Rural Ontario is undergoing great structural changes. Farms, homes, and businesses are being lost to bankruptcy.

Here's how it works: community volunteers, called Kitchen Table Advisors (KTA's), take a free indepth training course.

In response to a call on our crisis line, a team of two experienced KTA's (sworn to confidentiality) will visit the family, assess the situation, and make customized referrals to needed services. KTA's can connect families with professionals (lawyers, accountants, advocates)

who volunteer to help out on a caseby-case basis.

Emergency financial assistance for family needs or family counselling is available through KTA's.


A unique feature of the Alliance is the KTA's stay in contact with the family for several months to make sure things are improving.






