



A group of Georgetown District High School (GDHS) business students just got back from a weekend at The Westin-Harbour Castle in Toronto for DECA's 27th annual North Atlantic Regional Conference (NARCON) on Student Leadership Development.

The students from GDHS all seemed to have the same feeling that they were glad they got the opportunity to go.

"We met a lot of people from all over, and it really opened our eyes to the business world," says Tanya Alrawdah, an OAC Business Administration student at the high school.

"I made a lot of new friends and I am actually writing to a couple of people I met from Maryland," says Teresa Fendley, another one of the delegates from GDHS.

The conference was made up of a series of informal seminars which taught students about a variety of different things. The students


enjoyed learning more about sexual harrassment in the workplace, leadership skills and how to "dress for success".

Above all, the main point that the seminars were trying to get across was to have more self-confidence, because believing in yourself will get you everywhere.


