

Rebel wrestlers claim Orillia mat crown

The GDHS Rebels wrestling squad continued their successful 1993-94 campaign last weekend by winning the Orillia Senior Open Saturday.

In their first major tournament victory this season, the Rebels collected 68 points and easily won the meet. Sarnia Collegiate were their closest opponents who finished second with 37 points.

A total of 260 wrestlers from 23 schools participated at the meet. Georgetown sent 13 competitors and all finished in the top five.

"It was our first major win this season," said head coach Jim Hall, who heads up the wrestling team along with assistant coach Nick Daniels, "We had a lot of depth at the meet and took first place rather easily."

Bill Stokes and Jason Titus con-

tinued to shine in mat action and came away with first place finishes in their respective weight classes.

Taking second place honors were Mike Egerton, Colin Kay, Kevin Withers and Mike Hergaarden. Rounding out the top three places were Doug Dutchburn, Mitch Dodd, Ian Cox, Mike Roe and Jeff Whorley who all pinned down third place showings.

Mike Large and Phil Elliot each took fifth place finishes.

Meanwhile at the E.C. Drury meet in Milton, Jason Myers and Carlos Scappin (of Acton High) each placed first while Acton's Scott Snyder finished third.

The wrestling team has two more major tournaments prior to Halton Regional championship action February 16 at E.C. Drury in Milton.

The Halton Junior finals will be held at Lester B. Pearson in Burlington on February 9.

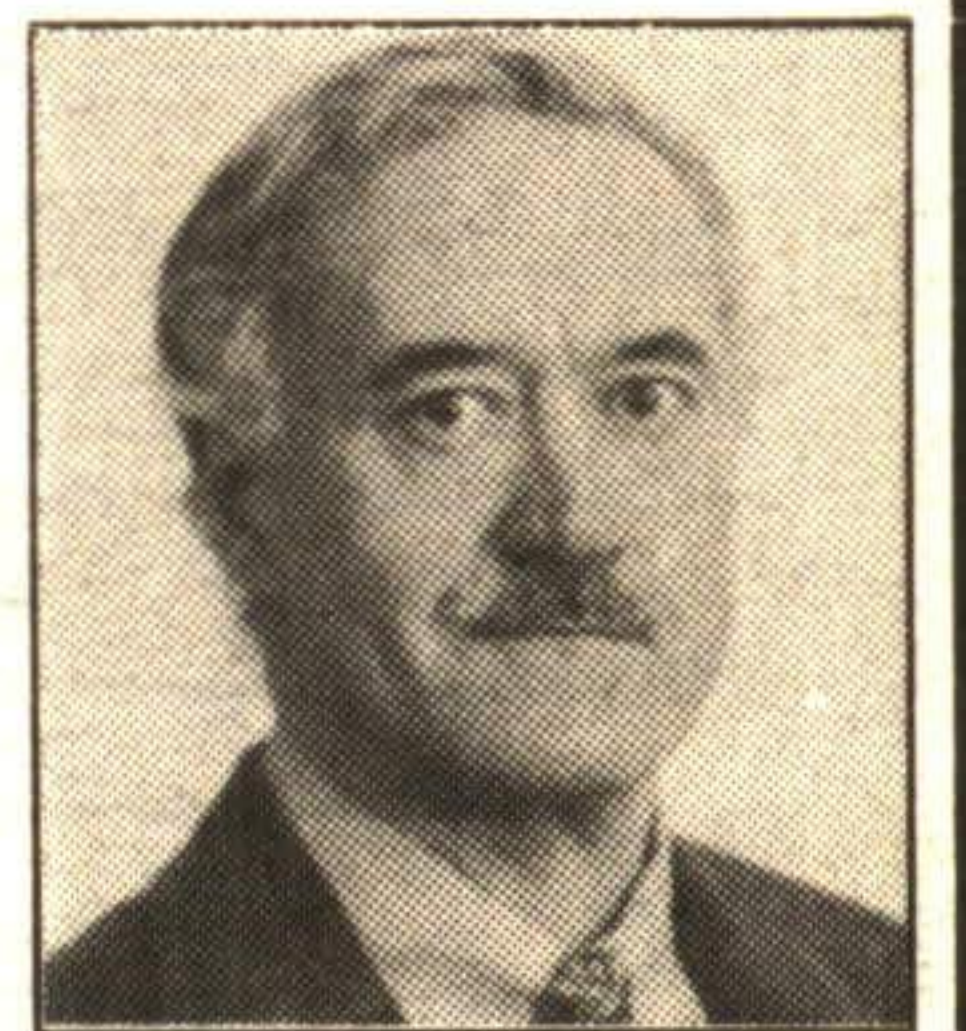

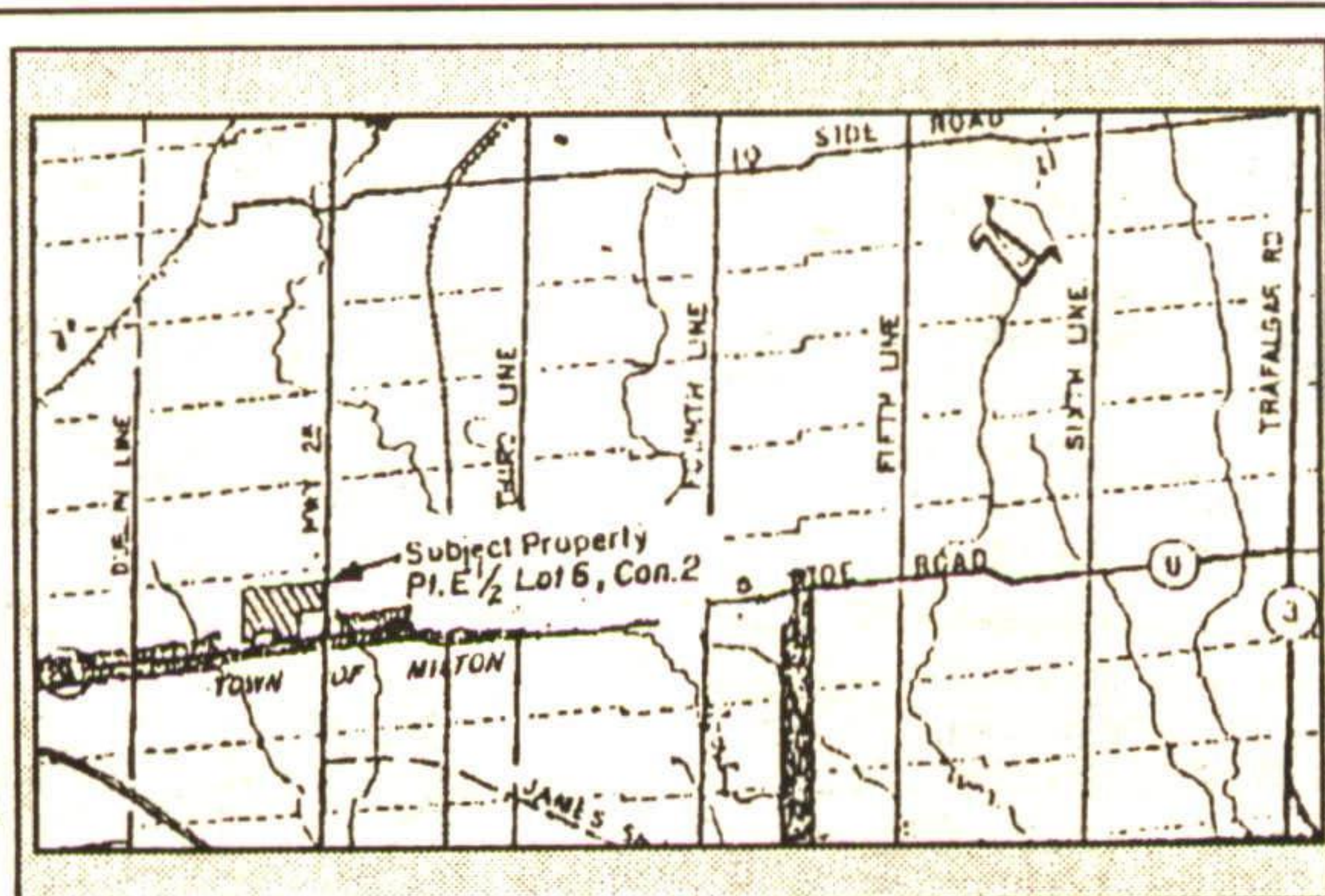

The property is located on the north side of 5 Sideroad, at Highway 25 in the Town of Halton Hills.

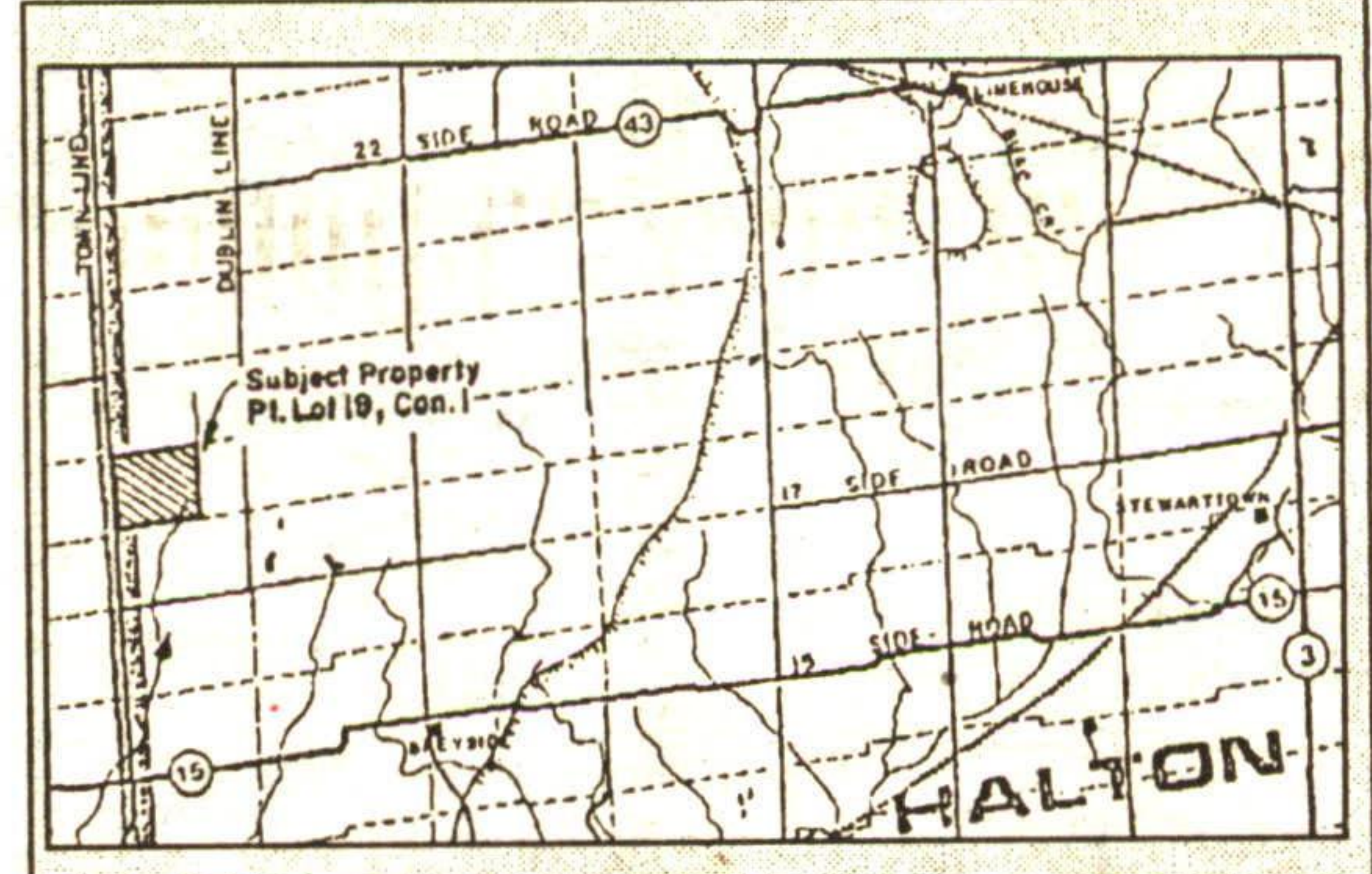

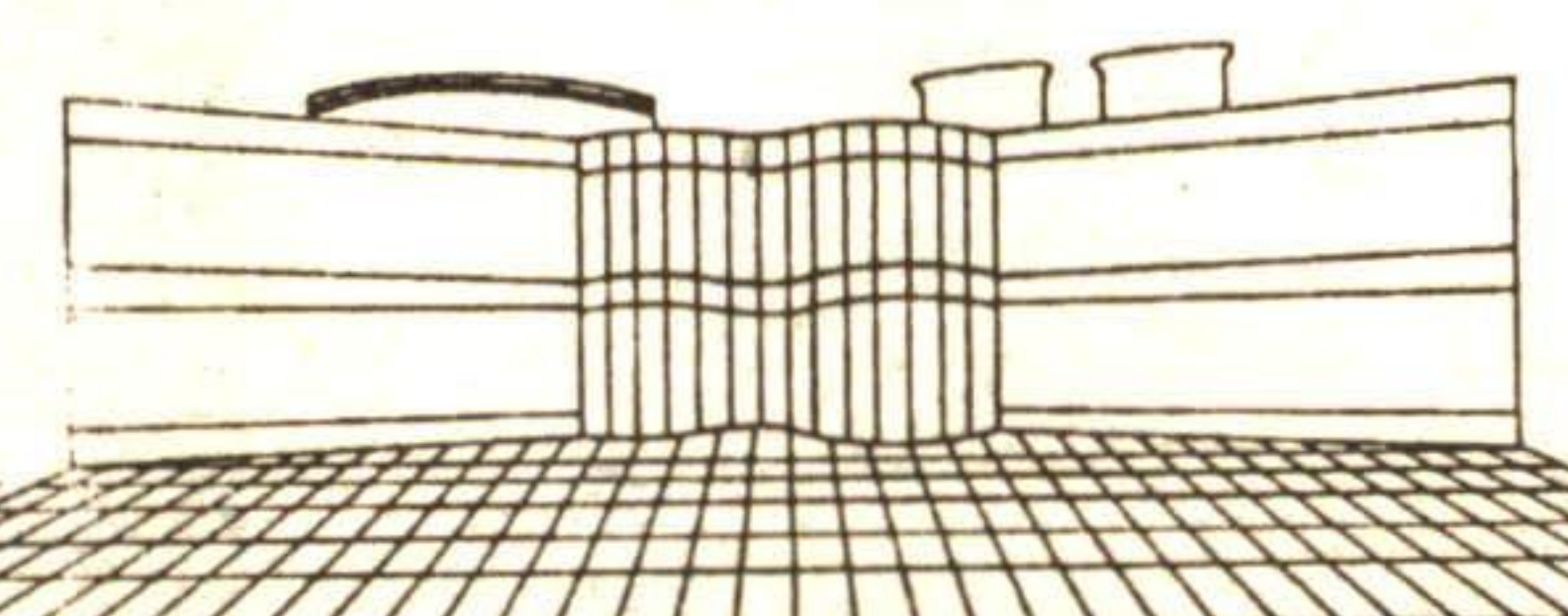
