

#### SALAME DOLCE **Chocolate Salame**

Serves 8 to 10

cup raisins cup Marsala

tablespoons (1 stick plus 3 tablespoons) unsalted butter, room temperature

cup sugar

cups leftover butter cookies, spice cookies, or Marie biscuits, whirled into fine crumbs

with processor tablespoons pine nuts


teaspoons apricot jam

tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder

Soak the raisins in the Marsala for 30 minutes; drain, squeezing out any extra moisture. Reserve the Marsala.

Cream the butter and sugar in a mixing bowl until light and fluffy, about 5 minutes be hand or 3 to 4 minutes by mixer at high speed. Add the raisins, cookie crumbs, pine nuts, jam, and cocoa and mix well to form a firm dough. If too dry, add more Marsala, 1 tablespoon at a time.

Roll the dough up up in the shape of salame on a piece of aluminum foil, wrap with plastic wrap or aluminum foil, and refrigerate for at least 3 to 4 hours, until it is well set. It keeps nicely for a week.






