

Working as a team, the Brookville teachers developed the Crane Unit of study that integrates mathematics, science, design, and technology concepts. The unit was developed for Brookville students who first used the unit last spring, but the teaching unit has since been shared with other schools in the region.

The awards are intended to honor Canada's best teachers and are given to elementary and secondary teachers who have had a major, proven impact on student performance and interest in science, technology, and mathematics.

Award recipients receive a Certificate of Excellence and congratulatory letter from the Prime Minister, as well as a cash award. One third of the cash award is given to the school, while two thirds of the cash award is given to the educator for professional development and other teaching aids to help outstanding teachers continue to make a difference to their schools.


