

Shutterbugs get clicking — Photoart '94 is now accepting entries

With the coming of February, the time has once again come for Halton Hills' shutterbugs to dust off their prize winning prints and prepare to enter Photoart '94.

The annual juried photographic art exhibition and sale will feature three separate categories for entries. They include People and Animals, Scenery, Foliage and Flowers, and Objects and Abstracts. Prizes will be awarded in all categories for both black and white and color entries.

Photos must be no smaller than 5 by 7 inches and no larger than 16 by 20 inches. No Polaroid pictures will be accepted.

All photos must be mounted on white board, (not matted or framed) and have a white margin a minimum of 2 inches wide and a maximum of 3 inches wide. These measurements will be enforced.

A handling charge of \$3 per photo will be charged by Halton Hills Camera Club. Entries can be dropped off at NRS Brand Realty, Mountainview Rd., until Feb. 26, between 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. weekdays, and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturdays. They must be dropped off in a sealed envelope with Photoart '94

marked on the front.

Entries will be judged by three professional photographers, and the exhibition and sale will open March 3 at the Gallery, at 7 p.m. Awards will be presented at 8 p.m.

All photos will be offered for sale in the exhibition, and Halton Hills Camera Club will be deducting a 25

per cent commission on any works sold to defray costs.

A full set of rules and regulations for Photoart '94 can be obtained at most photo outlets around Halton Hills.
