The Georgetown Chrysler Raiders got their week rolling with a big 10-3 victory over the last place

Royal York Rangers Wednesday night and have now won two of their last three contests.

At the mid-way mark of the regular season, Georgetown holds a 5-16 record and seventh place in

Central Ontario Provincial Junior A West Division standings.

Goaltender Paul Stinnett was between the pipes Wednesday and turned in another solid effort for his second win of the season. He allowed two goals in the opening period, one more in the second frame and then stonewalled Ranger attackers in the final stanza.

Ian Ellis and Doug Sheppard led the Raiders' scoring attack against Royal York.

Ellis, who is making a good run in the West Division scoring race, turned another hat-trick and picked

up two assists while rookie Sheppard notched a pair of markers and three assists.

Also scoring for Georgetown were Brent Ford and Randy Bond with two each and Kris Arro with a single marker. Drawing assists were Chris Monk, Dave Milek, Mike Bajurny, Trevor Brandt, David Bouskill, Arro, Jason Parks, Bond and Chris Logue.

The Raiders faced Oakville and Burlington this weekend.

The team's next home game is Saturday, December 4th against the Milton Merchants.

## Minor peewee Raiders claim win over Hespeler

The Georgetown M&M Pro Sports Minor Peewee Raiders came up with a big win on Sunday, November 21, shutting out Hespeler 7-0.

Georgetown started out with good control of the game in the first period by keeping the puck in the Hespeler zone. The first goal was scored at the 5:38 mark unassisted by Josh Travers, followed shortly after at 4:55 by a goal from Matt Hotham assisted by a good pass from Mike Rovere.

Georgetown's power play was in action for the third goal at the 2:15 mark by Jason Campbell assisted by Roddy Heinz and Matt Hotham. Good team work from Georgetown brought the first period to a quick end with Georgetown leading 3-0.

Hespeler determined to get on the scoreboard in the second period, turned up the heat with a few shots but came up short due to the good goaltending by Ryan Carter. Hespeler had the advantage when Georgetown was short-handed but again, good plays and quick thinking by Brent McClung and Matt Hotham gave Ryan Bobor the opportunity to slip the fourth goal in for Georgetown. Good defence plays by Andrew Black and Bryan Stuttard kept Hespeler at a distance.

Again, back in the Hespeler end Matt Hotham sent a good pass over to Brent McClung who then came up with one of his famous slapshots from the blueline which the Hespeler goalie never even saw, thus bringing the game now to a 5-0 lead.

To add the finishing touches on the game, Josh Travers netted his second goal at the 1:43 mark assisted by Ryan Bobor and ending off the game, Ryan Bobor's second goal, unassisted at the 1:31 mark brought the final numbers on the scoreboard Georgetown 7-Hespeler 0.
