New local school on 'wish list'

The Halton Board of Education's capital expenditure 'wish list' includes the building of eight new schools - one of those schools in Georgetown - over the next five years at a cost of \$95.6 million. The board's estimated share would be \$56.6 million.

Top priority on the capital expenditure forecast presented last week is a new K to 8 school in the Heaton Forest/Millcroft areas of Burlington. Next in line is a K to 8 school in the Iroquois Ridge and River Oaks areas (both in Oakville); a K to 8 in Georgetown;

K to 5 in Clearview (Oakville); a high school in northwest Oakville and a K to 8 school in West Oak Trails (Oakville).

The five year capital expenditure forecast, covering the years 1995 to 1999, will be sent to the Ministry of Education and Training after final approval is given by public school trustees at their next meeting.

Wish list is the best terminology to describe the five year capital expenditure forecast, according to Burlington trustee Lynda Schreiber, who can't see the province having "money to fulfill a lot of our wishes."

The release of the capital expenditure forecast is one time when the

board becomes somewhat parochial, said Georgetown trustee Dick Howitt, chairman of the Property Committee who submitted the list to trustees.

"They want to do what's best for their own schools and that's natural," said Howitt, who is optimistic that most trustees will allow the reality of the economic situation to dominate their parochial feelings.

"The staff comes up with a formula, it's not a scientific formula but it's a formula to take all the various requests for money" and prioritize them in a "reasonable and fair" way, added Howitt.

"Most of the time trustees accept that," he said.
