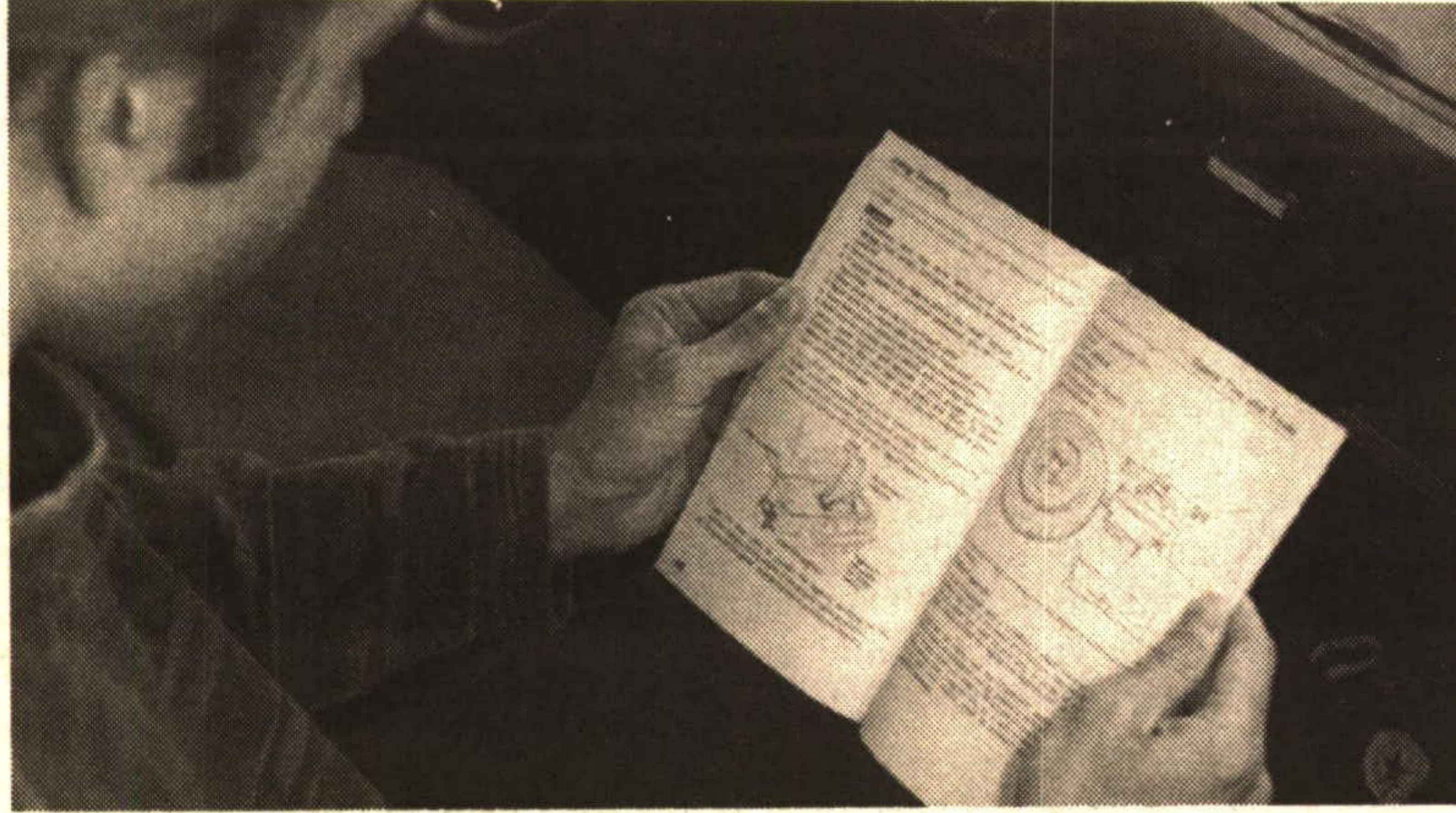
Get To Know Your Car

If you aren't familiar with the workings of your car, it may be difficult for you to recognize when problems occur and what may be causing those problems. Everyone—men and women, new drivers and experienced drivers—should take the time to learn the basics about their cars.

Because most gas stations are self serve, we should know how to fill up with the right fuel for our cars. And it's a good idea to check the oil level about every other fill-up. Your owner's manual will show you where the dipstick is. You will also want to know where to fill up the windshield washer solvent—especially for winter driving. Become familiar with the look of your tires when they are properly filled. This way you'll be able to notice when a tire needs air.

All of the items previously listed tell you when small things need to be done to your car—either by you or a service station mechanic. To keep your vehicle in tip-top shape you need to keep a regular maintenance schedule: tuneups about every year, oil and filter changes every three months or 3,000 miles, and tire rotations about every 6,000–8,000 miles. To keep your car's exterior in good condition, it is a good idea to wax your car about twice a year—once right before summer and once right before winter.

Take some time to become familiar with your car. This could save you big money down the road.
