After last week's disappointments, the Halton Novice Hurricanes came back with two wins and an exhibition loss.

Brantford visited Hillsburgh on Nov. 24 and were met with a barrage of well placed passes, fast paced skating, and shut out goaltending by Matt Fielding, resulting in a 6-0 decision.

Chase Trull continues to impress with his soft hands around the net, which earned him two assists. Three players: Lucas Schott, Mike Ley, and Ryan Ellis each had two goals and an assist. Well done boys. Clem D'Orazio claimed two assists. Scott Enair, John Gleed, Adam Sturgeon, and Danny Walinga each earned an assist.

On Saturday Oakville came to town, and Halton again took control of the game.

Mike Ley played a strong game and got the team off on the right foot by potting the first two goals

for Halton. The third goal was an inspired end to end rush from short handed by defenseman Danny Walinga. Ryan Ellis had two goals and an assist. Lucas Schott had a goal. Josh Vanderbreggen, Matt Clark, Adam Sturgeon, and Chase Trull had assists.

The game ended (7-2) in a strange way as the Zamboni drove out onto the ice with seven minutes left in the game, signaling the curfew each team had signed up to had expired. Oakville requested a replay of the whole last period (declined) or protest. The jury is out. On Sunday Halton visited an (MTHL) highly ranked Markham club and played toe to toe for 45 minutes of entertaining hockey. The team played tied or one down throughout the game but kept plugging with good playmaking and an excellent defensive effort not to let the quick Markham forwards ever get clear access to the Halton

goalies. Chase Trull opened the scoring with a one timer to the corner. Ryan Ellis followed up with the second and the last Halton goals (plus an assist on the first one). Matt Clark, Lucas Schott, and Clem

D'Orazio notched assists. Two Halton goals in the last two minutes were disallowed but the team never got down and swarmed the opposition in the last minute of play. Final score 3-4.

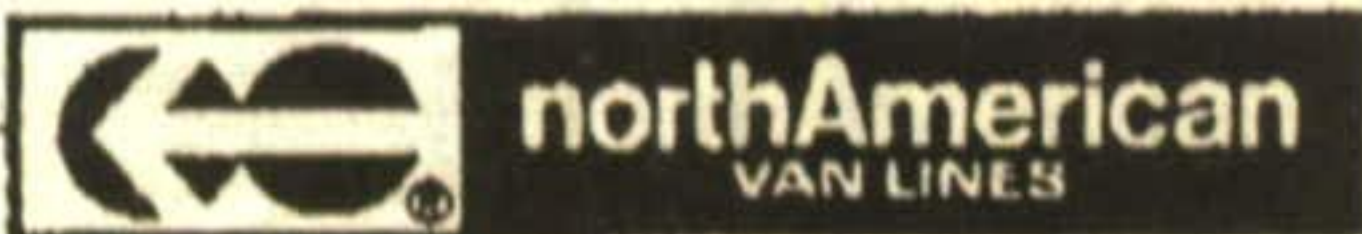

**Q:** If I colour my hair and don't like the results can I recolour right away?

**A:** Yes you can but there are a few variables involved. Recolouring depends upon the strength of your hair, if colour used was too light or too dark and whether it was coloured with a permanent or a semi permanent colour. **Q:** If something is broken during the move, who is responsible for replacing it?

**A:** All household goods carriers are required by law to insure customers' goods with a carriers' liability of 60 cents per pound. Settlement for lost or damaged goods is strictly on the basis of weight. For example, a broken television weighing 30 pounds would be settled at \$18.00. Because the carriers' liability is so minimal, replacement insurance is offered by many moving companies at an additional charge. Settlement is then made at current replacement cost. For example, the broken television would be replaced. Irrespective of what type of insurance coverage obtained, owner packed items which are broken are not covered. This is because the damage was sustained as a result of poor packing - not handling. It is important that customers understand the difference in insurance options. Do not accept movers at face value who state they are "fully insured". ASK QUESTIONS!

**Q:** Who claims the child when there is joint custody?

**A:** "Custody" is a legal term. For tax purposes determination of who can claim the child is based on "dependency". Generally dependency is determined by who the child is dependent upon for support. In the case of claiming the "equivalent to married" credit, the child must also live with the taxpayer making the claim.

**Q:** When your sponge painting a wall, can you sponge a latex over an alkyd?

**A:** This applies to the rule "You can never apply latex over alkyd (oil)". However, usually for sponge painting you change the background color to co-ordinate with your sponging colors. Therefore you can use Para's 777 - super-stick latex primer, tinted to your color. This enables you to do your sponge painting with latex base paints for ease of clean-up and fast drying. However you still may sponge over your existing alkyd, with alkyd base paints.

**Q:** How does the selling off of package vacations and flights work?

**A:** Sell off's come about by Package Tour Companies that have left over empty seats on planes and rooms at hotels, just prior to the departure date. Approximately 1-2 weeks prior to departure, the amount of empty space is counted and if necessary, the package tour company puts it on sale for the lower rate. Saving's on sell-offs vary according to the amount of space left available and the destination. Usually about 5-30% off the original price. The difficulty in sell off's comes from that there is no guarantee of a certain hotel or its quality, the destination that you wish to go to or the actual date you may want to travel. Some destinations and flights are booked well in advance and will not come up on sell off at all. Best bet, book in advance and take advantage of the new early booking bonuses that are offered by most tour companies, they range in savings of \$25.00 to \$100.00 p.p. off of your package price. Your local Travel Agent can assist easily and their services are FREE!
